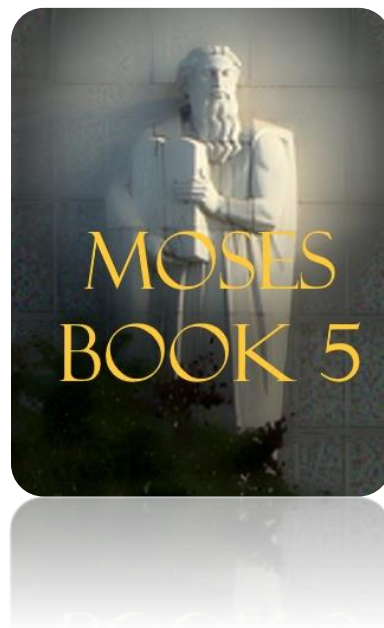


# DEUTERONOMY 7 vs 1

**Warning to the readers:** You are about to enter the land first promised to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob 4500 years ago: **Do not proceed** without doing what our Father God in heaven kindly asked His people to keep and do in these chapters: Deuteronomy 4, 5, 6 - 7, 8, 9, 10, 11; or you will not understand the repeated fair warnings of the later prophets: Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel and Daniel, or all the minor prophets from Hosea to Malachi...



<sup>1</sup> When the LORD your God brings you into the land where you go to possess it, and **throws out** many nations before you, the Hittites, the Girgashites, the Amorites, the Canaanites, the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites, seven nations greater and mightier than you / notice these 7 nations are thrown out by the Lord God...they are the cursed sons of Ham's lineage, cursed by Noah. As His people approach these nations... His terrifying power goes before them; He knows there are always hardheads who think they can challenge the living God;

<sup>2</sup> and when the LORD your God delivers them before you / when the last holdouts remain; defeat them and completely destroy them; make **no** covenant with them, show **no** mercy to them / these ruthless pagan leftover warriors were to be annihilated:

<sup>3</sup> Do **not** intermarry with them; do **not** give your daughters to his sons, do **not** take his daughters for your sons.

<sup>4</sup> For they will turn your sons away from following Me, to serve other gods: then the anger of the LORD will be ignited against you, and He will quickly destroy you.

<sup>5</sup> But thus do to them: destroy their altars, smash their images, cut down their Asherim, and burn their graven images with fire / everything associated with Baal worship was to be annihilated by the all-male army -- the fathers and sons of the House of Israel.

<sup>6</sup> For you are a holy people / a holy nation... to the LORD your God: the LORD your God chose you to be a people / a nation... for His own possession from all the peoples / from all the nations... who are on the face of the **earth**.

<sup>7</sup> **The LORD did not set His love on you,** or choose you because you were more numerous than any of the peoples / any of the nations; they were not a spectacular acting nation that caught the Lord's attention; for you were the fewest of all peoples / the littlest of all the nations:

<sup>8</sup> **but because the LORD loved you,** because He would keep the oath He pledged to your forefathers, the LORD brought you out by His mighty hand, and redeemed you from the house of slavery, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.

<sup>9</sup> So, know the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God, who **keeps** covenant and mercy **with those who love Him** and **keep** His commandments to the thousandth generation;

<sup>10</sup> but He repays those who hate Him to their face, to destroy them / the night He was betrayed, Jesus said, He who does not love Me, does not keep My words, and the word which you hear is not mine, but the Father's who sent Me – **John14:**

He will **not** delay with him who hates Him, He will repay him to his face.

<sup>11</sup> **Keep** the commandments, statutes, and judgments which I command you this day, to **do** them.

<sup>12</sup> Then it will happen, if you listen to these judgments, and **keep** and **do** them, that the LORD your God will **keep** with you His covenant and mercy which He swore to your forefathers:

And listen to how He responds to those who will have no other gods but Him, who make no graven images to bow down and worship, who will keep His sabbath day holy; who honor father and mother, who do not murder, adulterate, steal or falsely accuse anyone; and who covet nothing of their neighbor...

<sup>13</sup> He will **love** you, **bend the knee**, and **multiply** **[1]** you: / God almighty willingly humbles Himself and gets down in the dirt to work with His people who seek to learn from Him...and **multiply**

**[2]** the fruit of your womb,

**[3]** and the fruit of your land, your grain, your new wine, and your oil,

**[4]** and the increase of your herds, and the flocks of your sheep, in the land which He pledged to your forefathers.

<sup>14</sup> You will be blessed above all nations: there will **not** be a male or female barren among you, or among your cattle.

<sup>15</sup> **[5]** and the LORD will remove all sickness from you, and will put none of the harmful diseases of Egypt which you have known, upon you; but will put them on all who hate you.

<sup>16</sup> So, destroy all those nations whom the LORD your God will deliver to you; look on them with **no** pity, do **not** serve their gods; for that will be a snare to you / all 7 nations were trespassing squatters on the land who brought their pagan practices, and who have been given warning to pack their bags and leave... don't feel sorry for those inspired to sacrifice their children:

<sup>17</sup> But if you say in your heart, these nations are greater than me; how can I dispossess them? / the Lord already said He was going before His people... to drive out these heathen; He leads from the front... not like cowardly, fake leaders on earth who lead with their behind.

<sup>18</sup> Do **not** fear them: but remember what the LORD your God did to Pharaoh and to all Egypt;

<sup>19</sup> remember the great trials which your own eyes saw, the signs and the wonders, the mighty hand and outstretched arm by which the LORD your God brought you out; so, the LORD your God will do to all the people whom you fear / to help His people; and hinder His enemies; He will get in the dirt with His people; and do whatever it takes to deliver them.

<sup>20</sup> Moreover the LORD your God will send hornets against them until those who are left - who hide themselves from you, are destroyed / all creation is in His arsenal.

<sup>21</sup> Do **not** dread them: for the LORD your God is among you, a mighty and awesome God.

<sup>22</sup> The LORD your God will clear away these nations before you **little by little**:

you will **not** destroy them at once, lest the wild beasts grow too numerous for you / the Lord was not leading a mass slaughter of people; He was allowing each trespassing group of squatters to pack their bags and leave at their earliest convenience; as wild beasts gathered to clean up carcasses.

<sup>23</sup> But the LORD your God will deliver them to you, and will cause them a great confusion until they are destroyed / He will even use weather to disrupt the devious schemes of His enemies.

<sup>24</sup> He will deliver their kings into your hand; you will destroy their name from under heaven / the VIPs of mankind will quickly fade and be forgotten: **no one will withstand you** / notice: it does not say they won't resist; but those who do, the Lord says, **destroy them**.

<sup>25</sup> The graven images of their gods, **you are to burn with fire**, do **not** covet the silver or gold that is on them, do **not** take it for yourself / God says, get rid of all that stuff: only one image, not made of wood or stone God allows, and what is it? His only begotten Son full of grace and truth,

lest you be snared by it for it is an abomination to the LORD your God / so you are not trapped by all the glitter; God our Creator and Maker... does not need pagan relics and religious junk... to advance His agenda; and neither do His people.

<sup>26</sup> Do **not** bring any abomination into your house, and like it, you become accursed: but utterly detest it, and utterly abhor it; for it is accursed / If God said don't do it, well, don't do it.
