THE Last generation...



Most people seem confused about the **LAST DAYS**, **THE LAST TIMES**. Listening to them, they seem terribly ignorant, though Paul said, **I would not have you ignorant**, yet they haven't thought it through to its conclusion. The original 7 appointments of the LORD,

are well documented: with the first 4 days already fulfilled: Passover, Unleavened Bread, Firstfruits and Pentecost; now 3 days are still on His calendar. These days are at the end of summer, when all their work and sweat was done; these 3 days relate to gathering the Harvest.

JESUS said, until the time of the Gentiles is fulfilled -- Luke 21:24; .

JESUS the good Teacher gave us lots of information about the workdays of the Lord, as each day was completed by Messiah; we see the grand order of His work: noting mystical, no hocus pocus was needed as those first 4 of the 7 Days of the Lord were carefully completed. And searching the scripture, we find the same detail as to what the prophets said about the last 3 days that approach. We can imagine the same clarity surrounding the final three days: blowing Trumpets, Afflicting Souls and putting up His Tent. The last generation of the



faithful ought to expect: **3 workdays of Messiah**, the **first** when He grabs up His faithful, the **second** to deal with the nations; and **third** to make ready His 2^{ND} arrival on **Day7** as He steps on the Mount of Olives, and in a moment clears away all the clutter of war piled on religious crap and clutter of all the centuries as He comes for a thousand years.

These specific workdays belong to the Lord alone while He allowed His people to party 3 times each year though they were not to go up to Jerusalem with empty hands: the were to bring a thank offering -- Leviticus 23. Knowing the 7 specific days helps sort through all the prophecies found in Daniel, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Joel, Haggai, Zechariah, Malachi; Matthew, Mark, Luke, Thessalonians 1 and 2, 1 Peter 3, 1 John 2, and Revelation, and all the other verses.



Even crazy Balaam 3,500 years ago knew: God is not like mankind, when he said: God is not a man that He should lie, or the son of man that He should reconsider; has He not spoken and will He not make it good? -- Numbers 23.

THE Last generation...



The Word of God -- He has been speaking for a long time, and knows the history of the messed-up church, in the greater messed-up world... I find it hard to imagine the Lord forgot to tell us something, so sent a fool or 2 who came 100s of years later to fill in the gaps with new weird stuff.

Jesus said, Ask, and it will be given; seek, and you will find; knock and it will be opened to you. He said, Come to Me, learn from Me, and you will find rest for your soul. Jesus, the good Pastor likes working with and teaching His students who



come to Him. The LORD has said from old: Ask Me, and I will show you great and mighty things you do not know! -- Jeremiah 33. I don't need fools who ignore the clear word.

What did JESUS forget to tell His church – the Love of His life?

Nothing!

This is why He could sit down! And take a break!

The night He was betrayed, He said: if it was not so, I would have told you. He also said, I will come again and receive you unto myself, that where I am, you may be also -- John 14.

If JESUS, the MESSIAH fulfilled COMPLETELY and FULLY the first 4 workdays when He came the first time... so what would cause anyone to think... JESUS, the MESSIAH will not fulfill COMPLETELY and FULLY the last 3 workdays when He comes the second time? The 5th Day of Trumpets / His next great workday on His calendar: at the time of the harvest; after all the sweat and toil is done; in every nation nobody needs to be ignorant: God has not appointed His people unto wrath, but unto salvation through Jesus Christ the Lord.

The 6th Day of Atonement / the Day afflicting souls, the terrible Day of God's anger; only Philadelphia, illustrative of those who really follow the Lord, they did what He asked them to do; and so were promised by the Lord that they will be excused and absent from the terrible test coming on the whole earth.

THE Last generation...



The 7th Day of tents / temporary shelters, it is the last day on Messiah's calendar: a day He returns to the Mount of Olives in Jerusalem, a joyous day of great thanksgiving. It will make you want to sing: Hallelujah!



JESUS said: when you see the abomination of desolation the massive apostasy; He said: when you see signs in the sun; in the moon; in the stars. When you see on the earth a distressing / literally, a squeezing, tightening, narrowing of nations. When you see a squeezing of nations perplexity / they ask: what is going on? The last generation if they pay attention should see evidence of it on the news.



JESUS said: when you see the **sea**, and the waves roaring / **the sea of humanity** making lots of noise, in successive waves of disruption, upheaval and distress... of people throughout the world asking: what is going on? The last generation... should be able to see evidence of ALL these things on the international TV News.



JESUS knew what Daniel said: after: [1] Babylon came [2] the Medo-Persians, [3] Greece then [4] Rome) Daniel did not know its name was Rome, but we do: yet Daniel describes the roman way strong as iron, breaking in pieces, smashing and destroying; and mentions its toes... so Daniel tells us about this global govt's trying to keep the whole world in balance... it will try to devour the whole earth, to tread it down and break it into pieces -- Daniel 2, 7, 8. The last generation should see the romans doing things on the TV news.

JESUS also said: when the Son of man returns... will He find faith? / will He find people still trusting the Lord? Will He find people acting in agreement with what He has said and promised? Without faith, we are powerless to please God -- Hebrews 11.



What do we do about the Day of Trumpets blasting 100 times that day: Malachi 3: 16-18 Is this the year? We do not know, but each rehearsal year we get closer. Messianic pastors say these 3 verses speak to this day: Those who fear the Lord spoke to one another, and the Lord gave attention (He liked what He was hearing), and heard it (what was the happy noise) and He jots a note in His book – on His calendar?: for those who respect the Lord and value His name. They will be Mine on the day I prepare My own possession, I will spare them... So you will again distinguish between the right and the wrong, between the one who serves God, and the one who doesn't. these 3 verses can help shape our time the day when the dead in Christ rise first and then He grabs up His faithful. Those gatherings like Ephesus who lost their first love, or Thyatira doing their pet projects, or Laodicea who thought they were rich and needed nothing. They will hold services and have an oh shit sherlock moment, when they discover they must go through the terrible 6th Day, because they forgot to do what the Lord told them to do, the night He was betrayed, to guard and share His word, and not deny His name.
