Without doing what our Father God in heaven kindly asked His people to **keep** and **do** **at Mount Sinai in Arabia**, in these chapters: Deuteronomy 4, 5, 6, 7 – 11; you will not understand the repeated fair warnings of the later prophets: Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel and Daniel, or all the minor prophets from Hosea to Malachi...

¹ All the commandments which I command you today / all 10 commandments; no more, no less – learn the 10... write them on your minds and hearts... and do them,

you will **keep and **do**, that you live and multiply, and go in and possess the land which the Lord swore to your forefathers / it certainly does not sound like our Father God is some raving maniac, does it? It does sound like He is a loving Father who cares for His children and is training them.**

² Remember all the way the Lord your God led you these forty years in the wilderness, humbling you, testing you,

to know what is in your heart / to know what stuff we are really made of,

whether you **keep His commandments, or **not**.**

³ He humbled you, allowing you to hunger / it is good to be hungry; we have opportunities to learn when we have occasion to fast and go without; we are reminded many in the world are hungry; many in the church world are starving to death... just to hear the promises found in the word of God,

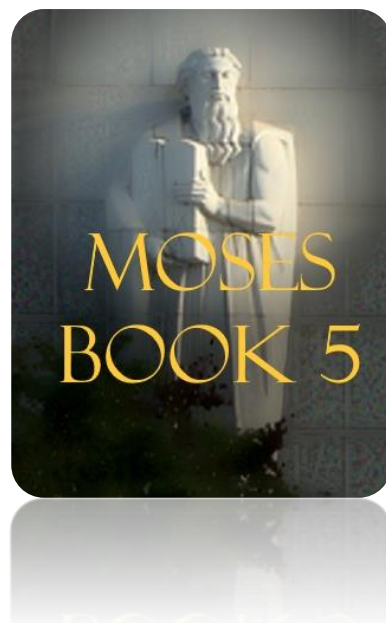
and fed you with manna which you did **not know, and your fathers did **not** know / and why was all this educating and assaying and humiliation?**

that He makes you to know that man does **not live by bread only / that the one who proceeds from Adam's lineage understands there is more to life than meets the eye,**

but man lives **by every word that proceeds from the mouth of the Lord / Hudson Taylor said: There is a God in heaven, He has spoken in His word. He means what He said, and plans to do all that He has promised. Jesus said, heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will never pass away. The Lord expects His people to mark His words on their hands – as they labor in public; to hide His words in their minds – in their private devotion; this is proof they have the mark of God in their hand and forehead.**

⁴ Your clothing did **not wear old on you, your foot did **not** swell, these forty years / for 40 years... Wow! That's hard to imagine. Where on earth did we get the idea our Father God is mean? Certainly, not from Jesus, He greatly loved His Father who is our Father, too.**

that, as a man disciplines his son, so also the LORD your God disciplines you / another Wow! God wants to train His children; that is good to know. Do you go to a doctor who is not trained? Will you fly on an airplane with a pilot who is not trained? Do you put your money in the hands of a bank teller who does not count? Our God is not an absent Father; He is very kind to train each of us.

⁶ Therefore you will **keep the commandments of the Lord your God,**

to walk in His ways and to **fear Him /** those 10 commands tell us a lot about the Lord. Moses came to know God's ways -- he could say, that's the way God is; that is why God does what He does; but the people only saw His actions -- they just looked for miracles -- **Psalm 104:7**. We need to know God better, we need to be stopped dead in our tracks as if struck by a bolt of lightning, or confronted by someone with a gun; there is nothing wrong with fearing God. He's different than us, He sure is smarter than us, even smarter than the most brutal tyrant He allows to temporarily exist in His creation.

⁷ For the LORD your God brings you to a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and springs flowing from valleys and hills;

⁸ a land of wheat and barley, of vines and fig trees and pomegranates; a land of oil olive and honey;

⁹ a land where you will eat food without scarcity, and you will lack nothing; a land whose stones are iron, and from whose hills you can dig copper / it is a good land, and in His original plan... before some stubborn folks started complaining and led a rebellion; it only would have taken 10 days, going through the wilderness to get to this **good land**.



¹⁰ When you eat and are full, **then **bend the knee** to the Lord your God for the good land He gave you /** in the previous chapter we learn twice it says: God bends His knee to work with and help His people multiply and increase; and because talk is cheap, it is easy to mindlessly pray... and eat like pigs; but what if we change the order: and end with thanks to God for all He provided.



¹¹ Beware you do not forget the LORD your God, and do not **keep His commandments, judgments, and statutes, which I command you today /** that we retell and remind our family and our friends... when we rise up, when we lay down... when we work, when we play...we teach our children the 10 great commands of our God:



¹² Lest when you have eaten and are full, and have built good houses, and live;

¹³ Lest when your herds and your flocks multiply, and your silver and your gold multiplies, and all that you have multiplies;

➡ ¹⁴ Then your heart becomes **proud**, and you **forget** the LORD your God, who brought you from the land of Egypt, from the house of slavery;

¹⁵ He led you through that great and terrible wilderness, with its fiery serpents and scorpions, with that dry ground where there was **no** water / in 3 short days without water and we start to die;

He brought water for you out of the rock of flint.

¹⁶ He fed you in the wilderness with manna, which your fathers did **not** know / He led them through all these terrifying situations, so that they would not forget,

that humbling you, and testing you, to do you good in the end;

¹⁷ Lest you say in your heart / in case you carelessly embezzle His blessings, and foolishly think in your mind, and thoughtlessly say in your deepest, most inner-being,



➡ **my** power... and **my** mighty hand

has given **me** this wealth.

¹⁸ But you will remember **the Lord your God** / and every word that proceeds from His mouth:

for it is He who gives you the power to gain wealth, He establishes His covenant which He pledged to your forefathers today.

And now Moses gives a final warning to the people of God:

¹⁹ And it will happen,

if you forget the LORD your God, and follow after other gods, and slavishly serve, or foolishly bow down to worship them / who are not gods, because there aren't any gods than the One God who created us – and He knows what He is talking about, and He wants us to know whatever we

might place in front of Him... whatever we bow down and serve... even our own self... it will only have deadly results,

then...

I testify against you today, **you will perish** / the Lord God makes a public pledge to His people should they wander from Him, or decide to go shopping around the neighborhood, or outright abandon Him; this is not a veiled threat; our Father God speaks clearly to His children, He says you will be destroyed.

²⁰ As the nations which the LORD destroyed before your face, **so you will perish** because you would **not** obey the voice of the LORD your God.
