

ISAIAH 31 vs 1

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Beginning in chapter 24, Isaiah addresses the major actors when the time of the Gentiles ends; when Messiah comes in power and great glory to set things right. With an awesome event, the whole world will know including **the 3 faithless shepherds** – Zechariah 11; He is on the way.



¹ Woe to those who go to Egypt for help; and rely on horses, and lean on chariots, because they are many; and on horsemen, because they are strong; / how terrible it will be for them

yet they do not look to the Holy One of Israel, they do not seek the LORD! / little David had enough sense to take his slingshot, 5 smooth stones, and declare the Lord had called him to the battle, and whom the Lord guides, He provides; the great King David warned his very wise son, Seek the Lord while He may still be found – which means there will come a time when some cannot find Him, apparently, He moves on with His agenda; if you seek Him with all your heart He will let you find Him – **2 Chronicles 15:2**.

² Yet He also is wise, and will bring evil and will not retract His words but will arise against the house of the evildoers, and against the help of those who work crimes / the Lord is eager with all the resources to help those who call on Him – and will frustrate the plans of those who pick fights with his people, He is willing to keep His word to His own hurt – Psalm 15: He will not help those who do not have the same scale for all.

³ Now the Egyptians are men, and not God, and their horses are flesh, and not spirit. When the LORD stretches out His hand both he who helps will fall, and he who is helped will fall; they all will fall together; / the LORD multitasks very well; and like a house of cards; the Egyptians-- like 100 dominos lined up in a row.

⁴ For thus the LORD said to me: Like the lion or the young lion growling over its prey, when many shepherds are called out against it, it will not be intimidated by their voices, it will not be bothered by all their noise:

⁵ **As birds fly, so the LORD of hosts defends Jerusalem; He will also deliver it; passing over, He will rescue it.**

⁶ **Return to Him from whom you have deeply deserted, O children of Israel – those ruled by God.**



On the Mount of Olives: when the Messiah comes again, we know He will come to this place. We also know that 2500 years ago, Sennacherib's invasion of Judah got no closer to Jerusalem than the Mount of Olives. This part of Isaiah's prophecy serves a dual purpose: speaking to both events.

⁷ **For on that day all will throw away their demon idols of silver and gold, that their hands made to sin** / idolatry seeks to replace God's word of promise with our images – invented by our little mind; a picture might be worth 1,000 words, but in an emergency try texting only a picture. We are created to hear and respond to God's word.

⁸ **The Assyrian will fall by a sword not of man; and a sword not of any man will devour him: so he will not escape that sword,** / he who moved from Assyria to Rome, he will have his worthless weapon for endless wars on him; many scholars share think this is the last man of lawlessness – antichrist who is coming; he falls with his sword; in the previous chapter, the Lord says, He will bang on the Assyrian's head as if He was playing a tambourine – music to His ears. When the Assyrian drops dead, it will be inglorious; done in by the sword of the Spirit is the Word of God. At Messiah's command, when He returns in power and great glory; in a moment, He will deal with this lawless fool, and his compadres with a word; as simple as: **Adios! your fired! Go to hell,**

and his young men will melt away / before they can blink, they will be vaporized,

⁹ **And he and his rock solid strength, will suddenly melt away in a panic, his junior cadets will be terrified of the raised flag, says the LORD, whose fire is in Zion, and whose furnace in Jerusalem** / from where Mr. Sennacherib was allowed to flee; but where Mr. Antichrist, like a French fry that is finally cooked crisp.
