
1 SAMUEL 6 vs 1



In the 350 years of the judges before this book; years characterize by the phrase: and the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the Lord. Obviously, the Lord said enough and sent Samuel, who was the last judge; a good judge, who moved in the power of the Spirit. This first book of Samuel, focuses on 3 principle people: Samuel, from his birth to his death, Saul, the first king – the people's choice, and David, the blessed king, the Lord's choice.

The return of the Ark by the Philistines,



- ¹ And the Ark of the LORD was in the country of the Philistines seven months.
- ² And the Philistines called for the priests and the diviners, saying, What will we do with the Ark of the LORD? Tell us how we can return it to its place.
- ³And they said, If you send away the Ark of the God of Israel, do not send it empty; but return to Him a trespass offering: then you will be healed, and it will be known to you why His hand is not removed from you.
- ⁴ Then they asked, What will be the trespass offering which we will return to Him? They answered, Five golden hemorrhoids, and five golden mice, according to the number of the leaders of the Philistines: for one plague was on you all, and on your leaders.
- ⁵ Therefore you will make images like your hemorrhoids, and images like your mice that mar the land; and you will give glory to the God of Israel: perhaps He will ease His hand from off you, and from off your gods, and from off your land.
- ⁶ Why then do you harden your hearts, as the Egyptians and Pharaoh hardened their hearts? When He had worked wonders among them, and did they not let the people go, and they departed? We are grateful to God that the Saudi govt has preserved the Mountain of Moses.
- ⁷ Now therefore take a new cart, and take two milch kine / two cows for milking, on which there has never been a yoke, and hitch the cows to the cart, and take their calves home away from them:
- ⁸ And take the Ark of the LORD, and set it on the cart; and put the jewels of gold which you return to Him for a trespass offering, in a box by its side; and send it away, that it may go.
- ⁹ And watch, if it goes up by the way of its own territory to Beth-shemesh, then He has done us this great evil: but if not, then we will know that it is not His hand that struck us: it happened to us by chance.
- 10 Then the men did so; and took two milking cows, and hitched them to the cart, and penned their calves at home.

 11 And they placed the Ark of the LORD on the cart, and the box with the mice of gold and the images of their hemorrhoids.

¹² And the cows took the direct route to the way of Beth-shemesh, and went along the highway, lowing as they went, and did not turn aside to the right or to the left; and the leaders of the Philistines followed them to the border of Beth-shemesh.

¹³ And those of Beth-shemesh were reaping their wheat harvest in the valley: and they lifted up their eyes, and saw the Ark, and rejoiced to see it.

¹⁴ And the cart came into the field of Joshua, of Beth-shemesh, and stopped where there was a great stone: and they split the wood of the cart, and offered the cows as a burnt offering to the LORD.

¹⁵ And the Levites took down the Ark of the LORD, and the box that was with it, in which were the jewels of gold, and put them on the large stone: and the men of Beth-shemesh offered burnt offerings and sacrificed sacrifices that day to the LORD.

¹⁶ And when the five leaders of the Philistines saw it, they returned to Ekron that day.

¹⁷ And these are the golden hemorrhoids that the Philistines returned for a trespass offering to the LORD; one for Ashdod, one for Gaza, one for Askelon, one for Gath, one for Ekron;

¹⁸ and the golden mice, according to the number of all the cities of the Philistines belonging to the five leaders, both fortified cities, and country villages, even to the large stone of Abel, on which they placed the Ark of the LORD: which stone remains to this day in the field of Joshua, of Beth-shemesh.

¹⁹ And He struck some of the men of Beth-shemesh, because they looked into the Ark of the LORD, and of all the people, He struck 50,070 men: and the people mourned, because the LORD struck many people with a great slaughter.

 20 And the men of Beth-shemesh said, Who is able to stand before the LORD, this holy God? and to whom will He go up from us?

²¹ So they sent messengers to the inhabitants of Kiriath-jearim, saying, The Philistines have brought back the Ark of the LORD; come down, and take it up to you.
