

ISAIAH 9 vs 8

The people were forewarned by Moses as they entered the land pledged to their forefathers, they knew the blessings promised by God should they obey His voice, and the curses should they choose to turn away from Him. Isaiah spoke words of hope to the people who were preparing for yet another invasion due to their faithlessness. In four strophes, Isaiah next outlines their crime, their punishment, and a final refrain.



⁸The LORD sent a word to Jacob / a message is sent the descendants of their scheming forefather,

and it has rested on Israel / condemnation has fallen on rebellious Israel.

⁹And all the people will know, even Ephraim and the inhabitants of Samaria / Ephraim the leader of the House of Israel, the 10 northern tribes... received all **the bright promises God first made with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob**... that they might be a blessing to the world; but due to their faithlessness, they forfeited their right to remain in the land,

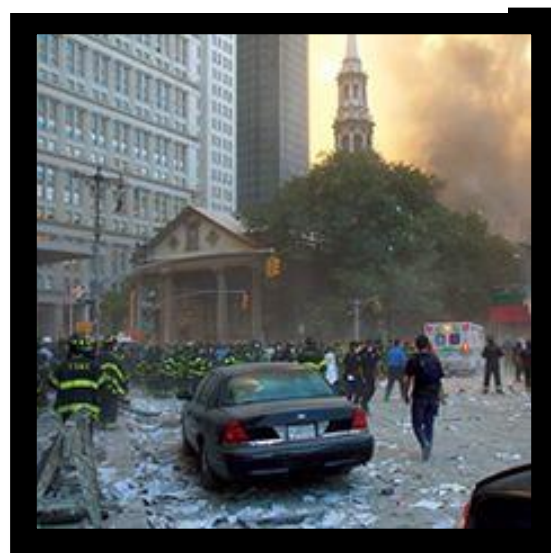
who say in the pride and stoutness of heart / these northern fat-head tribes were very much like their progeny who populate the 21st century, they proudly speak their bold pronouncements defying God,

¹⁰The bricks are fallen down,

but we will build with hewn stones / on the surface, their response sounds laudable, but remember, the Lord lifted His hedge of protection around them... allowing Assyrians to invade and their walls to fall; yet notice the people aren't remorseful, they are stubborn fools who want to argue with the Lord, refusing to humble themselves before Him; they are going to rebuild bigger, taller, stronger than ever, adding:

the sycamores are cut down,

but we will exchange them with evergreens / again they're in defiance of God's judgment; they are sure that they will grow higher and fuller than before.



Since Isaiah first spoke these words, other than the nation Israel, America is the only other country in world history... which built their foundation on the Bible... which is the only reason why it had been able to be a great blessing to the world. These are the same words and verses spoken by the ignorant, rebellious citizens duped by a global agenda at the rebuilding of the World Trade Center -- the modern-day equivalent of **the Tower of Babel** in New York City; not knowing these defiant words are against the Lord God who was driven out of the life of their country... as He was driven out of the lives of those Isaiah was warning.

11 So the LORD will set up the adversaries of Rezin against him / having violated God's warning: Ephraim conspired with Rezin and their duplicitous neighbors turned on them,

and join his enemies together;

12 The Syrians to the east,

the Philistines to the west;

and they devour Israel with gaping mouths.

For all this His anger is not turned away,

but His hand is still outstretched / and is His hand outstretched to help or to hinder? His people will reveal the answer as they either turn to Him...or turn from Him. It was Jesus who said, as is your faith it will be done to you. Will they want to exercise their faith for Him? Or against Him?

13 For the people do not turn to Him who struck them;

they do not seek the LORD of hosts.

14 So, the LORD will cut off head and tail from Israel / and what does that mean? Read on,

branch and rush in one day / both the highest, and the lowest will be affected.

ISAIAH 9 vs 8

15 The elder and the honorable, he is **the head;**

and the prophet who teaches lies,

he is **the tail** / Jesus said liars and deceivers along with the lawless are coming –

doing what is right in their own estimation; well, they have arrived.

16 For those who lead people to error;

and those led by them are destroyed / they're all blindly falling into the ditch together.

17 So, the LORD has **no joy in their young men,**

He has **no mercies for the fatherless and widows** / and you might wonder why?

Well don't interrupt Isaiah:

for everyone is self-indulgent,

and an evildoer,

and every mouth speaks foolishness / the language of fools, who have no awareness of God.

For all this His anger is **not turned away,**

but His hand is still outstretched.

18 For wickedness burns like a fire:

it consumes briars and thorns,

it ignites thickets of the forest,

and it billows like columns of smoke / the lowest and highest are touched by those who do wrong.

19 By the wrath of the LORD of hosts,

the land is burned,

its people are like fuel for the fire:

no one will spare his brother / internal discord snaps asunder the once natural ties.

²⁰ On the **right**,

he will seize, and be hungry;

on the **left**,

he will destroy, but not be satisfied:

each will feed on the flesh of his own offspring / is this literal or figurative? only time will reveal.

²¹ Manasseh on **Ephraim**; Ephraim on Manasseh / both very competitive brothers... Joseph's 2 sons, ½ Egyptian sons, inheritors of the many nationalistic blessings given to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

Manasseh, the once great nation... and Ephraim, the once greater commonwealth of nations – they are still in the news today, Isaiah tells us, corrupted, they will be feeding on each other... consuming each other... until the time of the Gentile nations comes to a close... or until they wake up and remember it is the Lord God who blessed them;



together they will be against **Judah** / these 3, will either be faithful and greatly blessed, or overrun with Herodians and greatly cursed... so until they wake up, they definitely can be labeled **dumb asses**; it is **not** a good thing for brothers... or cousins... to quarrel. **Israel** does not need to resemble **Judah**; the many tribes of Israel and where they went... welcomed the good news of the Messiah and helped carry the good news for the past 2000 years; thankfully our cousins in Judah are also embracing the Messiah.
