GENESIS 20 vs 1



In this chapter. Abraham once again moves to the southern country: later chapters will include the birth of Isaac (chapter 21), the marriage of Isaac and Rebekah (chapter 24) the death of Abraham as well as the birth of Abraham's grandsons Esau and Jacob (chapter 25); and all the numerous promises of God to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob which are nationalistic promises still being fulfilled by their descendants, heirs of those promises scattered throughout the world in our 21st century.

Abraham and Abimelech,

¹ And Abraham journeyed from there to the Negev / the south country, about 10 miles south of Gaza; were they uneasy about living near the recent destruction?, and dwelt between Kadesh and Shur, and stayed in Gerar.



- ² And Abraham said of Sarah his wife, She is my sister: and Abimelech king of Gerar sent, and took Sarah.
- ³ But God came to Abimelech in a dream by night, and said to him, Behold, you are a dead man, because of the woman you have taken; she is a man's wife.
- ⁴ But Abimelech had not come near her: and he said, LORD, will You slay a nation, though it is blameless?
- ⁵ Did he not say to me, She is my sister? and she herself, even she said, He is my brother: in the integrity of my heart and innocency of my hands I did this.
- ⁶ And God said to him in a dream, Yes, I know in the integrity of your heart you did this; for I also withheld you from sinning against Me: thus I did not let you touch her.
- ⁷ Now restore his wife to the man; for he is a prophet, and he will pray for you, and you will live: but if you do not restore her, know that you will surely die, you and all who are yours.
- ⁸ So Abimelech rose early in the morning, and called all his servants, and told all these things in their hearing: and the men were very much afraid.
- ⁹ Then Abimelech called Abraham, and said to him, What have you done to us? and how have I offended you, that you brought on me and on my kingdom a great sin? Deeds that ought not be done, you have done to me.
- ¹⁰ And Abimelech said to Abraham, What did you see, that you have done this thing?
- ¹¹ And Abraham said, Because I thought, surely the fear of God not in this place; and they will kill me because of my wife.

¹² But indeed, she is my sister; the daughter of my father, but she is not the daughter of my mother; and she became my wife;

¹³ and it happened, when God caused me to wander from the house of my father, that I said to her, This is your kindness that you will show to me; in every place where we go, say of me, he is my brother.

¹⁴Then Abimelech took sheep and oxen, and male and female servants, and gave them to Abraham, and restored to him his wife Sarah.

¹⁵ And Abimelech said, Behold, my land is before you: settle wherever you please.

¹⁶ And to Sarah he said, Behold, I have a thousand pieces of silver to your brother: behold, it is a covering of the eyes / it was Sarah's vindication to all who are with you, and before everybody you are cleared.

¹⁷So Abraham prayed to God: and God healed Abimelech and his wife, and his maidservants; and they bore him children.

¹⁸ For the LORD had completely closed up all the wombs of the household of Abimelech, because of Sarah, wife of Abraham.
