Here is a highly speculative footnote to this verse.


<sup>17</sup> Jesus said unto her, Do not touch Me; for I have not yet ascended to My Father.

Consider this: Did Jesus have an activity still needed to do as our High Priest? Sacrifices were made in the outer court; only the High Priest could enter into the Holy of holies... with evidence of the blood sacrifice.

So when, as our High Priest did Jesus do that? When did that occur? Since we read later that they were touching Him.

From the Qumran Caves, Fragment #4Q405 - **The Songs of the Sabbath Sacrifice...** were only translated in 1985. The

final Song, the fragments clearly read... using a specific Hebrew phrase about the High Priest... that is only referenced in Exodus 28 and 39.





Line 2. ... the King, when they served before

Line 3. King, and He inscribed His glory...

Line 4. holiness, the sanctuary of all...

Line 5. **their ephodim** (warrior garments) **they spread out** ...

Line 6. holy ones ... good favor ... spirits of the holy ones...

Line 7. their holy places... many colors, like woven work, engraved with figures of splendor.

And next, is the verse of interest:



Day 3: Firstfruits

Line 8. In the midst of the glorious appearance of Scarlet, the colors of most Holy light, they stand firm in their holy station before...

Now, don't you want to know... before Whom?!

This fragment from antiquity, only translated in 1985, speaks of:

this sanctuary of all, and therein, suddenly appears this King... the center of attention, gloriously appearing... in red!

## **JOHN 20 vs 17**




This Song of Sabbath Sacrifice, in lines 9 through 13, continues:
