
LUKE 11 vs 37



Dr. Luke continues to write about Jesus speaking to a large crowd who gathered around Him, and said...

- ³⁷ And as He was speaking, a Pharisee asked Him to dine with him: and He went in, and reclined at the table.
- ³⁸ And when the Pharisee saw it, he marveled that Jesus had not first ritually washed before dinner.
- ³⁹ And the Lord asked him, Why do you Pharisees clean the outside of the cup and the platter; but inside you are full of greed and wrongdoing.



- ⁴⁰ You fools, did not the One who made the outside, make the inside also?
- ⁴¹ But give from what you have within to the poor; and indeed, everything will be clean for you.
- Woe / how terrible it will be to you, Pharisees! for you give a tenth of mint, rue and all kinds of herbs, and bypass justice and love for God:

these things you ought to do, and not leave the other undone.

- ⁴³ Woe / how terrible it will be to you, Pharisees! for you love the front seat in the synagogues, and all the laudatory greetings in the markets.
- 44 Woe / how terrible it will be to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! / concealing what is, while appearing what is not, for you are like unmarked graves, and those who walk over them are not even aware of them.
- ⁴⁵ Then sizing up the situation, one of the experts of the law said to Him, Teacher, saving thus, You insult us also.
- ⁴⁶ And Jesus said, Woe / how terrible it will be to you also, you lawyers! / you experts of the law, for you load people with burdens too grievous to carry, yet you yourselves do not touch these burdens with one of your fingers.
- ⁴⁷ Woe / how terrible it will be to you! for you build the tombs of the prophets, and your fathers killed them.
- ⁴⁸ So truly you are witnesses that you approve the deeds of your fathers: for they indeed killed them, and you build their tombs.

⁴⁹ For this reason, the wisdom of God said, I will send them prophets and apostles, and some of them they will kill and persecute:

⁵⁰ so that this generation is held responsible for the bloodshed of all the prophets, since the foundation of the world;

51 from the blood of Abel to the blood of Zacharias / from A to Z, first to last all who perished between the altar and the temple: Amen, I say to you, It will be required of this generation.

⁵² Woe / how terrible it will be to you, lawvers! / experts of the law,

for you have taken away the key of knowledge: you did not enter in yourselves, and those who were entering, you hindered / Jesus affirms a scouring indictment on the master teachers and educated elite who failed at their assignment in every generation; it won't go well for them.

⁵³ And when He left there, the scribes and Pharisees began to oppose Him vigorously, and to provoke Him to speak on many things:

⁵⁴ to ambush Him, seeking to entrap Him with something He said, that they might accuse Him.
