EXODUS 13 vs 1




10 Plagues are recorded before Pharaoh finally lets the people of the Lord go; a list that parallels the papyrus lpuwer. And if you really think this chapter is too fantastic to believe, well then check out the natural catastrophe at Lake NYOS in Cameroon, 1986. That sequence of plagues similarly effected those living around Lake NYOS.


- 1. The Rivers turn to blood.
- 2. Frogs come next, frogs know how to hop out of the deadly water, but they don't do well on dry land
- 3. Lice or gnats follow the frogs; frogs that hopped too far, died on the dry land; and the insects had a feast
- 4. Flies follow the lice and gnats, shortly after to also munch on all the millions of dead carcasses.
- 5. Pestilence on their cattle.
- 6. Boils, again check out the catastrophe at Lake NYOS Cameroon
- 7. Hail and fire.
- 8. Locusts.
- 9. Darkness.
- 10. Death of the firstborn.

The great expulsion of the Hyksos (1453bc) (the Semitic Shepherd Kings) from their home in Avaris, capital of the Hyksos rulers, living in the fertile delta of the Nile River of Goshen; this is recorded on the Stele of **Pharaoh AH-MOSE I**; whose 12-year-old son, Prince Sapair died that dark night. All this research is fully and carefully discussed in Simcha Jacobovici's incredible documentary: Exodus Decoded and the Real Mount Sinai.



- ¹ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,
- ² Consecrate to Me all the firstborn, whatever opens the womb among the children of Israel, of man and beast: it is Mine.
- ³ And Moses said to the people, Remember this day, when you exited Egypt, the house of bondage; for by His strong hand the LORD brought you from this place: nothing leavened is to be eaten.
- ⁴ This day you are exiting in the month Abib / the first of seven days on the Lord's calendar.
- ⁵ And it will be when the LORD brings you to the land of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites, which He pledged to your fathers to give you, a land flowing with milk and honey, that you will work this service in this month.





EXODUS 13 vs 1



⁶ Seven days you will eat unleavened bread, and the seventh day will be a feast to the LORD.


⁷ Unleavened bread will be eaten seven days; and no leavened bread will be seen among you, nor will there be leaven seen among you in all your living quarters.

⁸ And you will tell your son on that day, saying, This is done because of what the LORD did to me when I exited Egypt.

⁹ And it will be to you as a sign on your hand, and as a reminder between your eyes / and hopefully between your eyes are your brains to remember, that the law of the LORD be in your mouth: for with a strong hand the LORD brought you from Egypt.

¹⁰ So you will keep / guard to protect... this ordinance in its season from year to year.

¹¹ And it will be when the LORD brings you to the land of the Canaanites, as He pledged to you and your fathers, and gives it to you,



 12 that you will set apart to the LORD all that opens the womb, and every firstborn offspring of cattle you have; the males will be the LORD'S.

¹³ And every firstborn of an ass you will redeem with a lamb; and if you will not redeem it, then you will break its neck: and all the firstborn man among your children will you redeem.

¹⁴ So it will be when your son asks you in the future, saying, What is this? you will say to him, With a strong hand the LORD brought us from Egypt, from the house of bondage:

¹⁵ and it happened, when stubborn Pharaoh would not let us go, the LORD killed all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, the firstborn of man, and the firstborn of beast: so I sacrifice to the LORD all males that open the womb; but all the firstborn of my children I redeem.

¹⁶ And it will be tied on your hand and between your eyes as a sign / knotted to your hand as you work, and your mind as you remember: for by His strong hand the LORD brought us from Egypt.

¹⁷ And it happened, when Pharaoh let the people go,

that God led them not through the way of the land of the Philistines, although that was near; for God said.


In case the people reconsider when they see war, and they return to Egypt:

¹⁸ So God led the people around, through the way of the wilderness of the Red Sea: and the children of Israel went up in fives from the land of Egypt / about 50 miles south of where king Solomon harbored his massive fleet of ships; enormous markers of where Moses and the people of God crossed Yom Suph, erected on both sides by Solomon were still standing into the 21st century.


¹⁹ And Moses took the bones of Joseph with him: for he had rightly pledged to the children of Israel, saying, God will surely visit you; and you will carry my bones away from here with you.



²¹ And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of cloud, to lead them the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light; to go by day and night:

²² He did not take away the pillar of cloud by day, nor the pillar of fire by night, from before the people.
