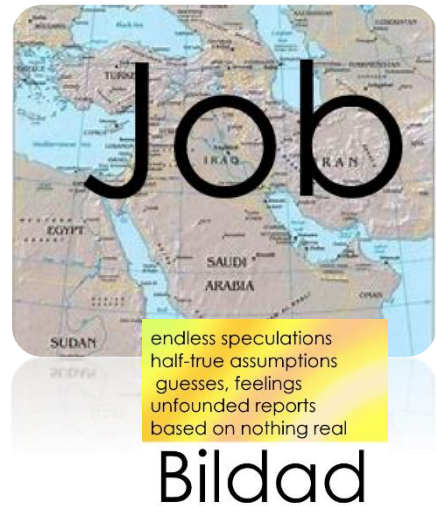


# JOB 25 vs 1
