In this chapter we have an account of the posterity of Esau, who, from him were called Edomites, that Esau who sold his birthright, and lost his blessing, and was not loved by God as Jacob was. Here is a brief register kept of his family, for some generations. Esau was twin brother of Jacob, sons of Isaac. The Edomites were neighbors to Israel, and their genealogy would be of use to give light to the stories of what passed between them. <sup>1</sup> Now these are the generations of **Esau**, who is **Edom**.

<sup>2</sup> **Esau** took his wives of the daughters of Canaan; Adah the daughter of Elon the Hittite, and Oholibamah the daughter of Anah the daughter of Zibeon the Hivite;

<sup>3</sup> And Bashemath Ishmael's daughter, sister of Nebajoth.

<sup>4</sup> And Adah bare to **Esau** Eliphaz; and Bashemath bare Reuel;

<sup>5</sup> And Oholibamah bare Jeush, and Jalam, and Korah: these are the sons of **Esau**, which were born to him in the land of Canaan.

<sup>6</sup> And **Esau** took his wives, and his sons, and his daughters, and all the persons of his house, and his cattle, and all his beasts, and all his substance, which he had got in the land of Canaan; and went into the country from the face of his brother Jacob.

<sup>7</sup> For their riches were more than that they might live together; and the land wherein they were strangers could not bear them because of their cattle.

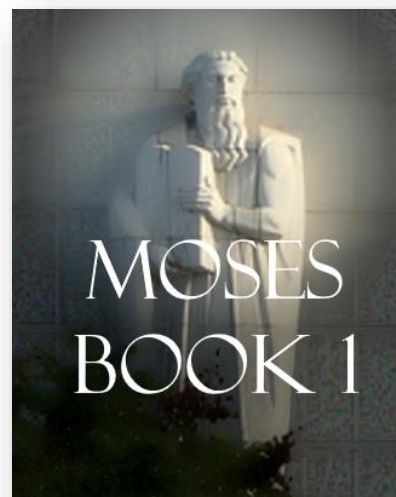
<sup>8</sup> Thus dwelt Esau in mount Seir: **Esau** is **Edom**.

<sup>9</sup> And these are the generations of **Esau** the father of the **Edomites** in mount Seir:

<sup>10</sup> These are the names of the sons of **Esau**; Eliphaz the son of Adah the wife of **Esau**, Reuel the son of Bashemath the wife of **Esau**.

<sup>11</sup> And the sons of Eliphaz were Teman, Omar, Zepho, and Gatam, and Kenaz.

<sup>12</sup> And Teman was concubine to Eliphaz the son of **Esau**; and she bare to Eliphaz Amalek: these were the sons of Adah, wife of **Esau**.

<sup>13</sup> And these are the sons of Reuel; Nahath, and Zerah, Shammah, and Mizzah: these were the sons of Bashemath, wife of **Esau**.

<sup>14</sup> And these were the sons of Oholibamah, the daughter of Anah the daughter of Zibeon, wife of **Esau**: and she bare to **Esau** Jeush, and Jalam, and Korah.

<sup>15</sup> These were chiefs of the sons of **Esau**: the sons of Eliphaz the firstborn son of **Esau**; chief Teman, chief Omar, chief Zepho, chief Kenaz,

<sup>16</sup> Chief Korah, chief Gatam, and chief Amalek: these are the chiefs that came of Eliphaz in the land of **Edom**; these were the sons of Adah.

<sup>17</sup> And these are the sons of Reuel, son of **Esau**; chief Nahas, chief Zerah, chief Shammah, chief Mizzah: these are the chiefs that came of Reuel in the land of **Edom**; these are the sons of Bashemath, wife of **Esau**.

<sup>18</sup> And these are the sons of Oholibamah Esau's wife; chief Jeush, chief Jalam, chief Korah: these were the chiefs that came of Oholibamah the daughter of Anah, wife of **Esau**.

<sup>19</sup> These are the sons of **Esau**, who is **Edom**, and these are their chiefs.

<sup>20</sup> These are the sons of Seir the Horite, who inhabited the land; Lotan, and Shobal, and Zibeon, and Anah,

<sup>21</sup> And Dishon, and Ezer, and Dishan: these are the chiefs of the Horites, the children of Seir in the land of **Edom**.

<sup>22</sup> And the children of Lotan were Hori and Hemam; and Lotan's sister was Timna.

<sup>23</sup> And the children of Shobal were; Alvan, and Manahath, and Ebal, Shepho, and Onam.

<sup>24</sup> And these are the children of Zibeon; both Aiah, and Anah: this was that Anah that found the mules in the wilderness, as he fed the asses of Zibeon his father.

<sup>25</sup> And the children of Anah were these; Dishon, and Oholibamah the daughter of Anah.

<sup>26</sup> And these are the children of Dishon; Hemdan, and Eshban, and Ithran, and Cheran.

<sup>27</sup> The children of Ezer are these; Bilhan, and Zaavan, and Akan.

<sup>28</sup> The children of Dishan are these; Uz, and Aran.

<sup>29</sup> These are the chiefs that came of the Horites; chief Lotan, chief Shobal, chief Zibeon, chief Anah,

<sup>30</sup> Chief Dishon, chief Ezer, chief Dishan: these are the chiefs that came of Hori, among their chiefs in the land of Seir.

<sup>31</sup> And these are the kings that reigned in the land of Edom, before there reigned any king over the children of Israel.

<sup>32</sup> And Bela the son of Beor reigned in Edom: and the name of his city was Dinhabah.

<sup>33</sup> And Bela died, and Jobab the son of Zerah of Bozrah reigned in his stead.

<sup>34</sup> And Jobab died, and Husham of the land of Temani reigned in his stead.

<sup>35</sup> And Husham died, and Hadad the son of Bedad, who smote Midian in the field of Moab, reigned in his stead: and the name of his city was Avith.

<sup>36</sup> And Hadad died, and Samlah of Masrekah reigned in his stead.

<sup>37</sup> And Samlah died, and Saul of Rehoboth by the river reigned in his stead.

<sup>38</sup> And Saul died, and Baal-hanan the son of Achbor reigned in his stead.

<sup>39</sup> And Baal-hanan the son of Achbor died, and Hadar reigned in his stead: and the name of his city was Pau; and his wife's name was Mehetabel, the daughter of Matred, the daughter of Mezahab.

<sup>40</sup> And these are the names of the chiefs that came of **Esau**, according to their families, after their places, by their names; chief Timnah, chief Alvah, chief Jetheth,

<sup>41</sup> Chief Oholibamah, chief Elah, chief Pinon,

<sup>42</sup> Chief Kenaz, chief Teman, chief Mibzar,

<sup>43</sup> Chief Magdiel, chief Iram: these be the chiefs of **Edom**, according to their habitations in the land of their possession: he is **Esau** the father of the **Edomites**.
