

# EXODUS 28 vs 1

Where is Sinai? Is it where we see on most maps; or is it in Midian (modern Saudi Arabia) where Moses lived for years, where he saw the burning bush? And is it the same place where Paul went in Arabia after his Damascus experience; where he received teaching directly from the risen Lord? The **sea of Edom** Is where those of **Esau** resettled along the **Red Sea** named after their father **Esau** whose name means: **red**.

The Priests garments,

**<sup>1</sup> Have your brother Aaron, and his sons come to you, from among the children of Israel, to minister to Me as priest -- Aaron, his sons Nadab, Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar.**

**<sup>2</sup> And make holy garments for Aaron your brother for glory and for beauty.**

**<sup>3</sup> Instruct all that are skilled artisans, whom I have filled with the spirit of wisdom, to make Aaron's garments to consecrate him, that he may serve Me as priest.**

**<sup>4</sup> These are the garments they will make; a breastplate, an ephod, a robe, an embroidered tunic, a turban and a sash. They are to make holy garments for your brother Aaron, and his sons so they may serve Me as priests.**

**<sup>5</sup> They should use gold, **blue**, **purple**, **scarlet**, and fine white linen.**

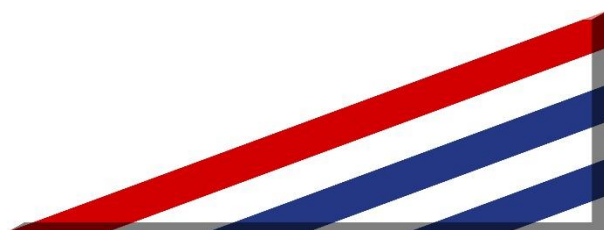
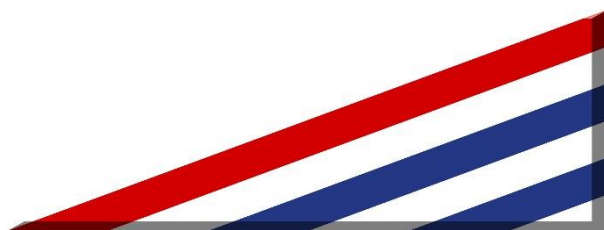
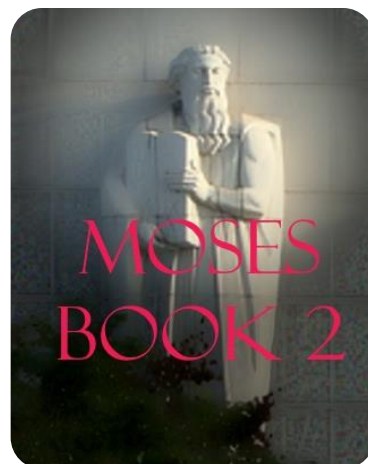
The Ephod,

**<sup>6</sup> They will also make the ephod of gold, embroidered with **blue**, **purple**, **scarlet**, and fine woven white linen.**

**<sup>7</sup> It will have its shoulder pieces joined at its two edges; and so it will be joined together.**

**<sup>8</sup> And the sash that is on the ephod, will be of the same, according to its work; even of gold, **blue**, **purple**, **scarlet**, and fine woven linen.**

**<sup>9</sup> Take two onyx stones, and engrave on them the names of the children of Israel:**

<sup>10</sup> six of their names on one stone, and the other six names on the other stone, in order of their birth.

<sup>11</sup> Engrave the two stones with the names of the children of Israel: like a gem cutter engraves a seal. Set them surrounded in gold filigree.

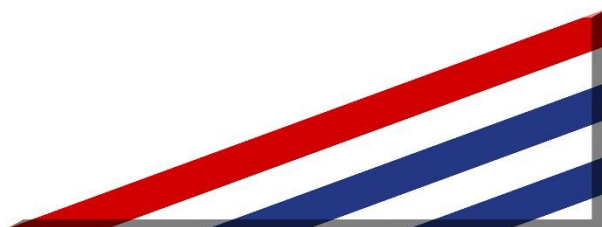
<sup>12</sup> Fasten the two stones on the shoulders of the ephod as memorial stones for the children of Israel: and Aaron will carry their names before the Lord on his two shoulders as a reminder.

<sup>13</sup> And you will make gold filigree settings;

<sup>14</sup> and two chains of pure gold; you will make them of braided cord work, and fasten the braided chains to the settings.

The Breastplate,

<sup>15</sup> Make an embroidered breastplate of justice; just like the ephod; make it of gold, blue, purple, scarlet, and of fine woven white linen.



<sup>16</sup> Make it square and folded doubled; 9 inches long and 9 inches wide.

<sup>17</sup> Put a setting of stones on it, four rows of stones: the first row: sardius, topaz, and carbuncle:

<sup>18</sup> The second row: emerald, sapphire, and diamond.

<sup>19</sup> The third row: jacinth, agate, and amethyst.

<sup>20</sup> And the fourth row: beryl, onyx, and jasper; they will be in settings of gold filigree.

<sup>21</sup> The 12 stones will relate to the names of the 12 children of Israel, like the engraving of a seal; each stone with its name will relate to one of the twelve tribes.

<sup>22</sup> Make for the breastplate braided chains of pure gold.

<sup>23</sup> Make two rings of gold for the breastplate, and attach the two rings on the two ends of the breastplate.

<sup>24</sup> Then attach the two braided chains of gold to the two rings which are on the ends of the breastplate.

<sup>25</sup> And the other two ends of the two braided chains fasten to the two filigree settings, and in this way attach them to the front of the shoulder pieces of the ephod.

<sup>26</sup> Make two rings of gold, and put them on the two ends of the breastplate at its inner border next to the ephod.

<sup>27</sup> And make two other rings of gold, and attach them at the bottom of both sides of the ephod on its front, near its seam, above the ephod waistband.

<sup>28</sup> They will tie the breastplate by its rings through the rings of the ephod with a cord of **blue**, so that it is above the ephod waistband, so that it does not come loose from the ephod.

<sup>29</sup> Aaron will carry the names of the children of Israel on the breastplate of justice over his heart, when he enters the holy place, to always remember in the presence of the Lord.

<sup>30</sup> Place in the breastplate of justice, the Urim and the Thummim; and they will be on Aaron's heart, when he enters the presence of the Lord: and Aaron will always carry the justice of the children of Israel on his heart before the Lord.

The Robe,

<sup>31</sup> You are to make the robe of the ephod all of **blue**.

<sup>32</sup> And there will be an opening at the center of it in its top: around the opening there will be a woven collar with an opening like body armor, so that it does not tear.

<sup>33</sup> Beneath the hem of it, make pomegranates of **blue**, **purple** and **scarlet**, around its hem; and bells of gold between them all around:

<sup>34</sup> a golden bell and a pomegranate, a golden bell and a pomegranate, on the hem of the robe round about.

<sup>35</sup> And it will be on Aaron to minister: and his sound will be heard when he enters the holy place before the Lord, and when he comes out, that he does not die.

The Turban,

<sup>36</sup> Make a plate of pure gold, engrave it, like engraving a seal, **HOLY TO THE LORD.**

<sup>37</sup> Put on it a **blue** lace, that it may be on the turban; it is to be on the front of the turban.

<sup>38</sup> And it will be on Aaron's forehead, that Aaron may bear the guilt of the holy things, which the children of Israel will consecrate as all their holy gifts; and it will be always on his forehead, that they may find acceptance with the Lord.

<sup>39</sup> You will weave a tunic of fine white linen, and will make a turban of fine white linen, and embroider a sash.

<sup>40</sup> And for Aaron's sons make tunics, sashes, and headbands for them, to give them glory and beauty.

<sup>41</sup> Put these on Aaron your brother, and his sons; then anoint them, and consecrate them, and set them apart, that they may minister to Me as priests.

<sup>42</sup> Make them linen undergarments to cover their naked bodies; they must extend from the waist to the thighs:

<sup>43</sup> These must be worn by Aaron and his sons, when they enter the Tent of the assembly, or when they approach the altar to minister in the holy place; that they do not incur guilt and die. This is a statute for him and his descendants after him, forever.
