## 1 CHRONICLES 23 vs 1




The Bible is so interesting; even the Old Testament. Remember: when reading the 1st and 2nd Chronicles... we read history and events recorded from the perspective of the 2 tribes of the **Southern Kingdom**, the House of **Judah**;

<u>not</u> like 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Kings... where we read the historical perspective of the 10 tribes of the **Northern Kingdom**... the House of **Israel**. David's last instructions to the People, and to his son Solomon,

The Divisions of the Levites

<sup>1</sup> So when David was old and full of days, he made his son Solomon king over Israel.



- <sup>3</sup>Now the Levites were numbered from the age of thirty years and above; and the number of individual males was 38,000.
- <sup>4</sup> Of these, 24,000 were to look after the work of the house of the Lord, 6,000 were officers and judges,
- <sup>5</sup>4,000 were gatekeepers, and 4,000 praised the Lord with musical instruments, which I made, said David, for giving praise.
- <sup>6</sup> Also David separated them into divisions among the sons of Levi: Gershon, Kohath, and Merari.
- <sup>7</sup> Of the Gershonites: Laadan and Shimei.
- <sup>8</sup> The sons of Laadan: the first Jehiel, then Zetham and Joel -- three in all.
- <sup>9</sup> The sons of Shimei: Shelomith, Haziel, and Haran -- three in all. These were the heads of the ancient families of Laadan.
- <sup>10</sup> And the sons of Shimei: Jahath, Zina, Jeush, and Beriah. These were the four sons of Shimei.
- <sup>11</sup> Jahath was the first and Zizah the second. But Jeush and Beriah did not have many sons; therefore they were assigned as one father's house.



<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>12</sup> The sons of Kohath: Amram, Izhar, Hebron, and Uzziel -- four in all.

<sup>13</sup> The sons of Amram: Aaron and Moses; and Aaron was set apart, he and his sons forever, that he should sanctify the most holy things, to burn incense before the Lord, to minister to Him, and to give the blessing in His name forever.

- <sup>14</sup> Now the sons of Moses the man of God were counted to the tribe of Levi.
- <sup>15</sup> The sons of Moses were Gershon and Eliezer.
- <sup>16</sup> Of the sons of Gershon, Shebuel was the first.
- $^{17}$  Of the descendants of Eliezer, Rehabiah was the first. And Eliezer had no other sons, but the sons of Rehabiah were very many.
- <sup>18</sup> Of the sons of Izhar, Shelomith was the first.
- <sup>19</sup> Of the sons of Hebron, Jeriah was the first, Amariah the second, Jahaziel the third, and Jekameam the fourth.
- <sup>20</sup> Of the sons of Uzziel, Michah was the first and Jesshiah the second.
- <sup>21</sup> The sons of Merari were Mahli and Mushi. The sons of Mahli were Eleazar and Kish.
- <sup>22</sup> And Eleazar died, and had no sons, but only daughters; and their brethren, the sons of Kish, took them as wives.
- <sup>23</sup> The sons of Mushi were Mahli, Eder, and Jeremoth -- three in all.
- <sup>24</sup> These were the sons of Levi by their ancient families -- the heads of the ancient families as they were counted individually by the number of their names, who did the work for the service of the house of the Lord, from the age of twenty years and above.
- <sup>25</sup> For David said, The Lord God of Israel has given rest to His people, that they may dwell in Jerusalem forever;
- <sup>26</sup> and also to the Levites, They will no longer carry the Tent, or any of the articles for its service.
- $^{27}$  For by the last words of David the Levites were numbered from twenty years old and above;
- <sup>28</sup> because their duty was to help the sons of Aaron in the service of the house of the Lord, in the courts and in the chambers, in the purifying of all holy things and the work of the service of the house of God.

<sup>29</sup>both with the showbread and the fine flour for the grain offering, with the unleavened cakes and what is baked in the pan, with what is mixed and with all kinds of measures and sizes;

<sup>30</sup> to stand every morning to thank and praise the Lord, and likewise at evening;

and at every presentation of a burnt offering to the Lord on the Sabbaths and on the New Moons and on the set feasts, by number according to the ordinance governing them, regularly before the Lord;

<sup>32</sup> and that they should attend to the needs of the Tent of meeting, the needs of the holy place, and the needs of the sons of Aaron their brethren in the work of the house of the Lord.
