

- ⁴ for we have been sold, I and my people, to be destroyed, to be killed, and be annihilated. Now if we had only been sold as slaves, men and women, I would have remained silent, for the trouble would not be commensurate with troubling the king.
- ⁵ Then King Ahasuerus answered and asked Queen Esther, Who is he, and where is he, who dares to presume in his heart to do thus?
- ⁶ And Esther said, an adversary and enemy is this evil Haman. Then Haman became terrified before the king and the queen.
- ⁷ And the king arose in his anger from drinking wine, and went into the palace garden: but Haman stayed to beg for his life from Queen Esther; for he saw that harm was determined against him by the king.
- ⁸ Now when the king returned from the palace garden into where they were drinking wine; Haman was falling upon the bed where Esther was.

Then the king said, Will he even assault the queen with me in the house? As the word went out of the king's mouth, they covered Haman's face.

⁹ Then Harbonah, one of the eunuchs who were before the king said, Behold indeed, the gallows standing at the house of Haman, 75 feet high, which Haman made for Mordecai, who spoke good on behalf of the king.
