

# HEBREWS 10 vs 1

<sup>1</sup> **For the law, being a shadow of good things to come** / the ceremonial law: hinting, suggesting, indicating what was to come,

**and not the very form of things to come, it can never by with those animal sacrifices which they offered continually year after year, make perfect those who come near.**

<sup>2</sup> **For then, they would not have ceased to be offered** / if perfection really came to us screwy mortals, doing little animal sacrifices, then why did that activity stop long ago?

**since the worshipers once purged, would no longer be conscience of sins** / but we all know: we can scrub our hands and get our finger nails clean, but all the scrubbing in the world will not clean our hearts and minds. Right?

<sup>3</sup> **But in those sacrifices we remember sins every year** / in those animal sacrifices, that word **anamnaysis**...is used only three other times; recalling when Jesus said, **Do this in remembrance of Me**.

<sup>4</sup> **For there is no power for the blood of bulls and of goats to take away sins.**

<sup>5</sup> **Why was this said?** Well, hear the Son of God: **When He comes to the world, He says, Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, but a body You prepared for Me.** /only His life alone could substitute for our messed up lives.

<sup>6</sup> **You did not desire burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin** / His Father was really not interested all that stuff; **God takes pleasure in men and women of faith**; not men and women pretending to act like High priest Aaron trying to remember all those little laws and rules and religious works he needed to do.

<sup>7</sup> **Then I said, Lo** / mark this! **Highlight this!** Circle this... and don't forget it,

**in the volume of the book it is written of Me,** / in the Old Testament, there are about 3,000 individuals mentioned. That is the size of a large public high school in California. I bet the average person couldn't name 10 people in the Old Testament... without naming 1 or 2 New Testament names. The Lord says the vast majority of pages of Scripture are about Him! And He says...

**I arrived to do Your will, O God** / Wow! someone came to do the will of God on this planet.



<sup>8</sup> **Above when He said, You did **not** desire, nor have pleasure in sacrifices and offerings and whole burnt offerings and offering for sin -- which are offered according to the law** / God never had pleasure in that stuff; it was not offered by faith. But does anybody listen?

<sup>9</sup> **Then He said, See, I arrived to do Your will O God. He takes away the first covenant to establish the second** / first old covenant had to go, for the new and better way.

<sup>10</sup> **By His will** we are sanctified / by the will of God we are set apart for His purposes;

through the offering of / bulls and goats? **NO!** through the offering of / self-righteous legalists pretending to imitate Christ? **NO!** Who needs an imitation? especially when we have the Real Thing! through the offering of / hocus pocus clerics of the modern-day churchianity; those who prefer the tradition of men? **NO!**

**we are sanctified by the one-time offering Jesus Christ gave in His body** / Period! The word: **ephapax**. means: **only once** it took only one time. No need to be repeated. It's done! finished! complete! Got the point? That is why He sat down!

<sup>11</sup> **and** / yet in the old times, **every priest stood daily ministering and offering oftentimes** / many times; sort of like those religious folks who replace the Word of God, offering instead their idolatrous images, with their tired, joyless speeches, and monotonous, eerie chants...that we hear... week after week, and year after year!

**every priest used to stand daily ministering and offering oftentimes... the same old sacrifices, which can **never** take away sins:**

<sup>12</sup> **But this One, after He... offered one sacrifice for sins... forever** / in His body...giving His blood... His life; one sacrifice forever -- and that is a pretty long time, wouldn't you imagine?! That doesn't mean... till next week... or next month... or next year!

**He offered **one** sacrifice... for sins... forever!**

And then...

**HE sat down at the right hand of God** / His first work assignment was complete!

<sup>13</sup> **From hereafter expecting His enemies be made His footstool** / and remember, we all were His enemies; but through His blood He brought us... near to God His Father and our Father.

<sup>14</sup> **For by one offering... He perfected forever... those being set-apart.**
