
DEUTERONOMY 25 vs 1



Notice: these several chapters 1 - 11 speak about the Covenant God has with His people. There are NO bloody sacrificial or ceremonial laws involved with this Covenant. Faithful men and women in all ages carefully **keep** and **do** these 10 commands... which express the Covenant of God with His people.

The Lord was not lawless. He said, do not think I came to destroy the law or the prophets; whoever relaxes one of the least of the commands and teaches others to do so, will be called least in the kingdom of heaven. And on the first day of the Resurrection, the good news of Messiah did not change: beginning with Moses and the prophets He explained to them things concerning Himself. According to Jesus... loving our Father in heaven with all our heart, soul, mind and strength... is not a bad thing to do; rather, it's a perfect, good thing to do.



Ruth benefited from this law,

- ¹ If there be a controversy between men, and they come to judgment, that the judges may judge them; then they will justify the righteous, and condemn the wrong.
- 2 And it will be, if the wrong man be worthy to be beaten, that the judge will cause him to lie down, and to be beaten before his face, according to his fault, by a certain number.
- 3 Forty stripes he may give him, and not exceed: lest, if he should exceed, and beat him above these with many stripes, then your brother should seem vile to you.
- 4 You will not muzzle the ox when he treads out the corn.
- 5 If brethren live together, and one of them die, and have no child, the wife of the dead will not marry without to a outsider: her husband's brother will enter to her, and take her to him to wife, and perform the duty of an husband's brother to her.
- 6 And it will be, that the firstborn which she bears will succeed in the name of his brother which is dead, that his name be not put from Israel.
- 7 And if the man like not to take his brother's wife, then let his brother's wife go up to the gate to the elders, and say, My husband's brother refuses to raise up to his brother a name in Israel, he will not perform the duty of my husband's brother.
- 8 Then the elders of his city will call him, and speak to him: and if he stand to it, and say, I like not to take her;

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⁹ Then will his brother's wife come to him in the presence of the elders, and loose his shoe from off his foot, and spit in his face, and will answer and say, So I will be done to that man that will not build up his brother's house.

- 10 And his name will be called in Israel, The house of him that has his shoe loosed.
- ¹¹ When men strive together one with another, and the wife of the one draws near to deliver her husband from the hand of him who strikes him, and puts forth her hand, and takes him by his private part:
- 12 Then you will cut off her hand, you will not pity her.
- ¹³ You will not I have in your bag differing weights, a great and a small.
- ¹⁴ You will not I have in your house differing measures, a great and a small.
- ¹⁵ But you will have a perfect and just weight, a perfect and just measure you will have: that your days may be lengthened in the land which the Lord your God gives you.
- 16 For all that do such things, and all that do uprightly, are an abomination to the LORD your God.
- ¹⁷ Remember what Amalek did to you by the road, when ye were come forth from Egypt;
- 18 How he met you by the road, and smote the hindmost of you, even all that were feeble behind you, when you were faint and weary; and he feared not God.
- ¹⁹ Therefore it will be, when the Lord your God has given you rest from all your enemies around, in the land which the Lord your God gives you for an inheritance to possess it, that you will blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven; you will not forget it.
