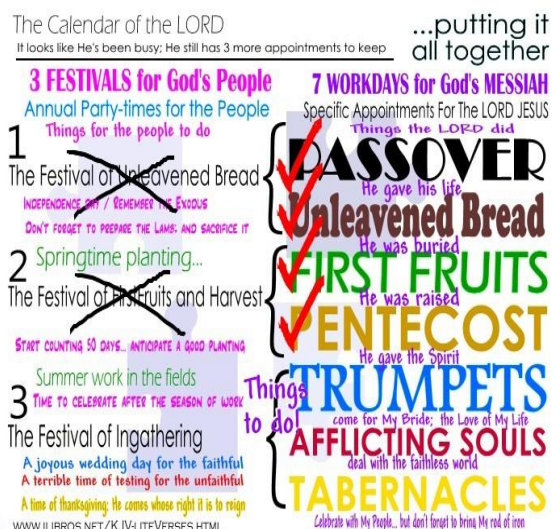
The Assyrian and his destruction,

¹ Woe to you who spoils, and you were not spoiled, and deals in treachery, yet they did not deal treacherously with you! / how terrible it will be for the biggest spoiler -- Rome; [Daniel says, the last world govt, will smash and destroy, until the whole world is broken](#); while they annually pilfer billions from the US Tax payer's coffers; not to mention all the nations of the world; look at every country she influenced; enslaved, kept uneducated in the dark; rogue nations run by thieves and robbers and child predators hard as iron; with policies fashioned by Nazis, Dictators, Socialists, Fascists alike, all disrupting those communities who disagree with them. They are frauds and dangerously deceptive; endlessly twisting truth; because their father is the father of lies.

when you cease to spoil, you will be spoiled; and when you cease to deal treacherously, they will deal treacherously with you.

/ Isaiah is told: when they cease to destroy, they will be destroyed; that is their sole purpose in the Lord God's agenda; they are to smash and destroy, keeping people awake, until one day, the long-awaited Rock of Ages comes and pulverizes them into hell; and they are incinerated in a moment; earlier Isaiah told us: the Lord will bang the Assyrian's head as if He was playing a tambourine; when the time comes it will bring great joy to Jesus the Christ to pound on that fool's head – [Isaiah 30:31-32](#);

² O LORD, be gracious to us; we wait for You: be our arm of strength every morning, our [salvation](#) / in Hebrew, our [Yeshua](#), where comes the name: [Jesus](#) [our salvation](#) in the storm / Matthew wrote: His name is Jesus, He will help His people.

The LORD of glory; Messiah, our Salvation - Yeshua:

³ **At the sound of the approaching storm, peoples flee; when the LORD stands up the nations scatter** / when Messiah sees enough, the same occurs.

⁴ **And your spoil will be gathered like the gathering of the caterpillar: as the running to and fro of locusts they will run about** / the Assyrians, Herodians; all fool criminals and thugs; like chasing cockroaches when the light is turned on, when the LORD stands up.

⁵ **The LORD is lifted up; He dwells on high. He fills Zion with right justice.**

⁶ **And wisdom and knowledge will be the stability of Your times, and strength of Yeshua: the fear of the LORD is His valued treasure.**

But back to the scorched earth:

⁷ **Look, their brave cry out: the ambassadors of peace weep bitterly / there was no peace; come out of her...**

⁸ **The highways lie wasted, no traveler in sight; he broke the covenant, he despised the cities, he regards no one** / they are destroyed thanks to Rome; the crazy, thieving, Assyrian they thought to make a pact with, has shown his two-faces.

⁹ **The earth mourns and suffers: Lebanon is shamed, and her forests are chopped down: fertile Sharon is a desert; Bashan and Carmel shake off their fruits** / it's like winter; the Lord sits in His heaven and laughs at the stupid stuff going on, but sometimes He says: enough.

¹⁰ **Now I will get up, says the LORD; now I will be exalted; now I Myself stand up** / it's My turn.

¹¹ **You conceived chaff, you gave birth to stubble** / WOW! Sifted debris, stalks and straw; that's it? combustible stuff good for a fire. That is all they could accomplish, and they probably made millions. Earlier, the prophet wrote: they labor and give birth to wind – **Isaiah 26:18:**

so, My breath, like fire will consume you.

¹² **And the nations will be burned to lime: like cut up thorns that burn in the fire.** ¹³ **You who are faraway, Hear what I have done; you who are near, recognize My might.**

¹⁴ **Sinners of Zion are terrified; trembling has surprised the hypocrites. Who among us can live with the consuming fire? who among us can live with continual burnings?** / there are citizens in Zion, hypocrites, who enjoy Zion's privileges and concur in Zion's services, but their hearts are not right in the sight of God; keeping their secret haunts of sin under cloak of a visible profession;

¹⁵ **He who walks upright, and speaks truth; he who rejects unjust gain, who shakes the hand yet holds no bribe, who will not hear of bloodshed, and will not look to do evil;**

¹⁶ **he will dwell on high.** His refuge is **the invincible rock.** his bread will be given; his waters will be sure.

¹⁷ **Your eyes will see the King in His beauty: they will look on the land far away.**

¹⁸ **Your heart will meditate on terror: Who enrolled the army? Who weighed the spoils? Who watched and lookout and report the strength of the city? / did they defund the police?**

¹⁹ **This fierce arrogant people, you will not see again; a people of incoherent speech that you can't understand; like stuttering, that no one can understand / do they speak a dead language?**

²⁰ **Look on Zion** / the City of David,? **the city of our appointed feasts: your eyes will see Jerusalem an undisturbed dwelling, a tent that will not be folded; its stakes will not be removed, its cords will not be broken.** / they are not moving ever again, accept to the New Jerusalem,

²¹ **But there, the majestic LORD will be for us a place of broad rivers and streams; where no boat with oars will go, where no gallant ship will pass** / no slave vessel, no war ship.

²² **For the LORD is our judge, the LORD is our lawgiver, the LORD is our king; He will save us** / in Hebrew: **Yasha** a diminutive of **Yeshua**.

Like an Assyrian shipwreck

²³ **Your tackle is loose: they could not strengthen their mast, they could not spread the sail, so the great war spoil is seized and divided; even the lame will take their prey / if they could not raise the sail: they could not get away: / even the weakest will have a share in the booty.**

²⁴ **And no resident will say, I am sick: those who dwell there will be forgiven their crime.**
