Much of what Jeremiah wrote was current history when he lived in 600BC; nonetheless... a closer look at what he recorded serves a dual purpose not only speaking to faithless Judah and Jerusalem and lessons that caused the LORD to send them to Babylonian captivity; but also as a reminder to the faithful in both HOUSES Israel and Judah and to each of us... what to expect wherever we go throughout history, until Messiah comes to rule with a rod of iron.

¹ And it happened, when Jeremiah finished telling all the people all the words of the LORD their God, for which the LORD their God had sent him to deliver to them, those words,



² then Azariah / lovely fool, son of Hoshaiah spoke, with Johanan / a useful idiot son of Kareah, and all the arrogant men, saying to Jeremiah, You liar: the LORD our God never sent you to forbid us to go to Egypt to settle there:

³ but it is Baruch son of Neriah who set you against us, to deliver us over to the Chaldeans, to be killed, or carried away captive to Babylon.

⁴ So Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the leaders of the Jewish forces, and all the people, did not obey the voice of the LORD, to remain in the land of Judah.

⁵ But Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the leaders of the forces, took all the survivors of Judah, who returned from where they were driven, to remain in the land of Judah;

⁶ men, women, children and even the daughters of the king, and all who Nebuzaradan the commander-in-chief had entrusted to Gedaliah son of Ahikam grandson of Shaphan, and Jeremiah the prophet, and Baruch the son of Neriah.

⁷ So they entered the land of Egypt: heedless of what the LORD said, they went to Tahpanhes.

⁸ Then the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah at Tahpanhes, saying,

⁹ Take some large stones in your hand, and hiding them under the pavement, which is at the entrance of the house of Pharaoh in Tahpanhes, and let some men of Judah watch you.

¹⁰ and tell them, Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Indeed, I will send and take Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon, My servant, and will set his throne over these stones that we hid; and he will spread his royal pavilion over them.

¹¹ He will come and ravage the land of Egypt, and deliver death for those doomed to die; and captivity for those doomed to captivity; and the sword for those doomed to the sword.

¹² And he will set ablaze the temples of the gods of Egypt; burning them, and taking them away captives: and he will scour the land of Egypt, like a shepherd plucks vermin from his garment; going forth in peace.

¹³ He will demolish the obelisks of Beth-shemesh, in the land of Egypt; and the temples of the gods of the Egyptians He will burn set ablaze.
