EXODUS 26 vs 1



Where is Sinai? Is it where we see on most maps; or is it in Midian (modern Saudi Arabia) where Moses lived for years, where he saw the burning bush? And is it the same place where Paul went in Arabia after his Damascus experience; where he received teaching directly from the risen Lord? The sea of Edom Is where those of Esau resettled along the Red Sea named after their father Esau whose name means; red.

1 You are to make the Tent with ten curtains of fine woven white linen, and blue, and purple, and scarlet: with a skillful design of cherubim work into them.

² Each curtain will be 42 feet long, and 6 feet wide: and all the curtains will have the same measure.



- ³ Five curtains will be joined together; and the other five curtains will be joined together.
- ⁴ Make loops of blue yarn on the edge of the last curtain in the first group; and do the same on the outer edge of the second group of curtains.
- ⁵ Make 50 loops on the edge of the first curtain, and 50 on the edge of the curtain the second group; so that the loops line up with one another.
- ⁶ Also make fifty claps of gold, and join the curtains together with the claps: so that the Tent is a single unit.
- ⁷ You are to make curtains of goats' hair to covering over the Tent: make eleven of these curtains.
- ⁸ Each curtain will be 45 feet long, and 6 feet wide. The eleven curtains will be the same measure.
- ⁹ Join 5 of the curtains by themselves, and the other 6 curtains by themselves. The fold the 6^{th} curtain at the front of the Tent.
- ¹⁰ Make 50 loops on the edge of the furthest curtain in the group, and 50 loops on the edge of the corresponding curtain that joins the second group.
- ¹¹Make 50 clasps of bronze, and put the clasps through the loops, and join the Tent together, that it be one unit.

- ¹² As for what remains of the curtains of the Tent, the remaining half curtain, will hang over the back of the Tent.
- ¹³ What remains along the length of the Tent curtains -- it will hang over the sides of the Tent, on either side to cover it.
- ¹⁴ And you will make a covering for the Tent of ram skins dyed red, and a covering above of badger skins.
- ¹⁵ You will make 10 upright supports for the Tent of acacia wood.
- ¹⁶ Each support board will be 15 feet long and 27 inches wide.
- 17 Each support board will have 2 tenons for joining. Do the same for all the boards of the Tent.
- ¹⁸ Make the support boards for the Tent, twenty boards on the south side.
- ¹⁹ And make 40 silver bases under the 20 support boards; two bases under the first support board for its two tenons, and two bases under another next support board for its two tenons.
- ²⁰ And 20 support boards for the second side of the Tent, on the north side:
- 21 along with their 40 silver bases; two bases under one support board, and two bases under the next support board.
- ²² And for the west side of the Tent make six support boards.
- ²³ And two additional boards make for both sides of the corners of the Tent.
- ²⁴ They are to be joined together at the bottom, and joined together at the top in one ring: thus it will be for both of them; they will be for the two corners.
- 25 There will be eight support boards, with silver bases, sixteen bases; two bases under the first support board, and two bases under each support board.
- ²⁶ You will make five crossbars of acacia wood; for the support boards of the one side of the Tent,
- 27 and five crossbars for the support boards on the other side of the Tent, and five crossbars for the support boards on the backside of the Tent, on the west.

²⁸ The central crossbar goes through the middle of the support boards from one end to the other end.

²⁹ Then overlay the support boards with gold, and make their rings of gold to hold the crossbars: and overlay the crossbars with gold.

³⁰ You will raise up the Tent according to its plan which was shown you on the mountain.

³¹ You will make a curtain of blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine woven white linen of made with a skillful design of cherubim work:



³² Hang it on four pillars of acacia wood overlaid with gold: with hooks of gold, that stand on the four silver bases.

³³ Hang up the curtain under the clasps, and bring the ark of the testimony there behind the curtain: so the curtain will separate you between the holy place and the most holy place.

³⁴ Put the mercy seat on the ark of the testimony in the most holy place.

³⁵ And set the table outside the curtain, and the lampstand on the south side of the Tent opposite the table; put the table on the north side.

³⁶ And for the entrance of the Tent, make a screen embroidered with blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine woven white linen.

³⁷ And make five pillars of acacia wood, overlay them with gold, and their hooks are to be gold: and you are to cast five bronze bases for them.
