GENESIS 13 vs 1



In this chapter, Abram and Sarai return to the land promised them; later chapters will include the birth of Isaac (chapter 21), the marriage of Isaac and Rebekah (chapter 24) the death of Abraham as well as the birth of Abraham's grandsons Esau and Jacob (chapter 25); and all the numerous promises of God to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob which are nationalistic promises still being fulfilled by their descendants, heirs of those promises scattered throughout the world in our 21st century,

Abram and Lot separate,

- ¹ And Abram up went from Egypt, he, and his wife, and all that he had, and Lot with him, to the Negev / to the south of modern Sinai.
- ² And Abram was very rich in livestock, in silver, and in gold / the history Moses is writing is not about scabby farmers, they are of the royal family of Noah; the king is the one who keeps all the kin together.



- ⁴ to the place of the altar, which he made there at first: and there Abram called on the name of the LORD.
- ⁵ And also Lot, who went with Abram, had flocks, and herds, and tents.
- ⁶ And the land was not able to support them, that they dwell together: for their possessions were great, so they could not dwell together.
- ⁷ And there was strife between the herdsmen of Abram's livestock and the herdsmen of Lot's livestock: and the Canaanite and the Perizzite lived then in the land.
- ⁸ So said Abram to Lot, please, Let there be no strife, between me and you, and between my herdsmen and your herdsmen; for our men, we are brothers.
- ⁹ Is not the whole land before you? please, Separate yourself from me: if you take the left, then I will go to the right; or if you go to the right, then I will go to the left.
- 10 And Lot lifted up his eyes, and saw all the plain of Jordan, that everywhere was well watered, (before the LORD destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah), even as the garden of the LORD, like the land of Egypt, as you go to Zoar.
- ¹¹ Then Lot chose for himself all the plain of Jordan; and Lot journeyed east:

and they separated the one from the other.

¹² Abram dwelt in the land of Canaan.

and Lot dwelt in the cities of the plain, and pitched his tent toward Sodom.

¹³ But the men of Sodom were wicked and sinful against the LORD exceedingly.

¹⁴ And the LORD said to Abram, after Lot separated from him,

Lift up now your eyes, and look from the place where you are north, south, east, and west:

¹⁵ for all the land that you see, to you I give it, and to your offspring forever.

And I will make your offspring as the dust of the earth: that if a man can number the dust of the earth, then also your offspring can be numbered.

¹⁷ Arise, walk through the land, its length and its breadth; for to you I give it / notice how the Lord suddenly started to pile on promise after promise to Abram and his descendants after him; by the way Abram was Hebrew. He was not Jewish, though the small Jewish tribe much later did come from his great grandson Judah.

¹⁸ Then Abram moved his tent,

and went and dwelt by the oaks of Mamre,

which are in Hebron, and he built there an altar to the LORD.
