## 1 KINGS 4 vs 1



The Bible is so interesting; even the Old Testament. Remember: when reading the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Chronicles... we read history and events recorded from the perspective of the 2 tribes of the **Southern Kingdom**, the House of **Judah**;

The administration of Solomon.

- <sup>1</sup>So King Solomon was king over all Israel.
- <sup>2</sup> And these were his officers; Azariah the son of Zadok the priest,
- <sup>3</sup> Elihoreph and Ahijah, the sons of Shisha, secretaries; Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud, the court recorder.



- <sup>4</sup> And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada in charge of the army: and Zadok and Abiathar priests:
- <sup>5</sup> And Azariah the son of Nathan in charge of the deputies: and Zabud the son of Nathan was principal officer, and the king's friend / advisor to the king:
- <sup>6</sup> And Ahishar was over the household / in charge of the palace: and Adoniram the son of Abda was over the tribute / over the forced labor of foreigners living among Israel and Judah.
- <sup>7</sup> And Solomon had twelve officers over all **Israel**, who provided food supplies for the king and his household: each man was assigned his month of the year to provide provisions.
- <sup>8</sup> And these are their names: Ben-Hur, in the hill country of Ephraim:
- <sup>9</sup> Ben-deker, in Makaz, and in Shaalbim, and Beth-shemesh, and Elon-beth-hanan:
- <sup>10</sup> Ben-hesed, in Arubboth; to him belonged Socoh and all the land of Hepher:
- <sup>11</sup> Ben-Abinadab, in all the region of Dor; Taphath the daughter of Solomon was his wife:
- <sup>12</sup> Baana the son of Ahilud; to him belonged Taanach and Megiddo, and all Beth-shean, which is by Zar-ethan beneath Jezreel, from Beth-shean to Abel-meholah, as far as the other side of Jokmeam:
- <sup>13</sup> Ben-geber, in Ramoth-gilead; to him belonged the towns of Jair the son of Manasseh, which are in Gilead; to him also belonged the region of Argob, which is in Bashan, sixty great cities with walls and bronze bars:
- <sup>14</sup> Ahinadab the son of Iddo had Mahanaim:

- <sup>15</sup> Ahimaaz was in Naphtali; he also took Basemath the daughter of Solomon for his wife:
- <sup>16</sup> Baana the son of Hushai was in Asher and in Bealoth:
- <sup>17</sup> Jehoshaphat the son of Paruah, in Issachar:
- <sup>18</sup> Shimei the son of Ela, in Benjamin:
- <sup>19</sup> Geber the son of Uri was in the land of Gilead, in the land of Sihon king of the Amorites, and of Og king of Bashan; and he was the only officer who was in that region.
- <sup>20</sup> Judah and Israel were many, as numerous as the sand on the seashore, they were eating and drinking, and rejoicing.
- <sup>21</sup> And Solomon reigned over all the kingdoms from the river Euphrates to the land of the Philistines, and to the border of Egypt: they brought tributes, and served Solomon all the days of his life.
- $^{22}$  And Solomon's provision for one day was 150 bushels of fine flour, and 300 bushels of meal / estimates suggest there were 4000 5000 people daily needing provision,
- <sup>23</sup> 10 fattened oxen, and 20 oxen out of the pastures, and 100 sheep, beside deer, and gazelles, and roebucks, and pen-fed poultry.
- <sup>24</sup> For he had dominion over everything west of the Euphrates River, from Tiphsah to Gaza, over all the kings west of the River: and peace was on all his surrounding borders.
- <sup>25</sup> And Judah and Israel dwelt safely, each man under his own vine and his own fig tree, from Dan even to Beersheba / from north to south, all the days of Solomon.
- <sup>26</sup> And Solomon had 40,000 stalls of horses for his chariots, and 12,000 horsemen.
- $^{27}$  And each of those officers provided food for a month for king Solomon, and for all who came to King Solomon's table: they lacked nothing.
- <sup>28</sup> Each man brought the barley and also the straw for the chariot horses and dromedaries to the place where the officers were, each man according to his assignment.
- $^{29}$  And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding / very great discernment and a great insightful heart, as vast as the sand that is along the sea shore.
- $^{30}$  And the wisdom of Solomon excelled the wisdom of all the people of the East, and greater than all the wisdom of Egypt.

<sup>31</sup> For he was wiser than all men; than Ethan the Ezrahite, and Heman, and Calcol, and Darda, the sons of Mahol: / all the 4 great sons of Zara, distant relatives; he was wiser than: Calcol – the 1st Ancient Irish King, Darda – Dardanus – the founder of Troy and the City States of Greece;

and his fame was known in all the surrounding nations.

- <sup>32</sup> And he spoke 3,000 proverbs: and his songs numbered 1,005 / so the book of Proverbs is only a very small collection of Solomon's wisdom; as for the songs, like father, like son, both were prolific writers; but only 2 songs of Solomon were included in the book of Psalms (72 and 127).
- <sup>33</sup> And he spoke of trees, from the cedars in Lebanon even to the hyssop that clings to the wall: he spoke also of animals, and of the winged critters / not just the birds, but bugs and bees, and of creeping things, and fish.
- <sup>34</sup> And people came from everywhere to hear the wisdom of Solomon, from all the then kings of the earth, who heard of his wisdom.
