Everyone who believes that **Jesus** is the **Christ** / **Yeshua** is the **Messiah**

is born of God: and everyone who loves the Father also loves the One who is born of Him.

²This is how we know that we love the children of God, **when we love God, and keep His instructions** / Moses told us that God on **Mount Sinai in Arabia** wrote His covenant of 10 instructions and no more with His people. When questioned by the Pharisees, Jesus summarize the Law under 2 great commands: to live long and prosper in the land.

1 Love God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength;

2 Love your neighbor as yourself.

³For this is what love for God is: that **we keep His instructions:**

and His instructions are **not** grievous / and how could they be burdensome? The Lord God said: do them and you will be blessed and live long in the land.

⁴**For Everyone is born of God conquers the world:**

and this is the victory that conquers the world -- our faith / what is faith? It is a gift of God; it is the ability to act, based upon a belief, sustained by confidence: it is taking a promise of God, and standing confidently on that promise. If God said, I am the Lord who heals you, then when you are sick, don't vacillate; stand! If you are lost, call on the Lord who shepherds us, and don't vacillate. call on God, let Him quickly help you win the victory... every day by faith, commit your way to the Lord.

⁵**Who is the one who conquers the world,**

but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

⁶This is the One who came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; **not** by water only, but by water and blood / water at His washing in the beginning; and blood at Calvary at the end, when Jesus the Messiah came in great humility – fulfilling the first 4 days of the Lord; both were necessary to validate and seal His claim of Christ, the Messiah.

And it is the Spirit who bears witness, because the Spirit is truth / and who are these two Olive Branches? **the two Sons of Oil** who stand by the Lord of the whole earth – **Zechariah 4**.



7 For there are three who bear record in heaven,

the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit:

and these three are One / what more do we know: there is the Father, there is the Word, and there is the Spirit; and Jesus told us where 2 or 3 gather (just like their arrangement in heaven) He is in our midst; and THEY are ONE, united in a way we can hardly imagine; and from all that the prophets told us, THESE THREE WHO ARE ONE... THEY like each other a lot.

This verse 7 is preserved here even though most modern translations have shortened a portion of it, which seems to follow the Alexandrian tradition of Gnostics, who often sought to eliminate verses **that suggested Jesus was both human and divine**; thus, they fought for the separation of **Jesus and Christ**.

For the first 500 years, verse 7 was the source used to address further church debates. This verse settles any discussion of the authority of the Father, Son and Spirit. If there is a difference, what the church debates said settles it. From 200 AD, Tertullian, to 250, Cyprian of Carthage; 350, Athanasius; 398, Aurelius Augustine; to 415, the Council of Carthage; 450-530 AD several African writers defend the doctrine of the Trinity: Three Witnesses in Heaven.

8 And there are three that bear witness on earth:

the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three are in agreement.

9 If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater:

for the witness of God is this, that He testifies concerning His Son.

10 He who believes in the Son of God has the witness in himself:

he who does not believe God has made Him a liar; because he does not believe the record God gave of His Son.

11 And this is the record, that God has given us eternal life,

and this life is in His Son.

12 He who has the Son has life;

and he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.

13 These things I wrote to you who believe on the name of the Son of God;

that you know you have eternal life / Jesus is the greatest Teacher to ever walk this earth; the sheer numbers still today prove His worth; as more people around the world search His Name on the internet to learn more about Him than anybody else. For the last 2000 years throughout the earth, more books have been written about Him, more buildings have been erected to honor Him; more songs have been written and sung to declare His praise; and more generosity has charitably been showered on every country of this planet... in loving memory of His kindness toward one another: **check the facts.**

14 And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us:

15 and if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have what we asked of Him.

16 If anyone sees his brother sinning which does not lead to death, he should ask for him, and God will give life to those who sin not unto death.

There is a sin leading to death: I do not say that he should request this.

17 All wrong doing is sin / in other words: all that is not right is sin
yet there is sin not leading to death.

18 We know everyone who is born of God does not live to sin,
but the one who is born of God guards himself, and the evil one does not touch him.

/ from chapter one, we know John said: we all sin; we all fall short of the glory of God; here, John says about those who make sinning their lifelong pursuit. Either we follow the Lord, and learn from Him or we do not; it's not a great mystery; Do you hide His word in your heart? The answer is a simple: yes, or no;

19 And we know that we are of God, and the whole world rests in wrong doing.

20 And we know that the Son of God has come, and gives us understanding,

that we may know the true One; and we are in the true One, even in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.

/ He is the Way, the Truth and the Life; the night He was betrayed; 12 different times He told His followers: **if you love Me, keep My instructions**; he who has my instructions and keeps them, he it is who loves Me; **if anyone loves Me, he will keep My word, and the Father will love him, and We will come to him, and make Our abode with him**; he who does not love Me, does not keep my words, and the word that I speak is not mine, but the Father's who sent me – **John 14,**
