Two half-Egyptian brothers -- elder sons of Joseph, were given blessings that would last until the time of the Gentiles is fulfilled; **Ephraim** carried all the birthright promises first given to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob; he would become a commonwealth of many nations in the last days; Manasseh would become the great nation; both would be engaged at the center of the earth: they will be seen promoting their policies and practices. Starting in this chapter, Moses tells us an interesting detail about who these people are; distinctive by traditional colors they carried through their wilderness journey until they entered the land promised to their forefather Abraham.

A study of heraldry helps us to know who these people were and where they went. The **colors** they would carry will be emphasized in chapters: 25, 26, 27, 28, 35, 36, 38 and 39; a reoccurring detail mentioned in this book of Exodus 25 more times; so pay attention.



- ¹ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,
- ² Speak to the children of Israel, that they bring Me an offering: from every man who willingly gives it with his heart, you will take My offering.
- ³ And this is the offering which you will take from them: gold, and silver, and brass / remember these items were provided them by the Egyptians as they left,
- ⁴ and blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine linen / which is White, and goat's hair / what are these colored fabrics for?



And don't you love how the Lord expects us to pay attention to the detail of His word? Think about it: **purple** is the color of royalty (Abraham was from the royal lineage of Noah) which leaves the other three colors mentioned; why? for what purpose?

Blue Scarlet and Fine Linen; and we might ask: do those colors look familiar? what nations carry those colors still today?

- ⁵ And rams' skins dyed red, and badger skins, and shittim wood,
- ⁶ Oil for the light, spices for anointing oil, and for sweet incense,
- ⁷ Onyx stones, and stones to be set in the ephod, and in the breastplate.
- ⁸ And let them make Me a sanctuary; that I may dwell among them.





⁹ According to all that I show you, after the pattern of the tabernacle, and the pattern of all its furnishings, even so will you make it.

¹⁰ And they will make an Ark of shittim wood: two cubits and a half will be its length, and a cubit and a half its breadth, and a cubit and a half its height.

¹¹ And you will overlay it with pure gold, inside and outside you will overlay it, and will make on it a molding of gold all around.

¹² And you will cast for it four rings of gold, and put them on its four corners; and two rings will be on its one side, and two rings on its other side.



¹³ And you will make polls of shittim wood, and overlay them with gold.

 14 And you will put the polls into the rings on the sides of the ark, that the ark may be carried with them.

 15 The polls will be in the rings of the ark: they will not be taken from it.

¹⁶ And you will put into the Ark of the Testimony which I give you.

 17 And you will make a mercy seat of pure gold: two cubits and a half will be its length, and a cubit and a half its breadth.

 $^{18}\,\mathrm{And}$ you will make two cherubim of gold, of hammered work will you make them, at the two ends of the mercy seat.

 19 And make one cherub at the one end, and the other cherub at the other end: even of the mercy seat you will make the cherubim at its two ends.

²⁰ And the cherubim will stretch out their wings above, covering the mercy seat with their wings, and their faces will look one to another; toward the mercy seat will be the faces of the cherubim.

²¹ And you will put the mercy seat on top of the ark; and in the ark you will put the Testimony that I will give you.



- ²² And there I will meet with you, and I will speak to you from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubim which are on the Ark of the Testimony, of every thing which I will give you in commandment to the children of Israel.
- ²³ You will also make a Table of shittim wood: two cubits will be its length, and a cubit its breadth, and a cubit and a half its height.
- ²⁴ And you will overlay it with pure gold, and make a molding of gold all around.
- 25 And you will make for it a frame of a hand breadth all around, and you will make a golden molding for its frame all around.
- ²⁶ And you will make for it four rings of gold, and put the rings in the four corners that are on its four feet.
- ²⁷ Next to the frame will the rings be for places of the polls to carry the Table.
- ²⁸ And you will make the polls of shittim wood, and overlay them with gold, that the table may be carried with them.



- ²⁹ And you will make its dishes, and its cups, and its pitchers, and its bowls, to cover withal: of pure gold will you make them.
- ³⁰ And you will set on the Table of the Bread of the Presence before Me always.
- ³¹ And you will make a Lampstand of pure gold: of hammered work will the Lampstand be made: its shaft, and its branches, its bowls, its bulbs, and its flowers, will be of the same.
- ³² And six branches will go from its sides; three branches of the Lampstand from its one side, and three branches of the Lampstand from its other side:
- ³³ three cups shaped like almond blossoms, with a bulb and a flower in its one branch; and three cups shaped like almond blossoms, with a bulb and a flower in its other branch: so for six branches going from the Lampstand.
- ³⁴ And in the Lampstand will be four bowls made like almond blossoms, with their bulbs and their flowers.
- ³⁵ And there will be a bulb under the first two branches of the same, and a bulb under the second two branches of the same, and a bulb under the third two branches of the same, according to the six branches that proceed out of the Lampstand.



³⁶ Their bulbs and their branches will be of the same: all of it will be one hammered work of pure gold.

- ³⁷ And you will make for it seven lamps: and they will light its lamps, that they give light in front of it.
- ³⁸ And its tongs, and its snuffers and trays will be of pure gold,
- ³⁹ with a talent of pure gold / 75 pounds will it be made, with all these vessels.
- ⁴⁰ And see that you fashion them according to the pattern that you were shown on the mountain.
