

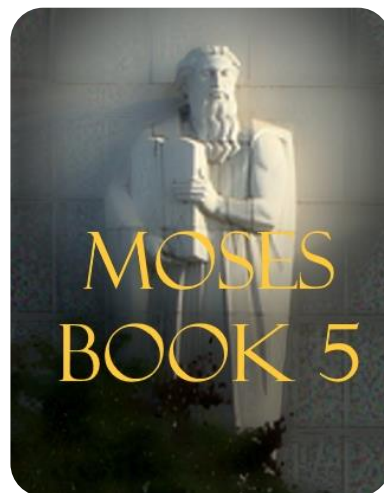
DEUTERONOMY 24 vs 1

Notice: these several chapters 1 - 11 speak about the Covenant God has with His people. There are NO bloody sacrificial or ceremonial laws involved with this Covenant. Faithful men and women in all ages carefully **keep** and **do** these 10 commands... which express the Covenant of God with His people.

The Lord was not lawless. He said, do not think I came to destroy the law or the prophets; whoever relaxes one of the least of the commands and teaches others to do so, will be called least in the kingdom of heaven. And on the first day of the Resurrection, the good news of Messiah did not change: beginning with Moses and the prophets He explained to them things concerning Himself. According to Jesus... loving our Father in heaven with all our heart, soul, mind and strength... is not a bad thing to do; rather, it's a perfect, good thing to do.



Regulating divorce,

¹ When a man takes a wife, and marries her, and it happens that she finds no favor in his eyes, because he found some indecency in her: then let him write her a bill of divorce, and put it in her hand, and send her from his house.

² And when she departs from his house, she goes and becomes wife to another man.

³ And if the latter husband turns against her, and writes her a bill of divorcement, and puts it in her hand, and sends her from his house; or if the latter husband dies, who took her to be his wife;

⁴ then her former husband, who sent her away, may not take her again to be his wife, since she was defiled; for that is an abomination before the LORD: and you will not cause the land to sin, which the LORD your God gives you for an inheritance.

⁵ When a man takes a new wife, he will not go out to war, nor will he be charged with any duty: but he will be free at home one year, and will please his wife which he has taken.

⁶ No one will take a handmill or an upper millstone in pledge: for he would be taking a life in pledge.

⁷ If a man is caught kidnapping any of his brethren of the children of Israel, and makes merchandise of him, or sells him; then that thief will die; and you will purge the evil from among you.

⁸ Be careful against the plague of leprosy, that you diligently observe and do according to all that the Levitical priests teach you: as I commanded them, so you will be careful to do.

⁹ Remember what the LORD your God did to Miriam by the road, after that you came forth from Egypt.

¹⁰ When you make your neighbor a loan of anything, you will not enter his house to take his pledge.

¹¹ You will remain outside, and the man to whom you made the loan will bring the pledge out to you.

¹² And if he is a poor man, you will not sleep with his pledge.

¹³ When the sun goes down, you will surely return the pledge that he may sleep in his own cloak, and bless you: and it will be rightness for you before the LORD your God.

¹⁴ You will not oppress a hired servant who is poor and needy, whether he is one of your brethren, or an outsider who is in your land within your town:

¹⁵ You will give him his wages on his day, before the sun goes down upon it; for he is poor, and sets his heart upon it: lest he cry out against you to the LORD, and it be sin to you.

¹⁶ Fathers will not be put to death for their children, nor will the children be put to death for their fathers: every man will be put to death for his own sin.

¹⁷ You will not pervert the justice due an outsider, nor the fatherless; nor take the garment of a widow in pledge:

¹⁸ but you will remember that you were a slave in Egypt, and the LORD your God redeemed you from there: therefore I am commanding you to do this thing.

¹⁹ When you reap your harvest in your field, and forgot a sheaf in the field, you will not go back to get it: it will be for the outsider, for the fatherless, and for the widow: that the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hands.

²⁰ When you beat your olive tree, you will not go over the boughs again: it will be for the outsider, for the fatherless, and for the widow.

²¹ When you gather the grapes of your vineyard, you will not glean it again: it will be for the outsider, for the fatherless, and for the widow.
