EXODUS 36 vs 1



Where is Sinai? Is it where we see on most maps; or is it in Midian (modern Saudi Arabia) where Moses lived for years, where he saw the burning bush? And is it the same place where Paul went in Arabia after his Damascus experience; where he received teaching directly from the risen Lord? The sea of Edom Is where those of Esau resettled along the Red Sea named after their father Esau whose name means: red.

Bezaleel and Aholiab.

- Then Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every skillful person, in whom the Lord put wisdom and understanding to know how to do all the work for building the sanctuary, according to all that the Lord had instructed.
- ²And Moses called Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every skilled person, in whose heart the Lord had put wisdom, all whose hearts moved them to come to the work and do it:



- ³ and they took from Moses's presence all the offerings that those of **Israel** had brought for the task of all it takes making the sanctuary. They also brought him freewill offerings each morning.
- ⁴ Then all the artisans who were doing all the work of the sanctuary, came one by one from the work he was doing;
- ⁵And they said to Moses, saying, The people are bringing much more than is needed for the work, that the Lord instructed to be done.
- ⁶So Moses gave an order, and announced throughout the camp, saying, Let no man nor woman make anything else as an offering for the sanctuary. So the people stopped.
- ⁷ For what stuff they had was sufficient for them to do all the work. There was more than enough.

Building the Tent,

- ⁸ All the skilled artisans among those doing the work made the Tent with the ten curtains of with blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine woven white linen: with cherubim of cunning work made he them.
- ⁹ Each curtain forty-two feet long, and six feet wide. All the curtains were of the same size.
- ¹⁰ He joined five of the curtains to each other: and the other five curtains he joined to each other.

- ¹¹ And he made loops of blue yarn on the edge of the last curtain in the first set, and did the same on the edge of the outermost curtain in the second set.
- 12 He made fifty loops on one curtain, and fifty loops on the edge of the curtain in the second set: so that the loops lined up with each other.
- ¹³ And he made fifty gold clasps and joined the curtains to each other: so that the Tent was a single unit.
- ¹⁴ He made curtains of goat hair for a tent over the Tent: he made eleven of them.
- ¹⁵ Each curtain was forty -five feet long, and six feet wide: all eleven curtains were the same size.
- ¹⁶ And he joined five of the curtains together, and the other six curtains together.
- 17 He made fifty loops on the edge of the outermost curtain in the first set, and fifty loops on the edge of the corresponding curtain in the second set.
- ¹⁸ And he made fifty bronze clasps to join the tent together, as a single unit.
- ¹⁹ Also he made a covering for the tent from ram skins dyed red, and a covering of badgers skins on top of it.
- ²⁰ And he made upright supports of acacia wood for the Tent.
- ²¹ Each support was 15 feet long and 27 inches wide.
- ²² Each support had two tenons, for joining one to another: he did the same for all the support of the Tent.
- 23 And he made supports for the Tent: twenty supports for the south side:
- 24 and he made forty silver bases to put under the twenty supports; two bases under the first support for its two tenons, and two bases under another support for its two tenons.
- ²⁵ For the other side of the Tent, the north side, he made twenty supports,
- ²⁶ and their forty silver bases; two bases under the first support, and two bases under another support.
- 27 And for the back side of the Tent westward he made six supports.
- 28 And two supports he made for the two back corners of the Tent.
- ²⁹ And they were paired at the bottom, and joined together at its head, at the top in one ring: this he did with both of them for the two corners.

- ³⁰ There were eight supports; with their 16 silver bases, two bases under each one.
- ³¹ And he made five crossbars of acacia wood; for the supports on one side of the Tent,
- ³² and five crossbars for the supports on the other side of the Tent, and five bars for the supports on the west side of the Tent.
- ³³ And he made the central crossbar to run through the supports from one end to the other.
- ³⁴ Then he overlaid the supports with gold, and made their rings of gold as holders for the crossbars, also overlaid with gold.
- ³⁵ And he made a curtain with blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine woven white linen: he made it with a design of cherubim worked into it.
- ³⁶ He made four pillars of acacia wood for it, and overlaid them with gold: their hooks were of gold; and he cast for them four silver bases.
- ³⁷ And he made an embroidered hanging screen for the Tent door with blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine woven white linen;
- ³⁸ with its five pillars and their hooks: and he overlaid their tops of the pillars and their bands with gold, but their five bases were of bronze.
