
DEUTERONOMY 33 vs 1



Notice: these several chapters 1 - 11 speak about the Covenant God has with His people. There are NO bloody sacrificial or ceremonial laws involved with this Covenant. Faithful men and women in all ages carefully **keep** and **do** these 10 commands... which express the Covenant of God with His people.

The Lord was not lawless. He said, do not think I came to destroy the law or the prophets; whoever relaxes one of the least of the commands and teaches others to do so, will be called least in the kingdom of heaven. And on the first day of the Resurrection, the good news of Messiah did not change: beginning with Moses and the prophets He explained to them things concerning Himself. According to Jesus... loving our Father in heaven with all our heart, soul, mind and strength... is not a bad thing to do; rather, it's a perfect, good thing to do.



The Blessing of Moses to the children of Israel

- ¹ And this is the blessing, Moses the man of God blessed the children of Israel before his death.
- ² And he said, The LORD came from Sinai (in Arabia), and dawned on them from Seir; He shone forth from Mount Paran, and He came with 10,000s of saints: at His right hand went a fiery law for them.
- ³ Yes, He loves the people; all His saints are in Your hand: and they sat down at Your feet; everyone will receive Your words.
- ⁴ Moses charged us with a law, even the inheritance of the assembly of Jacob.
- ⁵ And He was king in Jeshurun, when the heads of the people were gathered; the tribes of Israel altogether.
- ⁶ May Reuben live, and not die; and do not let his men be few.
- ⁷ And this regarding Judah: he said, Hear, O LORD, the voice of Judah, and bring him to his people: with his hands he contended them; and You be a help against his enemies.
- ⁸ And of Levi he said, Let Your Thummim and Your Urim be with Your godly one, whom you did prove at Massah, and with whom you did contend at the waters of Meribah;
- ⁹ who said of his father and to his mother, I did not consider them; nor did he acknowledge his brothers, nor regard his own children: for he observed Your word, and kept Your covenant.

- 10 They will teach Your justice to Jacob, and Your law to Israel: they will put incense before You, and whole burnt offerings upon Your altar.
- ¹¹ Bless his substance, O LORD, and accept the work of his hands; shatter the loins of those who rise up against him, and of those who hate him, that they never rise again.
- ¹² And of Benjamin he said, May the beloved of the LORD live in safety by Him; who shields him all the day long, and dwells between his shoulders.
- ¹³ And of Joseph he said, Blessed of the LORD is His earth, for the precious things of heaven, for the dew, and for the deep lying beneath,
- 14 and for the precious fruits brought forth by the sun, and for the precious things put forth by the moon,
- 15 And for the best things of the ancient mountains, and for the precious things of the everlasting hills,
- ¹⁶ and for the precious things of the earth and its fulness, and for the favor of him who dwells in the bush: let the blessing come upon the head of Joseph, and upon the crown of him who was distinguished from his brethren.
- ¹⁷ His glory is like the firstling of his bullock, and his horns are like the horns of unicorns: with them he will push the people together to the ends of the earth: and they are the 10,000s of Ephraim, and the 1000s of Manasseh.
- $^{\rm 18}$ And of Zebulun he said, Rejoice, Zebulun, in your going out; and, Issachar, in your tents.
- ¹⁹ They will call the people to the mountain; there they will offer sacrifices of righteousness: for they will suck of the abundance of the seas, and of treasures hid in the sand. / and this blessing seems to be fulfilled in the Dutch people fishing, and dyke-building, and their windmills.
- ²⁰ And of Gad he said, Blessed be he who enlarges Gad: he lives as a lion, and tears the arm with the crown of the head,
- ²¹ and he provided the first part for himself, because there, for there the lawgivers portion was he seated; and he came with the leaders of the people, and he executed the justice of the LORD, and his justice with Israel.
- ²² And of Dan he said, Dan is a lion's whelp: he will leap forth from Bashan.
- 23 And of Naphtali he said, O Naphtali, satisfied with favor, and full with the blessing of the LORD: take possession to the west and the south.

²⁴ And of Asher he said, More blessed than children is Asher; let him be favored by his brothers, and let him dip his foot in oil.

25 Your shoes will be iron and brass;

and as your days, so will your strength be.

- 26 There is none like to the God of Jeshurun, who rides the heaven to your help, and through the sky in His majesty.
- ²⁷ The eternal God is your refuge, and underneath are His everlasting arms: and He will throw out the enemy from before you; and will say, Destroy them.
- 28 So $^{\text{Israel}}$ will dwell secluded: the fountain of Jacob in a land of grain and new wine; and heaven also will drop down dew.
- ²⁹ Blessed are you, O Israel: who is like to you, O people saved by the LORD, who is the shield of your help, and who is the sword of your excellency! So your enemies will be found liars / some say, so your enemies will cringe before you; and you will trample on their high places.
