2 CHRONICLES 3 vs 1



The Bible is so interesting; even the Old Testament. Remember: when reading the 1st and 2nd Chronicles... we read history and events recorded from the perspective of the 2 tribes of the **Southern Kingdom**, the House of **Judah**;

<u>not</u> when reading 1st and 2nd Kings... where we read the historical perspective of the 10 tribes of the **Northern Kingdom**... the House of **Israel**.

Building the temple (971-931bc),

¹ Then Solomon began to build the House of the LORD at Jerusalem on Mount Moriah, where the LORD appeared to David his father, in the place that David had prepared on the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite / threshing floors were



located on high elevation catching the wind to carry away husks, which answers the location where it was built, on the Temple Mount; maybe where the Dome of the Rock is located – since it has never been excavated.

As for the poorly taught church people in the West who know very little about what the Bible actually says; there is NO need for a 3rd Temple to be built before Messiah comes again in power and great glory. The house of Judah rejected the Messiah when He came exactly when prophet Daniel said He would. There is no need for bloody sacrificial offerings. Zechariah says, when Messiah comes again, He will construct what structure He plans to teach under; Isaiah tells us: it is a Tent, which won't take long to set up, will it?!

- ² And he began to build the second day of the second month, in the fourth year of his reign.
- ³ Now here is the plan Solomon made for building the House of God. Its length in the old measurement of cubits; was 90 feet, and its breadth 30 feet.
- ⁴ And the length of front porch that was in the House, was the same breadth of the House, 30 feet, and its height was 180 feet: and he overlaid the interior with pure gold.
- ⁵ And the great hall he sealed with fir, which he overlaid with fine gold, and carved on it palm trees and garlands on its walls.
- ⁶ And he adorned the House with exquisite jewels: and the gold came from Parvaim.
- ⁷ He also overlaid with gold the entire House, its beams, its posts, its walls, and its doors; and engraved cherubim on the walls.
- ⁸ And he made the Most Holy place, its length was according to the breadth of the House, 30 feet abroad, and its breadth was 30 feet: and he overlaid it with 25 tons of fine gold.

⁹ And the weight of the nails was fifty shekels of gold / each nail weighed 2 pounds.

And he overlaid the upper chambers with gold.

- ¹⁰ In the Host Holy place he sculpted two cherubim, and overlaid them with gold.
- 11 And the wings of the cherubim extended 30 feet: one wing of each cherub was five cubits, stretching 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the wall of the House: and the other wing stretching 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet, touching the wing of the other cherub.
- ¹² And the wing of the other cherub was five cubits, extending to the wall of the house: and the other wing was five cubits also, touching the wing of the other cherub.
- ¹³ These cherubim with wings extending 30 feet: they stood on their feet, facing inward.
- ¹⁴ He also had the curtain of fine linen in blue, purple, and scarlet, with cherubim on it.
- 15 Also he erected in front of the House two pillars about 50 feet high, with a capital, 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet in height was on the top of each.
- $^{16}\,\mathrm{And}$ he put garlands like necklaces around the tops of the pillars; stringing upon them 100 pomegranates.
- ¹⁷ And the pillars he erected in front of the temple, one on the right, the other on the left; and called the one on the right Jachin, and the one on the left he called Boaz.
