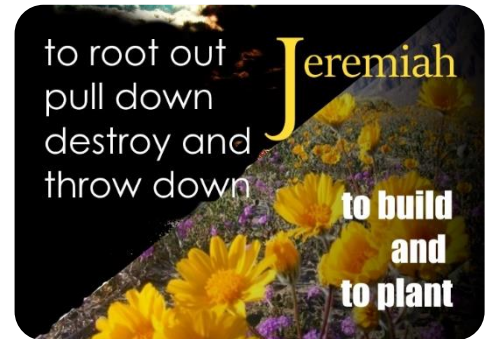


JEREMIAH 45 vs 1

¹ **This is the message that Jeremiah the prophet spoke to Baruch the son of Neriah, when he wrote these words in a scroll dictated by Jeremiah, in the fourth year of Jehoiakim son of Josiah, king of Judah, saying,**

² **Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, to you, O Baruch:**

³ **Did you say, Woe / how terrible it is for me now! for the LORD has added sorrow to my pain; I am tired of complaining, and I find no rest.**

⁴ **Thus you are to say to him, Thus says the LORD; Indeed, what I have built up I will soon break down, and what I have planted I will soon uproot, even this whole earth.**

⁵ **But you, are you seeking great things for yourself? Do not seek them: for, indeed, I will soon bring calamity on all flesh, says the LORD: but I will spare your life in all the places where you go /** and we know in ancient Irish history, within 5 years, Ollam Fodla – the great seer, and Simon Braech his assistant, with the daughter of an Egyptian king suddenly appeared at Tara in Ireland.
