
DEUTERONOMY 22 vs 1



Notice: these several chapters 1 - 11 speak about the Covenant God has with His people. There are NO bloody sacrificial or ceremonial laws involved with this Covenant. Faithful men and women in all ages carefully **keep** and **do** these 10 commands... which express the Covenant of God with His people.

The Lord was not lawless. He said, do not think I came to destroy the law or the prophets; whoever relaxes one of the least of the commands and teaches others to do so, will be called least in the kingdom of heaven. And on the first day of the Resurrection, the good news of Messiah did not change: beginning with Moses and the prophets He explained to them things concerning Himself. According to Jesus... loving our Father in heaven with all our heart, soul, mind and strength... is not a bad thing to do; rather, it's a perfect, good thing to do.



Dealing with what is lost and found,

- ¹ You will not see your neighbor's ox or sheep go astray, and pay no attention to them; you will certainly bring them back to your neighbor.
- ² And if your neighbor is not near you, or if you do not know him, then you will bring it home to your house, and it will remain with you until your neighbor looks for it, and you will restore it to him.
- ³ In like manner you will do with his ass; and so you will do with his raiment; and with any lost thing of your neighbor's, which he has lost, and you have found, you will do likewise: you may not neglect your duty.
- ⁴ You will not see your brother's ass or his ox fall down by the road, and hide yourself from them: you will surely help him to lift them up again.
- ⁵ The woman will not wear that which pertains to a man, nor will a man put on a woman's garment: for all that do so are abomination to the LORD your God.
- ⁶ If you happen to come upon a bird's nest before you in the road or in a tree, or on the ground, whether they be young ones, or eggs, and the mother sitting upon the young, or upon the eggs, you will not take the mother with the young:
- ⁷ but you will certainly let the mother go, but the young you may take to yourself; in order that it may be well with you, and that you may prolong your days.
- ⁸ When you build a new house, then you will make a parapet for your roof, that you may not bring blood guilt on your house, if anyone falls from it.

⁹ You will not sow your vineyard with two kinds of seeds: lest the fruit of your seed which you have sown, and the fruit of your vineyard, be defiled.

¹⁰ You will not plow with an ox and an ass together.

- ¹¹ You will not wear a garment made of woolen and linen together.
- 12 You will make yourself fringes upon the four corners of your garment, with which you cover yourself.
- ¹³ If any man takes a wife, and goes in to her, and then turns on her,
- 14 and charges her with shameful things, and publicly speaks against her, and says, I took this woman, but when I came to her, I found she was not a virgin:
- ¹⁵ Then the father of the girl, and her mother, will take and give evidence of the girl's virginity to the elders of the city at the gate:
- ¹⁶ And the girl's father will say to the elders, I gave my daughter to this man for a wife, but he turned against her;
- ¹⁷ And, lo, he has charged her with shameful deeds, saying, I did not find your daughter a virgin; yet this is the evidence of my daughter's virginity. And they will spread the cloth before the elders of the city.
- 18 So the elders of that city will take the man and chastise him;
- ¹⁹ and they will fine him in a hundred shekels of silver, and give them to the father of the girl, because he publicly defamed a virgin of Israel: and she will remain his wife; he may not divorce her all his days.
- 20 But if this charge was true, and the girl was not found to be a virgin:
- ²¹ then they will bring out the girl to the doorway of her father's house, and the men of her city will stone her to death: because she committed a folly in Israel, whoring in her father's house: thus you will purge the evil from among you.
- ²² If a man is found lying with a married woman, then both of them will die, both the man who lay with the woman, and the woman: so you will purge the evil from Israel.

²³ If there is a girl who is a virgin engaged to a husband, and a man finds her in the city, and lies with her;

²⁴ then you will bring them both out to the gate of that city,

and you will stone them with stones that they die; the girl, because she did not cry out in the city; and the man, because he has violated his neighbor's wife. Thus you will purge the evil from among you.



²⁵ But if in the field a man finds a girl who is engaged, and the man forces her, and lies with her: then only the man who lies with her will die.

²⁶ But you will do nothing to the girl; where there is no sin in the girl worthy of death: for just as when a man rises against his neighbor, and kills him, even so is this matter:

²⁷ For he found her in a field, and the engaged girl cried, and there was no one to save her.

²⁸ If a man finds a girl who is a virgin, who is not engaged, and seizes her, and lies with her, and they are discovered;

²⁹ then the man who lay with her will give to the girl's father fifty shekels of silver, and she will become his wife; because he has violated her, he cannot divorce her all his days.

³⁰ A man will not take his father's wife, nor uncover his father's skirt.
