

# EXODUS 34 vs 1

Where is Sinai? Is it where we see on most maps; or is it in Midian (modern Saudi Arabia) where Moses lived for years, where he saw the burning bush? And is it the same place where Paul went in Arabia after his Damascus experience; where he received teaching directly from the risen Lord? The **sea of Edom** is where those of **Esau** resettled along the **Red Sea** named after their father **Esau** whose name means: **red**.

The Covenant renewed,

**<sup>1</sup> The Lord said to Moses, Cut two stone tablets like the first: and I will write on them the words that were on the first tablets, which you broke.**

**<sup>2</sup> Be ready by morning, and come up in the morning to Mount Sinai, and present yourself there to Me on the mountaintop.**

**<sup>3</sup> No man may go up with you, and let no one be seen anywhere on the mountain; nor let flocks or herds graze in front of that mountain.**

**<sup>4</sup> So Moses cut two stone tablets like the first; and Moses got up early in the morning, and took the two stone tablets, and went up to Mount Sinai, as the Lord instructed him.**

**<sup>5</sup> The Lord descended in the cloud, and stood with him, as He called upon the name of the Lord.**

**<sup>6</sup> The Lord passed in front of him, and proclaimed, The Lord, The Lord God, merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in goodness and truth,**

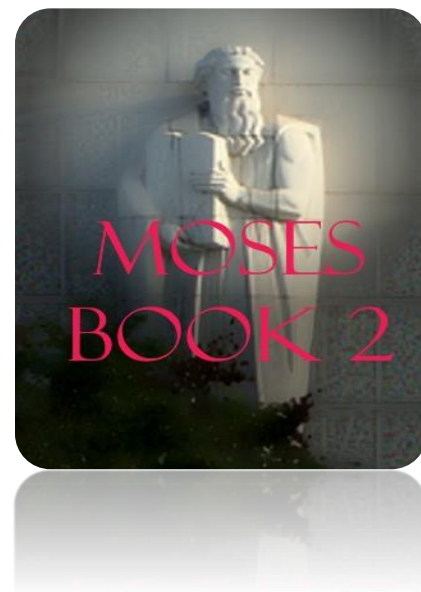
**<sup>7</sup> guarding mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity, stepping over the line, and sin, but He will not clear the guilty; bringing the consequences of the fathers on the children and grandchildren, to the third and fourth generation.**

**<sup>8</sup> Moses immediately bowed his head to the earth, and worshiped.**

**<sup>9</sup> Then he said, O Lord, If I have indeed found favor with You, I pray my Lord, please go with us; though the people are stubborn; forgive our iniquity and our sin, and take us as Your own possession.**

Covenant Obligations,

**<sup>10</sup> And The Lord said, See, I make a covenant: before all your people I will do wonders, such as have not been done in all the earth, nor in any nation. All the people you live among will see the Lord's work for what I do with you is awesome.**



# EXODUS 34 vs 1

<sup>11</sup> Observe what I instruct you today: See, I drive out before you the Amorites, Canaanites, Hittites, Perizzites, Hivites, and Jebusites.

<sup>12</sup> Be warned, lest you make a covenant with the inhabitants of the earth, wherever you go, lest it become for you a snare among you:

<sup>13</sup> but you must destroy their altars, smash their images, and chop down their Asherah poles:

<sup>14</sup> because the Lord is jealous for His work, you will not bow to another god: for He is a jealous God:

<sup>15</sup> lest you make a pact with the residents of the land, and prostitute yourself after their demon gods, and sacrifice to their gods, and one invite you, and you eat of their sacrifices.

<sup>16</sup> and you take of their daughters for your sons, and their daughters will prostitute themselves with their gods, and cause your sons to prostitute themselves with their demon gods.

<sup>17</sup> Do not make molten images of demon gods.

<sup>18</sup> Guard the Festival of unleavened bread. Seven days you will eat unleavened bread, as I instructed you, in the appointed time of the month Abib: for in the month Abib you came out from Egypt.

<sup>19</sup> The firstborn male from every womb is Mine; all your firstborn cattle, whether ox or sheep.

<sup>20</sup> But the firstborn of a jackass you may redeem with a lamb: but if you do not redeem it, then break its neck. All the firstborn of your sons you will redeem. And no one will appear before Me empty-handed.

<sup>21</sup> Six days you labor, but on the seventh day you rest: in time of plowing and harvesting you will rest.

<sup>22</sup> And you will guard the feast of weeks, of the firstfruits of wheat harvest, and the feast of ingathering at the year's end. / the 7 weeks in spring leading to Pentecost; and the festival after all the work is ready for harvest. These 3 days are still shadows of things to come, 3 work days for when Messiah comes again.

<sup>23</sup> Three times a year all your men must appear before the Lord God, the God of Israel.

<sup>24</sup> For I will toss out the nations before you, and enlarge your borders: no one will covet your land, when you go up three times a year to appear before the Lord your God.

<sup>25</sup> Do not offer Me a blood sacrifice with leaven; the Passover feast offering must not remain till morning.

**26** Bring the first of your land with you to the house of the Lord your God. You must not boil a young goat in its mother's milk.

**27** The Lord said to Moses, Write these words: for based on these words, I have made a covenant with you and Israel.

**28** And he was there with the Lord forty days and forty nights; he neither eat bread nor drank water. And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant, the ten instructions.

The Radiant Face of Moses,

**29** And it happened, when Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the two tables of testimony in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him.

**30** When Aaron and all of Israel saw Moses, indeed, the skin of his face shone; and they feared to come near him.

**31** But Moses called out to them; so Aaron and all the rulers of the assembly returned to him: and Moses spoke to them.

**32** Afterward all Israel came near: and he instructed them in all that the Lord told him on Mount Sinai.

**33** And when Moses finished speaking with them, he put a covering over his face.

**34** But when Moses went in before the Lord to speak with Him, he removed the covering, until he came out. And when he came out, he told those of Israel what he was instructed.

**35** And all Israel saw that the face of Moses was radiant. Then Moses put the covering over his face again, until he went to speak with the Lord.
