¹ The word of the Lord came again to me, saying,

Thus says the Lord God / aren't you glad our God speaks to His people?

Howl / Wail, How terrible the day! / Ezekiel says, you have your day now, when you carry all before you, and trample on all about you, but God will have His day.

- ³ For the day is near, the day of the Lord is near, a cloudy day, a time of great testing for the nations / a dark and dismal day; Jesus spoke of when the time of the Gentiles comes to a close.
- ⁴ A sword will come upon Egypt, and anguish will be in Ethiopia / the judgment starts with Egypt, but will quickly spread; and it will end with justice on the brutish nations today; it will be an Oh crap, kind of a day. Interesting, with the massive dam project under construction, modern Ethiopia controls the headwaters of the Nile River. Something is happening in South Sudan; will Ethiopia be uncharitable?

when the slain will fall in Egypt, and her multitude is carried away, and her foundations are broken down.

⁵ Ethiopia, and Libya, and Lydia / Cush, Put, and Lud, and all Arabia, and Cub, and the people of the earth who are in league / this is a bunch of mercenaries who comprise the Arab league; and recall it was the strange American policies that already totaled Libya,

will fall with them by the sword / they will die the way they lived: by the sword.

⁶ Thus says the Lord;

Those who support Egypt will fall; and her powerfully proud leaders will come down; from Migdol to Syene they will all come down: they will fall by the sword / financial markets will fail,

says the Lord God.

⁷ And the people who are in their league... will be wasted among the countries,

and her cities which are of their league... will be wasted among the cities.

⁸ And they will know / so they are definitely going to school, they have a lesson to learn,

I am the Lord,

when I set ablaze Egypt, and all her helpers are destroyed.

⁹ On that day, messengers from Me will go forth in ships to make the careless / unsuspecting... Ethiopians afraid, and anguish will come upon them, on the day of Egypt's doom / on the 6th day of the Lord, on the day of great wrath... envoys inspired by the Lord will be sent:

for, mark this regarding Egypt's painful day, it comes.

10 Thus says the Lord God;

I will make an end to the multitude of Egypt by the hand of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon / this prophecy was first fulfilled 2500 years ago – sort of a trial warm up anticipating the big game that is coming; fulfilled when Messiah comes in power and great glory.

¹¹ He and his people with him, the terrifying terrorists of the nations / all Babylon... including Babylon the great; both in force and fierceness, they will make horrifying work,

this leader **and his people with him... will be brought to destroy the earth** / Daniel told us, the 4th beast, a roman govt, clothed in its fashionable **purple** and **scarlet** – colors of Babylon; will be the last brutal govt smashing and destroying until the whole world is broken; busy doing that even today:

and will draw swords against Egypt, and fill the earth with the slain / we know history tells us this happened long ago, but hey, it is the legacy of Rome and will continue to the end; turn on TV and watch.

¹² And I will make the rivers dry, and sell the earth into the hand of evildoers / can you imagine the Nile River or the Euphrates River... or both dry? Such desert regions without water, in 3 days people will start to die... and nobody will say: I am shocked! happening now days.

and I will desolate the earth and everything in it, by the hand of strangers / God has been patient and longsuffering with the world; sorting out the scummy riffraff; but by foreigners; God's favorite method: send foreigners, thugs and rioters, they will stir up hated:

I the Lord have spoken / anybody want to argue with the Lord? And it is as if the Lord says, let's recap and pulls out His checklist:



13 Thus says the Lord God;

I will destroy the idols, and will put an end to the images in Noph / in the capital Memphis; there will no more be a prince from the land of Egypt: I will put fear in the land of Egypt.

- ¹⁴ And I will desolate Pathros, and will set ablaze Zoan, and will execute judgments in Thebes / one city after another will be judged; none will be spared.
- ¹⁵ I will pour My wrath upon Sin / Pelusium, the stronghold of Egypt; and cut off the multitude of Thebes.
- ¹⁶ And I will set ablaze Egypt: Pelusium will have great pain, Thebes will be breached, and Memphis will face enemies daily / one city after another will be routed; none will be spared.
- ¹⁷ The young men of Aven... and of Pibeseth will fall by the sword: and the women will go into captivity.
- ¹⁸ At Tehaphnehes, the day will be dark, when I break the burdens of Egypt: when the proud in her will cease: she will be shrouded by a cloud / a dark and dismal day, and her daughters will go into captivity.
- ¹⁹ Thus I will execute judgments in Egypt: and they will know / so they have a lesson to learn,

I am the Lord.

So Egypt falls to Babylon, but that is only half the story:

 20 In the eleventh year, in the first month, in the seventh day of the month,

the word of the Lord came to me,

²¹ Son of man, I broke the arm of Pharaoh king of Egypt;

and mark this, it will not be bound with a bandaged, so to heal and make it strong to wield the sword.

²² Therefore thus says the Lord God;

Indeed, I am against Pharaoh king of Egypt, and will break his arms, both the strong arm, and that which was broken / his lineage, and his armies; Egypt will be dismantled piece by piece -- outrageous? No, it makes me proud of God;

and I will make the sword fall from his hand.



²³ I will scatter among the nations the Egyptians and disperse through the countries / and DNA tells us that is what happened; one day all our faithful brothers and sisters – who have been harassed for centuries in Egypt will greatly rejoice.

²⁴ And I will strengthen the arms of the king of Babylon, and put My sword in his hand: but I will break Pharaoh's arms, and he will groan before him with groanings like a mortally wounded man.

²⁵ I will strengthen the arms of the king of Babylon, but the arms of Pharaoh will fall; and they will know / so they are attending a school of hard knocks, they have a lesson to learn,

I am the Lord,

when I put My sword in the hand of the king of Babylon / even the last mystery Babylon the great, faithless Mother of adoring whores... who is guilty of all the blood of the martyrs and saints of Jesus,

and he stretches it out against the land of Egypt.

²⁶ And I will scatter the Egyptians among the nations, and disperse them among the countries; and they will know / for a 4th time they went to school, they had a lesson to learn; what is it?

I am the Lord.

He is the Lord.
