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In the previous chapter 34, Ezekiel addresses the shepherds of Israel, the **faithless shepherds**... or we can say: the **faithless PASTORS**. Any correction of injustice always begins... at the House of the Lord. And I would challenge anyone in our modern day genius 21st century, to read the chapter and feel free to tell me where we are wrong on the following assessment: The Lord God through Ezekiel clearly tells us:

HE fired all the shepherds and promised, HE would come and do the job – after all HE is the Good Shepherd, which means: HE is the Good Pastor – John 10, What all the other ones are, who knows?



And having dealt with the shepherds, next **HE** turns to the sheep,

because <u>His sheep hear His voice and they follow Him.</u> So the flock is also address in chapter 34; because God's people know they are not sheep; and shouldn't be acting like mindless animals, though often they do.

In this chapter, Ezekiel briefly speaks to Mount Seir, the region SW of the Dead Sea where lived the Edomites along the Gulf of Aqabah, also known as the Red Sea probably named after their father Esau – Petra was their capital... they are descendants of Esau, meaning: Red, Jacob's twin brother; so they are cousins of Israel and Judah yet they were engaged in endless wars with each other. Ezekiel and Obadiah speak to Edom = Esau their doom is certain; their envy and hatred for Israel and Judah... left them perpetually desolate. Next, we read 2 distinct prophecies given Ezekiel.



² Son of man, set your face against Mount Seir, and prophesy against it / this prophecy is against the capitol of Esau's descendants – who should have been recipient of the birthright promises, but through his lack of discernment, sold the valuable promise for a bowl of soup – the pampered royal jackass guy was famished from yet another day of no real job, which equals: no real success,

³ saying, Thus says the Lord God / and as Moses and the prophets knew, when the Lord God speaks, we ought to listen, man does not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds... from the mouth of the Lord – Deuteronomy 8;

Indeed, O Mount Seir, I am against you, and I will stretch out My hand against you, and I will make you most desolate / deserted and destroyed; this word appears several times in this chapter and the next; remember prophecies are given for the people at the time the prophet first speaks, but also for future generations until the Lord says: it is finished. Of all the major world religions, only the Lord God of the bible speaks prophecies of future events, both bad and good.

⁴ I will lay waste your cities, and you will be desolate / deserted and destroyed, and you will know / the Lord is going to teach them; apparently they had faulty thinking going on and needed to learn...

¹ Moreover the word of the Lord came to me, saying,



I am the Lord.

⁵ Because you had a perpetual hatred and shed the blood of the children of Israel by the force of the sword, in the time of their calamity at the time that their iniquity had an end / Edom continued their endless wars of hereditary hatred, first derived from Esau against Jacob, they lived by their weapons of war; preferring their sword; motivated by indiscriminate hatred to the death of their cousins; This will have an end, mention in chapters 21, 25 & 29: I wonder if they are in the news today?

⁶ Therefore, as I live, says the Lord God,

I will prepare you to shed blood, and bloodshed will pursue you / and it is as if the Lord, the good Potter says, I see you will make a good vessel of wrath; so their motto was not: In God We Trust; rather, their manmade instruments became their trusty god; and the Lord says: your will be done. The Lord teaches a serious lesson: and He speaks earthy truths to convey to all of us a message to take to heart:

since you did not hate bloodshed, even bloodshed will pursue you.

⁷ Thus I will make Mount Seir most desolate / deserted and destroyed, and cut off from it the one who leaves and the one who returns / which means: the highways coming and going to hateful, bloodthirsty Mount Seir...will not be crowded; because nobody will be travelling them Like we read in the Revelation: Come out of her my people, the highways to faithless mystery Babylon will not be crowded.

⁸ And I will fill his mountains with his slain, in your hills, and in your valleys, and in all your rivers / plural high places of greater Esau and Mount Seir, filled to the brim with men and women young and old... all dead: in the high places of Esau; in the low places, wherever your people flow; and does that include in the massive immigration flows of greater Esau... throughout the world for the past decades... of this last govt that has been smashing and destroying until the whole world is broken? Yes!

they will fall who are slain with the sword.

⁹ I will make you perpetual desolations and your cities will not return / unending destructions, for greater Esau's unending hatred, it will not end well for them: and you children of Esau... will know / so they are still learning a lesson, and what is it?

I am the Lord.



¹⁰ Because you said These two nations and these two countries will be mine / words are important to God, and we are warned not to take what God says lightly; and from this phrase we learn, God listens to what we say; He does not take our words lightly either. Esau and his descendants are smarter than most people in the Church; as well as most of our very smart Jewish cousins; even those who thankfully have come to embrace Jesus the Christ – Yeshua the Messiah; yet none can seem to find where those 2 peoples are; I say, look in the mirror; but here the Lord God says, greater Esau knows, and in his perpetual, continuous, uninterrupted hatred he says;

These two nations and these two countries will be mine,



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and we will possess / that's their hardheaded goal... which does not mean they will fully succeed; because God always says to His people, as is your faith it will be done to you. So, for those who say, I have a clue: the House of southern Judah and the House of northern Israel – Yes! And we all know from history where the Jewish people went – their story is unbroken with tragedy after tragedy, having rejected the Messiah -- David's greater Son, the Chief cornerstone. But where lost Israel went to become a great commonwealth of nations, with Ephraim leading; and Manasseh a great nation... at the center of the earth, when the Gentile nations come to a close? Don't know?! Esau's children seem to know... and their perpetual hatred... for being such a peaceful religion, has not abated, subsided, or diminished;

These two nations and these two countries will be mine, and we will possess;

whereas the Lord was there / Moses tells us, the Lord God who created all things; He divided up all the boundaries of the nations according to the children of Israel - Deuteronomy 32 - and remember Israel is NOT Jewish; Ephraim is NOT Jewish; and Manasseh is NOT Jewish; but our little cousin Judah is Jewish. And we like our cousins of Judah. Check out:

11 Therefore, as I live, says the Lord God,

I will even do according to your anger,

and according to your envy

which you used from your hatred against them / the Lord isn't causing anyone to do evil, but seeing their choice, He says: Okay, your will be done. and I will make myself known among them, when I have judged you.

¹² And you will know

I am the Lord,

and that I heard all your blasphemies / wrongfully attributing the works of God to the works of Satan; I bet calling those of the 2 houses...the great Satan... but the Lord is going to teach them a lesson or two: so let's hear the Lord again, because He is such a good Teacher:

And you will know

I am the Lord,

and that I heard all your blasphemies which you have spoken against the mountains of Israel / against greater Israel who is in focus; not just one high place, but several, wherever greater Israel went, they blasphemed those high places; in other words: do not just think: Jerusalem, but also London, Sydney and Washington DC... to name only of few of the many high places where they went,







and that I heard all your blasphemies which you have spoken against the mountains of Israel saying, they are laid desolate / deserted and destroyed, rightfully saying, but wrongfully concluding: they are given us to consume / greater Israel's humiliation was temporary; greater Edom's is perpetual.

¹³ Thus with your mouth you have boasted against Me, and have multiplied your words against Me: I have heard them / the LORD said, when you speak arrogantly against them, you speak against Me – not a good thing;

14 Thus says the Lord God;

When the whole earth rejoices I will make you desolate / deserted and destroyed / which seems to suggest: something about greater Esau will impact the whole earth.

¹⁵ As you rejoiced at the inheritance of the House of Israel because it was desolate / deserted and destroyed / they still rejoice whenever tragedies happen to any of greater Israel's mountains; the original prophecy happened 170 years before Ezekiel was born; but this prophecy causing the whole earth to rejoice hasn't happened yet; so stay alert,

so I will do to you: you will be desolate / **deserted** and **destroyed, O Mount Seir, and all Idumea, all of it** / the Lord says, He will do the same to **Esau's people**; you know Herod was an Idumean ruling when Messiah first came; could other Herodians be over-populating some of greater Israel's nations in advance of His return? They might run, but they won't be able to hide, not from Him.

and they will know

I am the Lord.
