
## ACTS 20 vs 1



The previous chapter ended with the town clerk in Ephesus saying: So if Demetrius, and the craftsmen who are with him, have a matter against anyone, the courts are in session, and there are proconsuls: let them plead charges against one another. But if you want something else, it must be determined in a lawful assembly. For we are in danger of being accused of a riot this day, since there is no cause whereby we may give an account for this disorderly gathering. Luke is writing this,

The Ministry around Corinth continues,

And after the uproar ended, Paul called for the disciples, and embraced them, and departed and went to Macedonia.



- <sup>2</sup>And when he had passed through those areas, encouraging them greatly, he came to Greece,
- <sup>3</sup> and there he stayed three months. And as he was about to sail to Syria, a plot was devised by the Jews to ambush him, so he decided to go back through Macedonia.
- <sup>4</sup>And he was accompanied by Sopater of Berea; Aristarchus and Secundus of Thessalonica; and Gaius from Derbe, and Timothy, Tychicus and Trophimus from Asia.
- <sup>5</sup> These men going ahead of us / including Luke, waited at Troas.
- <sup>6</sup> But we sailed away from Philippi after the days of Unleavened Bread, and in five days, came to them at Troas; where we stayed seven days / they were still remembering the 7 great Days of the Lord; shadows of things to come... three of those days are still on the Lord's agenda.
- <sup>7</sup> And on the first day of the week, we gathered to break bread, Paul preached to them, and since he was ready to depart the next day; and extended his words until midnight.
- <sup>8</sup> And there were many lamps in the upper room, where they had gathered together.
- <sup>9</sup> And there, a young man named Eutychus sat on the window sill, and fell into a deep sleep: and as Paul continued preaching, he was overcome with sleep, and fell from the third story, and was picked up dead.
- $^{10}$  But Paul went down, bent over him, embraced him and said, Do not be troubled; for he is still alive.
- <sup>11</sup> So after returning upstairs, breaking bread, and eating, Paul talked with them a long time, until dawn; and then departed.

<sup>12</sup> And they brought the young man home alive, and were greatly comforted.

<sup>13</sup> But we / including Luke went on ahead to the ship, and sailed to Assos, intending from there

to take Paul: for he arranged it, thinking to go by land.

<sup>14</sup> When he met with us at Assos, we took him on board, and came to Mitylene.

<sup>15</sup> Sailing from there, the next day we arrived off Chios; and the next day we arrived at Samos, and waited; and the following day we came to Miletus.

<sup>16</sup> For Paul had decided to sail past Ephesus, so that he would not spend time in Asia: for he was hurrying to be in Jerusalem, if possible on the day of Pentecost.
