

# DEUTERONOMY 31 vs 1

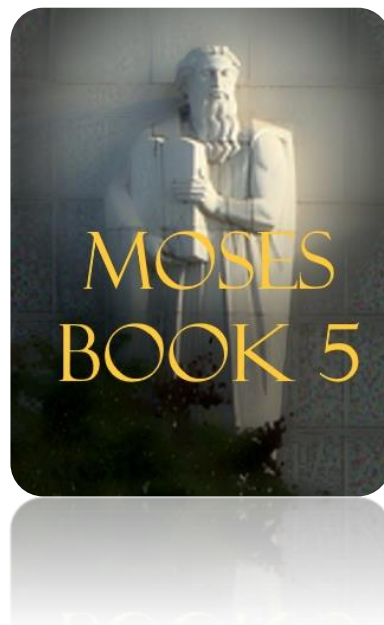

Notice: these several chapters 1 - 11 speak about the Covenant God has with His people. There are NO bloody sacrificial or ceremonial laws involved with this Covenant. Faithful men and women in all ages carefully **keep** and **do** these 10 commands... which express the Covenant of God with His people.

The Lord was not lawless. He said, do not think I came to destroy the law or the prophets; whoever relaxes one of the least of the commands and teaches others to do so, will be called least in the kingdom of heaven. And on the first day of the Resurrection, the good news of Messiah did not change: beginning with Moses and the prophets He explained to them things concerning Himself. According to Jesus... loving our Father in heaven with all our heart, soul, mind and strength... is not a bad thing to do; rather, it's a perfect, good thing to do.

The last responsibilities given by Moses,



**<sup>1</sup> So Moses went and spoke these words to all Israel.**

**<sup>2</sup> And he said to them, I am 120 years old this day; I can no more go out and come in: also the LORD has said to me, You will not go over this Jordan.**

**<sup>3</sup> The LORD your God, He will go over before you, and He will destroy these nations from before you, and you will possess them: and Joshua, he will cross over leading you, as the LORD has said.**

**<sup>4</sup> And the LORD will do to them as He did to Sihon and to Og, kings of the Amorites, and to the land of them, whom He destroyed.**

**<sup>5</sup> And the LORD will give them up before your face, that you may do to them according to all the commands which I have commanded you.**

**<sup>6</sup> Be strong and of a good courage, do not fear, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD your God, he it is that doth go with you; he will not fail you, nor forsake you.**

**<sup>7</sup> And Moses called to Joshua, and said to him in the sight of all Israel, Be strong and of a good courage: for you must go with this people to the land which the Lord has sworn to their fathers to give them; and you will cause them to inherit it.**

**<sup>8</sup> And the LORD, he it is that doth go before you; he will be with you, he will not fail you, nor forsake you: do not fear, nor be dismayed.**

**<sup>9</sup> And Moses wrote this law, and delivered it to the priests the sons of Levi, which bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and to all the elders of Israel.**

**<sup>10</sup> And Moses commanded them, saying, At the end of every seven years, in the solemnity of the year of release, in the feast of tabernacles,**

**<sup>11</sup> When all Israel is come to appear before the LORD your God in the place which he will choose, you will read this law before all Israel in their hearing.**

**<sup>12</sup> Gather the people together, men and women, and children, and your outsider who is within your gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear the LORD your God, and observe to do all the words of this law:**

**<sup>13</sup> And that their children, which have not known anything, may hear, and learn to fear the LORD your God, as long as ye live in the land where you go over Jordan to possess it.**

**<sup>14</sup> And the LORD said to Moses, Behold, your days approach that you must die: call Joshua, and present yourselves in the tabernacle of the congregation, what I may give him a charge. And Moses and Joshua went, and presented themselves in the tabernacle of the congregation.**

**<sup>15</sup> And the LORD appeared in the tabernacle in a pillar of a cloud: and the pillar of the cloud stood over the door of the tabernacle.**

**<sup>16</sup> And the LORD said to Moses, Behold, you will sleep with your fathers; and this people will arise, and go a whoring after the gods of the outsiders of the land, where they go to be among them, and will forsake Me, and break My covenant which I made with them.**

**<sup>17</sup> Then My anger will be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will hide My face from them, and they will be consumed, and many wrongs and troubles will befall them; so that they will say in that day, Is it not because our God is not among us that these wrongs come upon us?**

**<sup>18</sup> But I will surely hide My face in that day for all the wrongs which they have worked, in that they are turned to other gods.**

**<sup>19</sup> Now therefore write this song for yourselves, and teach it to the children of Israel: put it on their lips, that this song may be a witness for Me against the children of Israel.**

**<sup>20</sup> For when I bring them to the land which I pledged to their fathers, that flows with milk and honey; and they have eaten and filled themselves, and grow fat; then will they turn to other gods, and serve them, and provoke Me, and break My covenant.**

**<sup>21</sup> And it will happen, when many wrongs and troubles befall them, that this song will testify against them as a witness; for it will not be forgotten from the lips of their descendants: for I know their intent which they have, even now,**

<sup>22</sup> So Moses wrote this song the same day, and taught it to the children of Israel.

<sup>23</sup> And he gave a charge to Joshua the son of Nun, and said, Be strong and courageous: for you will bring the children of Israel to the land that I pledged to them: and I will be with you.

<sup>24</sup> And it happened, when Moses finished writing the words of this law in the book, until they were complete,

<sup>25</sup> that Moses commanded the Levites, who carried the ark of the covenant of the LORD, saying,

<sup>26</sup> **Take this book of the law**, and put it beside the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, that it remain there for a witness against you.

<sup>27</sup> For I know your rebellion, and your stubbornness: behold, while I am still alive with you today, you have been rebellious against the LORD; and how much more then, after my death?

<sup>28</sup> Assemble to me all the elders of your tribes, and your officers, what I may speak these words in their hearing, and call the heavens and the earth to witness against them.

<sup>29</sup> For I know that after my death you will act corruptly, and turn from the way which I commanded you; and evil will befall you in the latter days; because you will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke Him to anger with the work of your hands.

<sup>30</sup> Then Moses spoke in the hearing of all the assembly of Israel the words of this song, until they were ended.
