## **EXODUS 6 vs 1**




In God's economy, He knows some things may take a little extra time to convince Moses to keep going. The Lord, who is long-suffering and indulgent to the errors and infirmities of his people, made allowance for the indignity Moses experienced as the result of his first meeting with Pharaoh. God satisfied Moses in an answer to his complaints in the close of the previous chapter. He gives him fuller instructions than had yet been given him, what to say to the children of Israel; and He sends him again to Pharaoh -- Matthew Henry.

Remember, Israel means... isra = ruled + EI = God; ruled by God

<sup>1</sup> Then the LORD said to Moses, Now will you see what I will do to Pharaoh: for with a strong hand will he let them go, and with a strong hand will he drive them from his land.





- <sup>3</sup> And I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, by the name of God Almighty, but by My name YHWH was I not known to them.
- <sup>4</sup> And I have also established My covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land of their pilgrimage, wherein they were strangers.
- <sup>5</sup> And I have also heard the groaning of the children of **Israel**, whom the Egyptians keep in bondage; and I have remembered My covenant.
- <sup>6</sup> Say therefore to the children of Israel, I am the Lord, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with a stretched-out arm, and with great judgments:
- $^7$  and I will take you for My people, and I will be to your God: and you will know I am the LORD your God, who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
- <sup>8</sup> And I will bring you to the land which I swore to give it to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob; and I will give it you for a heritage: I am the LORD.
- <sup>9</sup> So Moses spoke to the children of **Israel**: but they did not listen to Moses for their despondency, and cruel bondage.
- $^{10}$  And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,
- 11 Go, tell Pharaoh king of Egypt,

to let the children of Israel go from his land.

<sup>12</sup> But Moses spoke before the LORD, saying, Behold, the children of Israel have not listened to me; how then will Pharaoh listen to me, for I am unskilled in speech?

<sup>13</sup> Then the LORD spoke to Moses and to Aaron, and gave them a charge to the children of Israel and to Pharaoh king of Egypt, to bring the children of Israel from the land of Egypt.

The genealogy of Moses and Arron

<sup>14</sup> These are the heads of their fathers' households:

The sons of Reuben the firstborn of Israel; Hanoch, and Pallu, Hezron, and Carmi: these are the families of Reuben.

<sup>15</sup> And the sons of Simeon; Jemuel, and Jamin, and Ohad, and Jachin, and Zohar, and Shaul the son of a Canaanite woman: these are the families of Simeon.

<sup>16</sup> And these are the names of the sons of Levi according to their generations; Gershon, and Kohath, and Merari: and the years of the life of Levi were a hundred thirty-seven years.

<sup>17</sup> The sons of Gershon; Libni, and Shimei, according to their families.

<sup>18</sup> And the sons of Kohath; Amram, and Izhar, and Hebron, and Uzziel: and the years of the life of Kohath were a hundred thirty-three years.

 $^{19}$  And the sons of Merari; Mahli and Mushi: these are the families of Levi according to their generations.

<sup>20</sup> And Amram took him Jochebed his father's sister to wife;

and she bare him **Aaron** and **Moses**:

and the years of the life of Amram were a hundred thirty-seven years.

<sup>21</sup> And the sons of Izhar; Korah, and Nepheg, and Zichri.

<sup>22</sup> And the sons of Uzziel; Mishael, and Elzaphan, and Sithri.

<sup>23</sup> And Aaron took him Elisheba, daughter of Amminadab, sister of Naashon, to wife; and she bare him Nadab, and Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar.

<sup>24</sup> And the sons of Korah: Assir, and Elkanah, and Abiasaph:

these are the families of the Korahites.

<sup>25</sup> And Eleazar Aaron's son took him one of the daughters of Putiel to wife; and she bare him Phinehas: these are the heads of the fathers of the Levites according to their families.

<sup>26</sup> These are the same Aaron and Moses, to whom the LORD said: Bring out the children of Israel from the land of Egypt according to their armies.

<sup>27</sup> They are the ones who spoke to Pharaoh king of Egypt, to bring out the children of Israel from Egypt:

these are the same Moses and Aaron.

<sup>28</sup> And it happened on the day when the LORD spoke to Moses in the land of Egypt,

<sup>29</sup> that the LORD spoke to Moses, saving, I am the LORD: speak to Pharaoh king of Egypt all that I say to you.

<sup>30</sup> And Moses said before the LORD, Behold, I am unskilled in speech:

how will Pharaoh listen to me?
