**<sup>1</sup> Now concerning the collection which is for the saints, do the same as I directed the assemblies of Galatia.**

**<sup>2</sup> On the first day of the week, each of you set something aside that you have saved, as He has prospered you, so when I come there is no need for collections.**

**<sup>3</sup> And when I arrive, I will send them with letters whoever you approve, to carry your gift to Jerusalem.**

**<sup>4</sup> If it is suitable for me to go, they can travel with me.**

**<sup>5</sup> I will come to you, after I pass through Macedonia -- for I am going through Macedonia.**

**<sup>6</sup> Perhaps, I will stay with you; yes, and winter with you, so that you may send me on my way wherever I go.**

**<sup>7</sup> I do not want to see you now, just in passing; for I hope to spend some time with you, if the Lord allows.**

**<sup>8</sup> For now I will remain in Ephesus until Pentecost;**

**<sup>9</sup> because a wide door for effective ministry has opened for me -- though there are many enemies.**

**<sup>10</sup> If Timothy comes, see that he has nothing to fear while with you: because he is doing the work of the Lord, just as I am.**

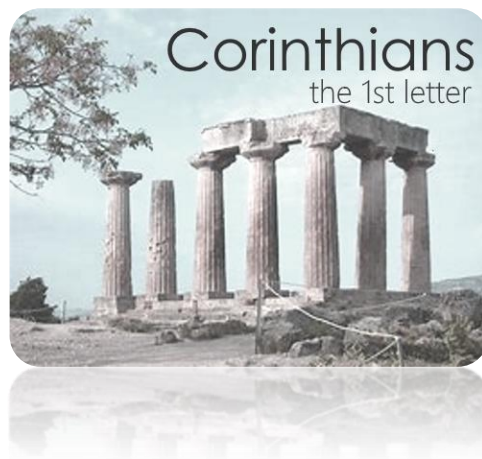
**<sup>11</sup> So let no one look down on him.** Send him on his way in peace, so that he can come to me: because I am expecting him with the brothers and sisters.

**<sup>12</sup> Now about our brother Apollos, I urged him to come to you with the brothers and sisters: but he was not at all willing to come now; but he will come when he has opportunity.**

**<sup>13</sup> Be alert, stand firm in the faith, act like men, be strong /** [this letter began with Paul declaring : God is faithful;](#) here it closes, and Paul says: **You be faithful, too.**

**<sup>14</sup> Do everything you do with love.**

**<sup>15</sup> Brothers and sisters, I urge you, since you know the household of Stephen. They are the firstfruits of Achaia, and have devoted themselves to serving the saints,**

<sup>17</sup> I am glad to have Stephen, Fortunatus and Achaicus with me: because they filled in for your absence;

<sup>18</sup> for they refreshed my spirit and yours. Therefore recognize such people.

<sup>19</sup> The assemblies of Asia greet you. Aquila and Priscilla greet you heartily in the Lord, along with the assembly that is in their home.

<sup>20</sup> All the brothers and sisters greet you. **Greet one another with a holy kiss** / 5 times in the NT this phrase is used; [as Dr. Peter J. Williams thoughtfully points out: Paul knows the Corinthians were too small to legislatively change the roman empire](#), so as servants of their Master Jesus Christ they could change the world; they could take to heart His words, and show their love to one another; and the best way to show we are family is when we give a kiss – men and women, young and old; servants kissing servants; Jews kissing Gentiles -- for we all have a very loving Boss who is in heaven.



<sup>21</sup> **This greeting is in my own hand – Paul.**

<sup>22</sup> **If anyone does not love the Lord Jesus Christ, let him be cursed / damned by God. Maranatha!**

<sup>23</sup> **The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you.**

<sup>24</sup> **My love be with all of you in Christ Jesus. Amen.**
