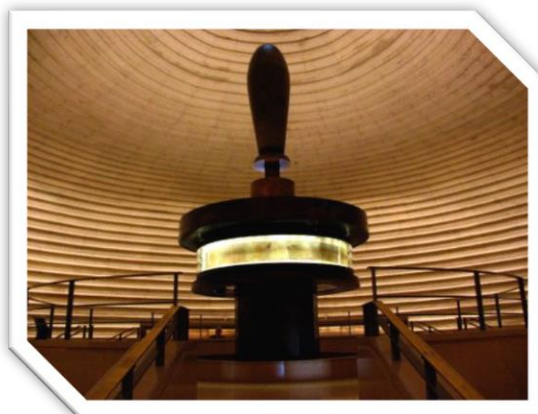


ISAIAH 12 vs 1

The people of God were warned by Moses as they entered the land pledged to their forefathers, they knew the blessings promised by God should they obey His voice, and the curses should they choose to turn from Him. Isaiah spoke words of hope to the people who were preparing for yet another invasion due to their faithlessness. What was their crime? What was their punishment? The prophets repeatedly told us.



The house of **Ephraim** (also known as the House of **Israel**) and the House of **Judah**, spent years scheming and scrapping against each other. **Israel** – the 10 northern tribes including Ephraim and Manasseh the 2 half-Egyptians sons of Joseph, they received all the exceptional nationalistic promises given to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. God sent them into Assyrian captivity – until they got lost in biblical history. They were NOT Jewish.

And **Judah** in the south, who was given specific promises particularly related to the promised Messiah king, the greater son of David who would accomplish many things spelled out in OT history. These 2 houses have 2 distinct histories... and only when the time of the Gentile nations comes to a close, only then the prophets clearly tell us will they be reunited... as one family under the rule of one great Shepherd king... who will come whose right it is to reign, the zeal of the Lord will make it happen. Until that happens, **Ephraim a great commonwealth**, a community of nations, **Manasseh a great nation**; and **Judah** ... with others will be in the news; see if you can find God's handiwork in time... those given temporal promises, in this life. God only gives eternal promises to individuals who care to follow Him and learn from Him.

Even people like Elizabeth I of England and Emperor Kangxi of China... along with multiplied millions – in every nation, among every tribe and language group... they have taken time to acknowledge and thank the Lord GOD almighty for His great kindness in sending his Son. Don't live under the delusion that the world has not heard the good news. Oh, they might not have heard all the details, but the word has gone out.

¹ **And in that day** ... and some might ask: What day? Well read the previous chapter, you will discover Isaiah spoke about it 3 times... though he writes about a coming day that belongs to the Lord, more than 90 times. Moses told us about the **7 Days of the Lord – Leviticus 23**; specific Days, work Days. Paul describes them as: *shadows of things to come*... fulfilled in Christ, the Messiah; by something He does. Without Christ those 7 days have no meaning. Well, when Isaiah was writing, He knew about the days pointing to Messiah, but obviously, he didn't know when Messiah came to visit, He would fulfill **the first 4 Days: Passover, Unleavened Bread, First Fruits and Pentecost** ... opening the time often referred to as the **Day of salvation**; which could be called: the **Day of Yeshua**, or the **Day of Jesus**. When Messiah came the first time, He did **not** come to judge the nations, but to redeem fallen mankind – those who came from Adam's race – out of every nation; those who cared to follow Him and learn from Him; they

were to become a people for His own possession Now we live in **the last days**: when the **Day of Salvation** will soon be closed: **Trumpets**, **Afflicting souls**, and **Tents**.

And in that day...

you will say / or more probably sing, **O Lord, I praise you:**

though **You were angry with me,**

Your anger turned away, and You comforted me.

² Behold, God is my **salvation** / **my Yeshua; my Jesus**

I will trust, and not be afraid:

for the **LORD Yahwah** is my strength and my song;

He has become my salvation / **my Yeshua; my Jesus**

³ Therefore you will joyously draw water from the wells of **salvation** / or **the wells of Yeshua, the wells of Jesus**.

And isn't it interesting? 700 years later... to the Samaritan woman, Jesus said, *whoever drinks of the water I give you, will never thirst again; the water I give will become a well springing up to eternal life. And the woman said, give me this water* – **John 4**.

will you sing, **Praise the Lord** / **Hallelujah**,

call on His name / because He will answer – **Psalm 91**

declare His doings among the nations / from the rising to the setting of the sun – **Malachi 1**,

make mention His name is exalted.
