## 1 KINGS 5 vs 1




The Bible is so interesting; even the Old Testament. Remember: when reading the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Chronicles... we read history and events recorded from the perspective of the 2 tribes of the **Southern Kingdom**, the House of **Judah**;

The Temple of Solomon, built with Phoenicians

<sup>1</sup> Now Hiram king of Tyre sent his servants to Solomon; for he heard that they had anointed him king in place of his father: for Hiram was always a friend of David.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Then Solomon sent word to Hiram, saying,



- <sup>4</sup>But now the LORD my God has given me rest on every side, there is neither adversary nor misfortune occurring.
- <sup>5</sup> And behold, I intend to build a house to the Name of the LORD my God, just as the LORD spoke to David my father, saying, Your son, whom I will set on your throne in your place, he will build a house to My Name.
- <sup>6</sup> So now command that they cut for me cedars from Lebanon; and my servants will be with your servants: and I will give you wages for your servants according to all that you will say: for you know there is no one among us with the skill to cut timber like the Sidonians.
- <sup>7</sup> And it happened, when Hiram heard the words of Solomon, that he rejoiced greatly, and said, Blessed be the LORD today, who has given to David a wise son over this great people.
- <sup>8</sup> And Hiram sent word to Solomon, saying, I have considered what things you sent to me: and I will do all you desire concerning the cedar and cypress timber.
- <sup>9</sup> My servants will bring them down from Lebanon to the sea: and I will convey them on rafts by sea to the place that you will direct me, and I will have them be discharged there, and you will take them. Then you will accomplish my desire: giving food for my household.
- $^{10}$  So Hiram gave Solomon the cedar and cypress timber, according to all he desired.
- <sup>11</sup>And Solomon gave Hiram 100,000 bushels of wheat for food to his household, and 110,000 gallons of pure olive oil: thus Solomon gave to Hiram year after year.

<sup>12</sup> And the LORD gave Solomon wisdom, as He promised him: and there was peace between Hiram and Solomon; and together the two made a covenant.

<sup>13</sup> And king Solomon raised a levy from all Israel; and their duty was 30,000 workmen.

<sup>14</sup> And he sent them to Lebanon, 10,000 a month in shifts: one month they were in Lebanon, and two months at home: and Adoniram was over the workmen.



<sup>15</sup> Now Solomon had 70,000 who carried, and 80,000 rock cutters in the mountains;

<sup>16</sup> beside Solomon's 3,300 chief officers who were over the work, who directed the people who were doing the work.

<sup>17</sup> Then the king commanded, and they cut great stones, costly stones, to lay the foundation of the house / archeology indicates: Phoenicians left their mark in the City of David 3000 years ago.

<sup>18</sup> So the builders of Solomon and the builders of Hiram cut them, so they prepared timber and stones to build the house.
