
## 1 SAMUEL 16 vs 1



In the 350 years of the judges before this book; years characterize by the phrase: and the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the Lord. Obviously, the Lord said enough and sent Samuel, who was the last judge; a good judge, who moved in the power of the Spirit.

This first book of Samuel, focuses on 3 principle people: Samuel, from his birth to his death, Saul, the first king – the people's choice, and David, the blessed king, the Lord's choice.

David is chosen and anointed.



- <sup>1</sup> And the LORD said to Samuel, How long will you mourn for Saul, seeing I have rejected him from reigning over Israel? fill your horn with oil, and go, I will send you to Jesse of Bethlehem: for I have provided Myself a king among his sons.
- <sup>2</sup> And Samuel said, How can I go? if Saul hears of it, he will kill me. And the LORD said, Take a heifer with you, and say, I come to sacrifice to the LORD.
- <sup>3</sup> And invite Jesse to the sacrifice, and I will show you what you will do: and you will anoint for Me him whom I designate to you.
- <sup>4</sup> And Samuel did what the LORD said, and came to Bethlehem. And the elders of the town trembled at his coming, and said, Do you come in peace?
- <sup>5</sup> And he said, In peace I come to sacrifice to the LORD: consecrate yourselves, and come with me to the sacrifice. He also consecrated Jesse and his sons, and invited them to the sacrifice.
- <sup>6</sup> And it happened, when they came, that he looked on Eliab, and said, Surely the LORD'S anointed is before Him.
- <sup>7</sup> But the LORD said to Samuel, Look not on his appearance, or at the height of his stature; because I have rejected him:

for the LORD sees not as man sees, for man looks on the outward appearance, but the LORD looks on the heart.

- <sup>8</sup> Then Jesse called Abinadab, and made him pass before Samuel. And he said, Neither has the LORD chosen this one.
- <sup>9</sup> Then Jesse made Shammah pass by. And he said, Neither has the LORD chosen this one.
- $^{10}$  Again, Jesse made seven of his sons to pass before Samuel. And Samuel said to Jesse, The Lord has not chosen these.

<sup>11</sup> And Samuel said to Jesse, Are all your children here?

And he said, There remains yet the youngest, and, behold, he tends the sheep. And Samuel said to Jesse, Send and get him: for we will not sit down until he comes here.

- <sup>12</sup> So he sent, and brought him in. Now he was **ruddy**, with beautiful eyes, and handsome to see. And the LORD said, Arise, anoint him: for this is he.
- <sup>13</sup> Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brothers: and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel arose, and went to Ramah.
- $^{14}$  Now the Spirit of the LORD departed Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD terrorized him.
- <sup>15</sup> And Saul's servants said to him, Behold now, an evil spirit from God terrorizes you.
- <sup>16</sup> Let our master now command your servants, who are before you, to seek out a man, who is a skillful player on a harp: and it will happen, when the evil spirit from God is on you, that he will play the harp with his hand, and you will be well.
- $^{17}$  So Saul said to his servants, Provide for me now a man who can play well, and bring him to me.
- <sup>18</sup> Then one of the young servants answered, and said, Behold, I have seen a son of Jesse of Bethlehem, who is skillful in playing, and a mighty man of valor, a warrior, one sensible in speech, and a handsome man, and the LORD is with him.
- <sup>19</sup> So Saul sent messengers to Jesse, and said, Send me David you son, who is with the sheep.
- $^{20}$  And Jesse took an ass loaded with food, and a bottle of wine, and a kid-goat, and sent them to Saul by David his son.
- $^{21}$  And David came to Saul, and attended him: and Saul loved him greatly; and he became his armor bearer.
- $^{22}$  And Saul sent to Jesse, saying, Please let David, stand before me; for he has found favor in my sight.
- <sup>23</sup> So it happened, whenever the evil spirit from God came to Saul, David took the harp, and played it with his hand: and Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.
