


Where is Sinai? Is it where we see on most maps; or is it in Midian (modern Saudi Arabia) where Moses lived for years, where he saw the burning bush? And is it the same place where Paul went in Arabia after his Damascus experience; where he received teaching directly from the risen Lord? The sea of Edom Is where those of Esau resettled along the Red Sea named after their father Esau whose name means: red.

The Building the Tent,

- <sup>1</sup> Moses gathered all the assembly of the children of Israel, and said to them, These words are what the Lord instructed, that you should do them.
- <sup>2</sup> Six days work will be done, but the seventh day will be a holy day, a sabbath of rest to the Lord: whoever works on it will be put to death.



- <sup>4</sup> And Moses said to the entire assembly of all Israel, saying, This is what the Lord instructed, saying,
- <sup>5</sup> Take up an offering among you for the Lord: Let all with a willing heart bring gold, silver and bronze,
- <sup>6</sup> and blue, purple, scarlet, and fine woven white linen, and goat hair,
- <sup>7</sup> and ram skins dyed red, and badger skins; acacia wood,
- <sup>8</sup> and oil for the light; spices for the anointing oil, and for the fragrant incense,
- <sup>9</sup> and onyx with gem stones to mount on the ephod, and breastplate.
- <sup>10</sup> Let all skilled artisans among you come, and make everything the Lord has instructed;
- <sup>11</sup> the Tent -- its tent and covering, its clasps and supports, its crossbars, pillars, and bases,
- $^{12}$  the ark with its poles, the mercy seat, and the curtain for the screen,
- 13 the table with its poles, all its utensils, and the Bread of the Presence,
- <sup>14</sup> the lampstand for light, and its utensils and its lamps, with oil for the light,
- $^{15}$  the incense altar, and its poles, the anointing oil, and the fragrant incense, and the entrance screen for the Tent,

<sup>16</sup> the altar of burnt offering, with its bronze grate, its poles, and all its utensils; the basin and its stand,

<sup>17</sup> the hangings of the courtyard, its pillars and bases, and the screen for the gate of the courtyard,

<sup>18</sup> the tent pegs of the Tent, and the pegs for the courtyard, with their ropes,

<sup>19</sup> the garments for service, to serve in the holy place, the holy garments for Aaron the priest, and garments for his sons, to minister in the office of the priest.

<sup>20</sup> And all the assembly of all Israel left the presence of Moses.

<sup>21</sup> And every one whose heart was moved, and every one whose spirit was prompted, brought an offering to the Lord for the work on the Tent of the assembly, for all its service, and for the holy garments.

<sup>22</sup> Both men and women came, all who were prompted brought bracelets, earrings, rings, necklaces, all sorts of gold jewelry -- everyone who offered an offering of gold to the Lord.

<sup>23</sup> And everyone, who had blue, purple, scarlet, and fine woven white linen, and goat hair, and ram skins dyed red, and badger skins, brought them.

<sup>24</sup> Everyone offering silver or bronze brought it as an offering to the Lord. Everyone, who had acacia wood for any task of the service, brought it.

<sup>25</sup> And all the women that were wise hearted did spin with their hands, and brought that which they had spun, both of blue, purple, scarlet, and fine woven white linen.



<sup>26</sup> And all the skilled women whose heart stirred them, spun goat hair.

<sup>27</sup> And the rulers brought onyx and gemstones to mount on the ephod, and breastplate;

 $^{28}$  and spice, and oil for the light, and for the anointing oil, and for the sweet incense.

<sup>29</sup> So all Israel brought a willing offering to the Lord, every man and woman, whose heart was prompted to bring something for all the work, that the Lord, through Moses had instructed to be done.

Bezaleel and Oholiab,

<sup>30</sup> Then Moses said to those of Israel, See, the Lord has called by name Bezaleel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah;

<sup>31</sup> He has filled him with the spirit of God, with wisdom, understanding, and knowhow in every craft;

<sup>32</sup> and to design every stunning work, in gold, silver and bronze,

<sup>33</sup> to cut gemstones to mount, and to carve wood, for work in every kind of artistic craft.

<sup>34</sup> He has also given both him and Aholiab, the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan the ability to teach others.

<sup>35</sup> He has filled them with skill to do all the work of an engraver, designer and embroiderer, blue, purple, scarlet, and fine woven white linen weaver, as performers of any work and maker of designs.
