EXODUS 37 vs 1


Making the Ark,

- ¹ Then Bezaleel made the ark of acacia wood:45 inches long, 27 inches wide, and 27 inches heigh:
- ² he overlaid it with pure gold inside and out, made a molding of gold all around it.
- ³ And he cast four gold rings for it, for its four feet, two rings on one side and two rings on its other side.
- ⁴ And he made poles of acacia wood, and overlaid them with gold.
- ⁵ And he inserted the poles into the rings on the sides of the ark, to carry the ark.
- ⁶ He made the mercy seat of pure gold: 45 inches long, and 27 inches wide.
- ⁷ And he made two cherubim of gold, hammered work at the two ends of the mercy seat;
- ⁸ one cherub at one end, and one cherub at the other end. At each end he made a cherub of one piece with the mercy seat.
- ⁹The cherubim extended their wings on high; they faced each other, and covered the mercy seat with their wings. The faces of the cherubim looked toward the mercy seat.

Making the Table,

¹⁰ And he constructed the table of acacia wood 36 inches long, 18 inches wide and 27 inches high:

- ¹¹ then he overlaid it with pure gold, and made for it a gold molding all around it.
- 12 Also he made a 3 inch frame all around it, and made a gold molding all around its frame.



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- ¹³ He cast four gold rings, and attached the rings to the four corners of its four feet.
- ¹⁴ The rings were next to the frame as holders of the poles to care the table.
- ¹⁵ He made the poles of acacia wood, and overlaid them with gold, to carry the table.
- ¹⁶ Also he made the utensils which were on the table, its dishes, spoons, and its bowls, all overlaid with gold.

Making The Lampstand,

- ¹⁷Then he made the lampstand of hammered pure gold: he made it all of one piece; its base and shaft, its ornamental cups, and its buds and petals:
- ¹⁸ Six branches extended from its sides; three branches of the lampstand from one side, and three branches of the lampstand from the other side:
- ¹⁹ Three cups were shaped like almond blossoms; each with a bud and petals, on one branch, and three cups shaped like almond blossoms. Each with a bud and petals, on the next branch. It was this way for the six branches extending from the lampstand.
- ²⁰ On the lampstand shaft there were four cups shaped like almond blossoms, with its buds and petals:
- ²¹ and for the six branches extending from it, a bud was under the first pair of branches from it, a bud under the second pair of branches from it, and a bud under the third pair of branches from it.
- ²² Their buds and branches were of one piece with it: all of it was a single hammered piece of pure gold.
- ²³ And he made its seven lamps, snuffers, and firepans of pure gold.
- ²⁴ He made it and all its utensils of 75 pounds of pure gold.

Making The Altar of Incense,

- And he made the altar of incense from acacia wood: it was square 18 inches long, 18 inches wide; and 36 inches high; its horns one piece with it.
- 26 And he overlaid its top, all around its sides, and its horns with pure gold: he also made a gold molding all around it.
- ²⁷ He made two rings of gold for it under the molding on two of its sides; he put these on opposite sides to be holders for the poles to carry it.

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²⁸ And he made the poles of acacia wood, and overlaid them with gold.

²⁹ He also made the holy anointing oil, and the pure fragrant, and expertly blended incense.
