
2 SAMUEL 22 vs 1

In the 350 years of the judges before this book; years characterize by the phrase: and the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the Lord. Obviously, the Lord said enough and sent Samuel, who was the last good judge, who moved in the power of the Spirit.

This second book of Samuel focuses on the history of the reign of King David, making Jerusalem both the political and religious center of the nation. At this time, Zadok is the high priest. The last chapters in this book include several events not in chronological order.



The Song of David,

- ¹ And David spoke to the LORD the words of this song, in the day the LORD delivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul / this Song is closely related to Psalm 18, David is grateful to God for delivering him from all his enemies:
- ² And he said, The LORD is my Rock, and my Fortress, and my Deliverer;
- ³The God of my Rock; in Him I find shelter: He is my Shield, and the horn who saves, my High tower, and my Refuge, my savior; You save me from violence / from hamas, what filled the earth in the days of Noah.
- ⁴I will call on the LORD, who is worthy to be praised: so I am safe from my enemies.
- ⁵ When the waves of death covered me, the floods of lawless men made me afraid;
- ⁶ the sorrows of hell covered me; the snares of death hindered me;
- ⁷ in my tight spot I called on the LORD, and cried out to my God: and He heard my voice from His holy place, and my cry He did hear.
- ⁸ Then the earth shook and quaked; the foundations of heaven moved and shuddered, because He was angry.
- ⁹ Smoke went from His nostrils, and fire from His mouth devoured: coals were ignited by it.
- ¹⁰ He bowed the heavens also, and came down; and darkness was under His feet.
- ¹¹ And He rode on a cherub, and was swift: and He appeared on the wings of the wind.
- 12 And He made darkness coverings around Him, as deep waters and thick clouds of the skies.
- ¹³ From the brightness before Him, coals of fire were kindled.

- ¹⁴ The LORD thundered from heaven, and the Most High made His voice heard.
- ¹⁵ And He sent out missiles, and scattered them; lightning, and unnerved them.
- 16 And the channels of the sea appeared, the foundations of the world were uncovered, at the rebuke of the LORD, at the blast of the sniff of His nostrils.
- ¹⁷ He sent from on high, He took me; He pulled me out of many turbulent waters.
- $^{18}\,\mathrm{He}$ delivered me from my strongest enemy, and from those who hated me: for they were too strong for me.
- ¹⁹ They hindered me in the day of my calamity: but the LORD was my stay / my anchor.
- 20 He brought me forth to a spacious place: He delivered me, because He delighted in me.
- 21 The LORD rewarded me according to my rightness: according to the cleanness of my hands He repaid me.
- ²² For I guarded the ways of the LORD, and have not wrongly departed from my God.
- ²³ For all His instructions were before me: as for His decrees, I did not depart from them.
- ²⁴ I was also held upright before Him, and have kept myself from my iniquity.
- ²⁵ So the LORD repaid me according to my rightness; according to my cleanness in His sight.
- ²⁶ With the merciful You show yourself merciful, and with the upright You show Yourself upright.
- 27 With the clean You show Yourself clean; and with the perverted You show Yourself clever.
- 28 And the afflicted people You will save: but You watch the arrogant, that You may bring them down.
- ²⁹ For You are my lamp, O LORD: and the LORD enlightens my darkness.
- ³⁰ For by You I have run through a troop: by my God I have leaped over a wall.
- ³¹ As for God, His way is perfect; the word of the LORD is tested: He is a Shield to all who run to Him for shelter.
- ³² For who is God, beside the LORD? and who is a Rock, beside our God?

- ³³ God is my strength and power: and He makes my way complete.
- ³⁴He makes my feet like deer feet: and sets me on my high places.
- ³⁵ He teaches my hands to war; so that a bow of steel is broken by my arms.
- ³⁶ You give me Your shield that saves: and Your kindness makes me great.
- ³⁷ You enlarged my steps under me; so my feet did not slip.
- ³⁸ I pursued my enemies and destroyed them; I did not turn again until I wrecked them.
- ³⁹ And I wrecked them, and injured them, that they could not arise: yes, they fell under my feet.
- ⁴⁰ For You bound me with strength to battle: those who arose against me you subdued under me.
- ⁴¹ You also gave me the necks of my enemies, that I might destroy those who hate me.
- ⁴² They looked, but there was none to save; even to the LORD, but He did not answer them.
- 43 Then I beat them as fine as the dust of the earth, I stamped them as the mud of the street.
- ⁴⁴ You also delivered me from the clashing of my people, you have kept me to be head of the nations: a people who I do not know serve me.
- ⁴⁵ Foreigners submit themselves to me: as soon as they hear, they are obedient to me.
- ⁴⁶ Foreigners will fade away, and they will fear from their enclosed places.
- ⁴⁷ The LORD lives; blessed be my Rock; and exalted is the God of the Rock who saves / Yesha, a diminutive of Yeshua.
- ⁴⁸ It is God who avenges for me, and who subdues the people under me.
- 49 And who delivers me from my enemies: You also lifted me on high above those who arose against me: You delivered me from the violent man.
- ⁵⁰ So I give thanks to You, O LORD, among the nations, and I sing praises to Your Name / surely you know His Name, and His Son's Name Proverbs 30.
- ⁵¹ He is the Tower of Salvation / the High Tower of Yeshua... for His king: and shows mercy to His anointed, to David, and to his seed for evermore.
