
GENESIS 3 vs 1



This far, we learned: the introduction to Genesis. Chapter 1 In the beginning when God created the heaven and the earth; and all that was suitable for Adam's existence; and it was very good. We learned: Chapter 2, details of idyllic life in the Garden from where all mankind was created to cover the earth; and it was very good. How much time has elapsed, it is impossible to accurately know; was it a long period of time? Probably not, since we know Adam lived 930 years. Chapter 3, we learn of the fall of Adam and his race; resulting in expulsion from the Garden of Eden.

¹ Now the serpent was more crafty than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, Yes, has God said, You will not eat of every tree of the garden? / apparently the serpent was a beautiful creature in is unfallen state; we are told, that Satan spoke through the serpent; perhaps Eve did not know that animals did not speak.



- ² And the woman said to the serpent, The fruit of the trees of the garden we may eat:
- ³ but of the fruit of the tree which is in the middle of the garden, God said, You will not eat of it, nor will you touch it, lest you die.
- ⁴ And the serpent said to the woman, Surely you will not die:
- ⁵ for God knows that in the day you eat of it, then your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.
- ⁶ And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree coveted to make one wise, she took of its fruit, and did eat, and gave also to her husband with her; and he ate.
- ⁷And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed together fig leaves, and made themselves coverings.
- ⁸ And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the breeze / in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden.

- ⁹ And the LORD God called to Adam, and said to him, Where are you? / as if the Lord God who created the heaven and the earth didn't know!
- ¹⁰ And he said, I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.
- ¹¹ And He said, Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree, which I commanded you that you should not eat?
- 12 And the man said, The woman whom you gave to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat. / so guess that is a YES.
- ¹³ And the LORD God said to the woman, What is this you have done? And the woman said, The serpent deceived me, and I did eat.
- ¹⁴And the LORD God said to the serpent, Because you have done this, you are cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon your belly you will go, and dust you will eat all the days of your life:
- ¹⁵ and hostility I will put between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed;
- **He will bruise your head**, and you will bruise His heel / notice, the Lord God has no conversation with the serpent; God simply tells him what will be his fate: this being the first indication of God's failsafe plan, the mystery of Messiah hid from the ages; to one day be fully realized in all His glory.
- ¹⁶ To the woman He said, I will greatly multiply your sorrow and your conception; in pain you will beget children; and your desire will be to your husband, and he will rule over you.
- ¹⁷ And to Adam He said, Because you heeded the voice of your wife, and ate from the tree, which I commanded you, saying, You will not eat of it: cursed is the ground for your sake; in toil you will eat of it all the days of your life;
- ¹⁸thorns and also thistles it will produce for you; and you will eat the herb of the field;
- ¹⁹ by the sweat of your face you will eat bread, till you return to the ground; for from it you were taken: for you are dust, and to dust you will return.

²⁰ And Adam called the name of his wife Eve; because she was the mother of all living.

²¹ And the LORD God made for Adam and his wife, coats of skins, and clothed them / this verse is the basis to the mystery of the Golden Fleece; in the Book of Jasher -- mentioned in both Joshua 10; and 2 Samuel 1, we read in detail of this covering from sheep skins made by the Lord; given to cover Adam and Eve, passed along to all the chief descendants till Noah entered the ark,

Ham stole those garments from Noah his father. When Ham begat Cush, the garments were given to him; and is that why Noah was naked and the two sons respectfully covered him? and from Cush came Nimrod, the mighty rebel against the Lord God. No wonder those of Ham's descendants were cursed.

²² And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become like one of Us, knowing good and evil: now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live forever:

²³ so the LORD God sent him from the garden of Eden, to work the ground from which he was taken.

²⁴So He drove out the man; and at the east of the garden of Eden, and He place cherubim and a flaming sword which turned every direction, to keep the way to the tree of life / so these cherubim with their flaming sword did what Adam had been assigned to do; which is what Jesus repeatedly assigned the night He was betrayed, to those who claimed to follow and learn from Him.
