1 THESSALONIANS 2 vs 1




This little letter to this Greek community, written around 50AD... is the first letter Paul wrote to the church Jesus said He was building.

¹ For you yourselves know, brothers and sisters, that our coming to you was not in vain:

² but having suffered, and being mistreated at Philippi, as you know we were bold by our God to speak the good news of God to you in spite of much hostility.

³ For our strong urging was not from error or filth or intent to deceive:



⁴ but as we were approved by God to be entrusted with the good news, even so we speak; not to please people, but rather the One God who examines our hearts.

⁵ For never at any time did we use greasy speech to flatter, as you know, nor had greedy motives - God is witness: / they didn't say what they said, looking for \$\$\$ from anyone.

⁶ nor did we seek the boasts from people, not from you nor from others, even with our weighty power, as ambassadors sent by Christ.

⁷ Instead, we were gentle among you, as a nursing mother warmly cares for her children:

⁸ so fond of you, we were pleased to share with you, not only the good news of God, but also our own lives, because you became very dear to us.

⁹ For you remember our labor and hardship brothers and sisters, night and day, working so not to burden any of you; we proclaimed to you the good news of God.

 10 You are witnesses, and God also, how devotedly, rightly and without blame we worked among you believers:

¹¹ as each of you know, like a father with his own children,

¹² to encourage, and strengthen, and urge you, that you walk worthily of God, who calls you to His kingdom and glory.

¹³ this is why we also give thanks continually to God, because having received the word of God that you heard from us, you received it not as the word of men,

but what it truly is: the word of God, which also works effectively in you who believe.

¹⁴ For you brothers and sisters, became imitators of the churches of God in Christ Jesus that are in Judaea: since you also have suffered the same from your own citizens, just as they did from the Jewish leaders: / isn't it interesting Paul writes this criticism of his own people, he was Jewish

¹⁵ who killed the Lord Jesus, and their own prophets, and expelling us; they displease God, and are hostile to all men:

¹⁶ hindering us to speak to the Gentiles that they might be saved; thereby always filling up their sins: for wrath has come upon them to the utmost.

¹⁷ But after we brothers, being separated from you for a short time -- in person, not in heart, with great desire, we were all the more eager to see your face.

¹⁸ For we wanted to come to you -- even I Paul, more than once; yet Satan hindered us.

¹⁹ For who is our hope or joy, or crown of rejoicing?

²⁰ Indeed you are our glory and joy.
