

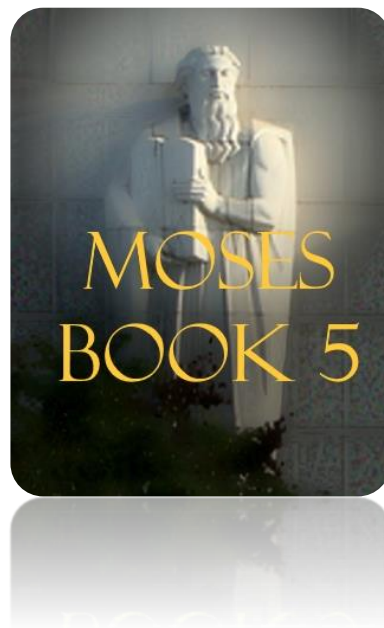
# DEUTERONOMY 3 vs 1

Notice: these several chapters 1 - 11 speak about the Covenant God has with His people. There are NO bloody sacrificial or ceremonial laws involved with this Covenant. Faithful men and women in all ages carefully **keep** and **do** these 10 commands... which express the Covenant of God with His people. **God saved His people from Egypt**

The Lord was not lawless. He said, do not think I came to destroy the law or the prophets; whoever relaxes one of the least of the commands and teaches others to do so, will be called least in the kingdom of heaven. And on the first day of the Resurrection, the good news of Messiah did not change: beginning with Moses and the prophets He explained to them things concerning Himself. According to Jesus... loving our Father in heaven with all our heart, soul, mind and strength... is not a bad thing to do; rather, it's a perfect, good thing to do **even if it is done imperfectly; because we will always need His help.**

**<sup>1</sup> Then we turned, and went up the road to Bashan: and Og the king of Bashan with all his people came out against us, to battle at Edrei.**

**<sup>2</sup> But the LORD said to me, Do not fear him: for I have delivered him and all his people, and his land into your hand; and you will do to him as you did to Sihon king of the Amorites, who lived at Heshbon.**

**<sup>3</sup> So the LORD our God delivered Og, king of Bashan and all his people into our hands also: and we smote them until no survivor remained.**

**<sup>4</sup> And we captured all his cities at that time; there was not a city which we did not capture from them, 60 cities, all the region of Argob, the kingdom of Og in Bashan.**

**<sup>5</sup> All these cities were fortified with high walls, gates, and bars; beside a great many unwallled towns.**

**<sup>6</sup> And we utterly destroyed them, as we did to Sihon king of Heshbon, utterly destroying men, women, and children of every city.**

**<sup>7</sup> But all the animals, and the spoil of the cities, we took for our booty.**

**<sup>8</sup> Thus we took the land at that time from the hand of the two kings of the Amorites who were beyond the Jordan, from the valley of Arnon to Mount Hermon;**

**<sup>9</sup> (Sidonians call Hermon Sirion; and the Amorites call it Senir;)**

<sup>10</sup> all the cities of the plain, and all Gilead, and all Bashan, as far as Salecah and Edrei, cities of the kingdom of Og in Bashan / [these verses speaks to when Balaam and his ass, saw in the distance, the multitude of the children of Israel approaching](#) – Numbers 23.

<sup>11</sup> For only Og king of Bashan remained of the remnant of giants; behold his bedstead was an iron bed; it is in Rabbah of the children of Ammon. Its length was nine cubits, and its width four cubits, after the cubit of a man / its length and width about 13 ½ feet by 6 feet.

<sup>12</sup> So we took possession of this land at that time, from Aroer, by the valley of Arnon, and half the hill country of Gilead, and its cities, I gave to the Reubenites and the Gadites.

<sup>13</sup> And the rest of Gilead, and all Bashan, the kingdom of Og, I gave to the half tribe of **Manasseh**; all the region of Argob, ( concerning all Bashan, it is called the land of giants).

<sup>14</sup> Jair the son of Manasseh took all the region of Argob as far as the border of Geshurites and Maacathites, and called it -- that is Bashan, after his own name, Havvoth-jair, to this day.

<sup>15</sup> And to Machir I gave Gilead.

<sup>16</sup> And to the Reubenites and to the Gadites, I gave from Gilead even as far as the valley of Arnon. The middle of the valley as a border as far as the river Jabbok, the border of the children of Ammon;

<sup>17</sup> the Arabah also, with the Jordan as its border, from Chinnereth even as far as the sea of the Arabah, even the Salt Sea, at the foot of the slopes of Pisgah on the east.

<sup>18</sup> Then I commanded you at that time, saying, The LORD your God has given you this land to possess it: all you valiant men will cross over armed before your brothers, the children of Israel, all who are eligible to war.

<sup>19</sup> But your wives, and your little ones, and your animals, (for I know that you have many animals,) will remain in your cities which I have given you;

<sup>20</sup> until the LORD gives rest to your brethren, as well as to you, and they also possess the land which the LORD your God has given them beyond Jordan: and then you may return every man to his possession, which I have given you.

<sup>21</sup> And I commanded Joshua at that time, saying, Your eyes have seen all that the LORD your God has done to these two kings: so the LORD will do to all the kingdoms where you cross over.

<sup>22</sup> **Do not fear them: for the LORD your God, He fights for you.**

<sup>23</sup> And I sought the LORD at that time, saying,

<sup>24</sup> O LORD God, You have begun to show Your servant Your greatness, and Your mighty hand: for what God is there in heaven or on earth, who can do according to Your works, and according to Your might?

<sup>25</sup> Let me, I pray, cross over and see the good land that is beyond the Jordan, that good hill country, and Lebanon.

<sup>26</sup> But the LORD was angry with me on your account, and would not listen to me: and the LORD said to me, Enough; speak no more to Me of this matter.

<sup>27</sup> Go to the top of Pisgah, and lift up your eyes to the west, and north, and south, and east, and see it with your eyes: for you will not cross over this Jordan.

<sup>28</sup> But charge Joshua, and encourage him, and strengthen him: for he will cross over ahead of this people, and he will give them as an inheritance the land which you will see.

<sup>29</sup> So we remained in the valley opposite Beth-peor.
