As the House of Israel prepared for Assyrian captivity 700 years after having rejected the 10 commands, the Lord said: Though I wrote ten thousand, they are regarded as a strange thing -- Hosea 8; as the House of Judah prepared for Babylonian captivity, He allowed them onerous manmade traditions and said: So, I permitted them statues that were not good, and judgments whereby they should not live -- Ezekiel 20.

But what Moses originally told the people of God... was not onerous or hocus pocus, but given so they prosper in the land they would enter, first promised to Abraham. Paul is not writing new rules or commands. The Covenant the perfect God made with His people were perfectly good for all to write on their minds and hearts; to keep and do... as they daily approached our great God and Father for our every need. Do the 10 commandments save? No! They save society. God saves, all who will turn to Him; and walk with Him, and go His way.



you who are spiritual, restore that one in the spirit of meekness; considering yourself, lest you also be tempted.

<sup>2</sup> Bear one another's burdens, and fulfil the law of Christ / the law of the Messiah, He did His part substituting His life for ours; He was cut off, but not for himself – Daniel 9; that we might do our part and make His soul, our offering for our sin; that He become our righteousness -- which is why we also read: My Servant will justify many; He bore the sins of many -- Isaiah 53. Dr. Gene Scott said, God treated His Son The Man of Sorrows... the way we should have been treated; that He might treat us, the way His Son should have been treated -- is it fair? No! It is not fair. We all should be dead.

<sup>3</sup> For if a man thinks himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself / Jesus, the night He was betrayed, said, without Me you can do nothing – John15.

<sup>4</sup> But let everyone prove his own work, and then he can rejoice in himself alone, and not in his neighbor / let everyone examine what he is really made of.

<sup>5</sup> For each will bear his own burden / each will carry his own load; all who die in Christ will be called to stand in His presence one day and He will tell us, what if anything we ever did for Him, for His sake endures, be it to give a cup of cold water to a thirsty traveler... in His name.

<sup>6</sup> Let the one who is taught in the word

**share all good things with the one who teaches** / and what are good things? well stocks, bonds, gold, silver -- to name a few, those things are good things.

Paul says, value the teachers who teach you; not with cheap talk, but with support.

<sup>7</sup>Be not deceived; God is not mocked:

for whatever a person sows, that he will also reap.

<sup>8</sup> For he who sows to the flesh will of the flesh reap corruption;

but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap life everlasting / Jesus said, it all comes down to where your treasure is, because that is where your heart is also.

<sup>9</sup> And let us not grow weary of doing well: for in due season we will reap, if we do not faint.

<sup>10</sup> So then, as we have opportunity,

let us do good to everyone, especially to those who are the household of faith.

<sup>11</sup> See how large the letters I am writing to you with my own hand.

<sup>12</sup> Those who desire to make a good showing in the flesh, they coerce you to be circumcised; and only so they should not be persecuted for the cross of Christ.

<sup>13</sup> For even they themselves who are circumcised do not keep the law;

**but desire to have you circumcised, that they may boast in your flesh** / isn't it interesting? At the beginning when God gave His 10 covenant commands, He also added: and no more. From the first, He said to His people **circumcise your hearts**. He always wanted them to write His commands on their minds and hearts... and then not just to guard them, but to do them.

<sup>14</sup> But for me, may I never boast / may I not glory, may I never brag,

except in the cross of the Lord of us: Jesus Christ,

by whom the world is crucified to me, and I to the world.

<sup>15</sup> For circumcision avails nothing,

**nor uncircumcision, but a new creature** / a new creation, a creation of love and joy and peace benefits.

<sup>16</sup> All who walk according to this rule,

peace be on them, and mercy on the Israel of God.

#### <sup>17</sup> From now on let no one trouble me:

**for I bear in my body the marks of the Lord Jesus** / his marks of suffering persecution for Christ Jesus – detailed in 2 Corinthians 11, were infinitely more valuable than what the hocus pocus Judaizers sought to impose, as they cut on their private parts.

### <sup>18</sup> Brothers, the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen. /

Jesus said, do not think I came to destroy the law, not the smallest letter will pass away from the law, until all is fulfilled: whoever keeps and teaches these will be called great in the kingdom of God – Matthew 5.

- 1. Do not have other gods before Me.
