The book of Isaiah has two great divisions; first: chapters 1–39; God's Criticism of both rebel houses Israel and Judah, thereby affecting all the local neighbors in the hood; and second: chapters 40–66; God's Consolation to both houses who have separate histories. The great Isaiah scroll found in the Qumran caves, dated from the 2nd century BC has put to rest many wild speculations about prophet Isaiah.



¹ For the sake of Zion

2700 years ago, Isaiah wrote: and what he had to say isn't going to make friends with many in our genius 21st century; particularly with that crappy organization UNESCO... or even with any of those of the roman global agenda... all those strange birds that have no difficulty promoting pedophilia along with the rape of women and children. Those entities will become manure for the beasts of the field.

Now, if crappy is too harsh a word to your tender ears, then substitute: dung-heap, or that good KJV word: dunghill. A way to look at this roman mess: the people in that middle east neighborhood have had more years of opportunity to learn what Isaiah said than most nations. That some fools in their community decided to suppress the information and didn't let the people know; is unfortunate. They will need a little history lesson. Zion, the City of David – often refers to Jerusalem, where the flock gathers; where King David of both srael and

This 1st picture from the Library of Congress taken in the early 1900s long before the protesters' grandparents were born; the **City of David** is the center piece of this picture above. It is an area of roughly 12 acres containing the threshing floor purchased by King David, and the Gihon springs, the only source of running water in Jerusalem even today; its where Solomon built the first temple.



This 2nd picture -- also from the Library of Congress, there wasn't much activity on these 12 acres; things don't change much. In 700BC, prophet Micah spoke to those corrupt leaders who build Zion with bloodshed, and Jerusalem with violence:

Therefore, on account of you, Zion will be plowed as a field, Jerusalem will become a heap of ruins, and the hill of the temple will be a lonely forest place. Micah 2:11-12. And it happened; so I hope our genius leaders today hear him because the Lord knows His plans for this city.

¹ For the sake of Zion I will not keep silent / for the City of David's sake, one day I hope to meet king David, so I won't be silent either; how about you?

for the sake of Jerusalem I will not be quiet, until its brilliant Righteousness goes forth and salvation as a blazing torch / in Hebrew: and Yeshua as a blazing torch where comes the name: Jesus Christ, the Messiah of God, who is our Righteousness,



² And the nations will see her Righteousness, and all the kings her glory / nobody will miss her Righteousness; one day Jesus the Messiah will come in power and great glory:

and you will be called by a new name, which the mouth of the LORD will designate / it's a new name; it's a New Jerusalem.

³ You will be a crown of glory in the hand of the LORD, a royal diadem in the hand of your God / a glorious crown, a precious stone in the palm of His hand.

⁴ You will no more be termed Forsaken and your land will no more be termed Desolate / no more called Abandoned: no more considered a Desert wasteland:

but you will be called My Delight Is in Her, and your land Married: for the LORD delights in you, and your land will be married.



⁵For as a young man marries a young woman, so your sons will marry you: as the Bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so your God will rejoice over you.

⁶ On your walls, I have set watchmen, O Jerusalem, who will not be silent day or night: you who remember the LORD, take no rest / if you know the Lord, don't sleep; it's not time for snoozing; work for the night is coming when no work will be done,

⁷ And give Him no rest until He establishes and makes Jerusalem a praise in the earth / raise your voice to the Lord God – day and night, don't give God a rest; for now the rulers of the nations say lots of stupid stuff; she is a City still in crisis, the last govt only knows how to break and destroy, they desire to control her; but don't let them; they do not represent her interests. Raise voices to our God He will hear.

⁸ The LORD has sworn by His right hand, and by His mighty arm / by the One who sits at His right hand; His only Son; when the Lord swears, that means He is going to do it; what He says will happen,

I will never again give your grain to be food for your enemies; and foreigners will not drink your wine, for which you labored:

⁹ but those who gather it will eat it, and praise the LORD; and those who gather it will drink it in the courts of My Sanctuary.

¹⁰ Go through, go through the gates / Open the gates;

prepare the way of the people; build up, build up the highway; remove the stones; lift up a victory flag over the people.

¹¹ Behold, the LORD has proclaimed to the end of the earth, Say to the daughter of Zion / He wants the world to know; say to this beloved City of David, left for so long as a forgotten, plowed field amid a heap of ruins,

Behold / pay attention, your salvation = your Yesha = your Jesus comes! / when He comes it will be a joyous day; it is the next day on His calendar; the 5th Day of the Lord; at the gathering of the Harvest;

Behold, His reward is with him, and His recompense is before him.

¹² And they will call them, The Holy People, The Redeemed of the LORD: and you will be called, Sought out, A City Not Forsaken.
