
1 SAMUEL 21 vs 1



In the 350 years of the judges before this book; years characterize by the phrase: and the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the Lord. Obviously, the Lord said enough and sent Samuel, who was the last judge; a good judge, who moved in the power of the Spirit.

This first book of Samuel, focuses on 3 principle people: Samuel, from his birth to his death, Saul, the first king – the people's choice, and David, the blessed king, the Lord's choice.

David is protected by Ahimelech,



- ¹ Then David came to Nob to Ahimelech the priest: and Ahimelech was fearful at the meeting of David, and said to him, Why are you alone, and no one with you?
- ² And David said to Ahimelech the priest, The king has commissioned me a matter, and has said to me, Let no man know anything of the business where I send you, and what I have commanded you: and I have directed the servants to a certain place.
- ³ So now, what do you have on hand? Give me five loaves of bread, or whatever is found.
- ⁴ And the priest answered David, and said, There is no ordinary bread available, but there is consecrated bread; if only the young men have kept themselves clear of women.
- ⁵ And David answered the priest, and said to him, Surely women have been kept away from us since I set out, and the young men's pouches have been consecrated, even though this is an ordinary mission; how much more will they and their pouches be today with bread?
- ⁶ So the priest gave him consecrated bread: for there was no bread there but the bread of the Presence, that was removed from before the LORD, in order to put hot bread when it was taken away.
- ⁷ Now one of the servants of Saul was there that day, detained before the LORD; and his name was Doeg, an Edomite, the chief of Saul's herdsmen.
- ⁸ And David said to Ahimelech, Now is there not a spear or sword on hand? For I have not brought my sword nor my weapons with me, because the king's matter was urgent.
- ⁹ Then the priest said, The sword of Goliath the Philistine, whom you killed in the valley of Elah, behold, it is wrapped in a cloth behind the ephod: if you will take it for yourself, take it: for there is no other except it here.

And David said, There is none like it; give it to me.

¹⁰ Then David arose and fled that day for fear of Saul, and went to Achish the king of Gath.

¹¹ But the servants of Achish said to him, Is this not David the king of the land? Did they not sing one to another of him as they dance, saying, Saul has slain his thousands, and David his ten thousands?

¹² And David took these words to heart, and was very fearful of Achish the king of Gath.

¹³ And he disguised his behavior before them, and pretended himself crazy in their hands, and scribbled on the doors of the gate, and let his saliva run down his beard.

¹⁴ Then Achish said to his servants, Behold, you see the man is crazy. Why have you brought him to me?

¹⁵ Do I lack crazy men, that you have brought this fellow to act the crazy man in my presence? Will this fellow come into my house?
