2 Kings14 says, Jonah was not only a real person but a qualified prophet from a little town near Nazareth. Matthew records: Jesus the Christ who spoke of Jonah's experience three days and three nights in the belly of a large fish, as a matter of fact – Matthew 12.

And this brief book of 4 short chapters, reads as a simple historical account of an incredible event and what followed in the Assyrian capital.

Jonah's tomb has been recognized by the local peoples for millennia; and only in recent years under the Obama / HRC administration, were US taxpayer dollars used to create and support ISIS and destroy the ancient middle east relics of the church of the living God.

The Preaching of Jonah

¹ Now the word of the LORD came to Jonah a second time, saying,

² Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and proclaim to it the proclamation that I tell you.

³ So Jonah got up, and went to Nineveh, according to the word of the LORD / which means Jonah got up, probably got cleaned up from the whale vomit, and started walking; from the Lebanese shoreline to modern day Mosul is about 567 miles; which took him about 28 days to travel.

Now Nineveh was an exceeding great city, a journey of three days / traveling 20 miles on average, Jonah walked 60 miles around the circumference of the city and its surrounding neighborhoods.

⁴ And Jonah began to enter into the city a day's journey, and he cried out, and declared, Yet forty days, and Nineveh will be overthrown.

⁵ So the people of Nineveh believed God, and proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them even to the least of them.

⁶ When the word reached the king of Nineveh, he arose from his throne, laid aside his robe, and covered him with sackcloth, and sat in ashes.

⁷ And he caused it to be proclaimed and published throughout Nineveh by the decree of the king and his nobles, saying:

Do not let man, beast, herd nor flock taste a thing: do not let them eat or drink water:

⁸ but let man and beast be covered with sackcloth, and call mightily to God: yes, that each turn from his wrong way, and from the **violence** / **hamas**... that is in their hands.

⁹ Who knows if God will turn and reconsider, and turn away from His fierce anger, that we perish not?

¹⁰ And God saw their works, that they turned from their wrong way; and God reconsidered the harm that He said He would do to them; and He did not do it.
